•	Ask the friend to make suggestions for improving the writing. NO hurt feelings
•	Do you need to continue to revise or edit?
•	Are you completely satisfied that you've done YOUR BEST draft?
•	Do you want to publish this piece? Publishing means rewriting the draft – using your
	BEST handwriting. It needs to be perfect!
