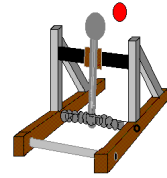


All fair maidens and fine lads in The American and National Leagues are hereby given an order to make one catapult by Tuesday the 25th of April in the year 2017.



The guidelines are as follows:

1. Ye catapult must be homemade (made mostly from materials found around ye castle). Please do not use bungee cords. Springs longer than 6 inches (before stretched) are not allowed.

2. Dimensions not to exceed: length - 45 cm (18 in)

width - 45 cm (18 in)

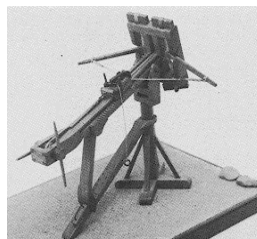
*height - 45 cm (18 in)

(*not including arm height)



3. No more than 10 rubber bands please.

YOU MAY COMPLETE THIS PROJECT WITH A PARTNER, HOWEVER MAKE SURE YOU ARE ABLE TO SCHEDULE TIME TO WORK TOGETHER OUTSIDE OF CLASS. BOTH PARTNERS MUST BE PRESENT WHENEVER THE CATAPULT IS BEING WORKED ON. A NOTE IS REQUIRED FROM BOTH SETS OF PARENTS GIVING THEIR CHILD PERMISSION TO WORK WITH THEIR PARTNER.
