Rainbow Editing

 **red** - Draw an  in front of each new paragraph.

orange - Underline the capital letters at the beginning of every sentence, for proper nouns, and the letter "I" by itself. Cross out letters that should not be capitalized.

 **yellow** - circle the punctuation at the end of every sentence. Add the punctuation if it is missing.

 **green** - Box transition words (first, then, next, after that). Make sure you are not using the same word too often.

 **blue** - circle words that you think may be misspelled.

 **purple** - Put a  around vivid verbs, interesting adjectives, and any other fancy words in your paper.
