

Track and field team continues success

Two more victories were earned by the Geneseo boys track and field team, this past week, coming in the Alleman and Streator meets.

Alleman Meet

The Leafs claimed another first-place victory on both the varsity and freshmen/ sophomore levels Tuesday night, April 5 in the teams' homeopener against the Alleman Pioneers.

Geneseo won the varsity meet 106-39, while the freshmen/ sophomore team won by a final score of 110-22.

"There was pretty good competition," Head Coach Don Fredericks said. "And we are sure happy with how our guys competed."

The varsity squad grabbed first-place victories in 16-of-18 events along with seven second-place finishes and 10 third places.

Both the 3200-meter relay and the 400-m relay teams crossed the line in first place for the initial two victories of the meet for the Leafs. The Dan 3200-m relay Chance Chenoweth, Nordstrom, Nate Silver and Nathan Schlindwein clocked in at 8 minutes, 28.94 seconds, while the 400-m relay of seniors Augie Anderson, Cody Leamen and Luke Reschke and junior Shaun Russell finished with a first place in 44.49.

Also on the track, senior Brian Chenoweth raced to-a first-place finish in the 3200-m with a final time of 10:00.71, edging out Alleman's Nathaniel Hird and Alex Kelly, both state finalist in cross country this past year, Fredericks said. Chenoweth also took the 1600m run with a final time of 4:39.81, just ahead of brother D. Chenoweth who was onehundredth of a second behind in second place with a time of 4:39.82. Schlindwein ended the 1600-m run in third place with a final time of 4:41.37, giving the Leafs the sweep of the event.

"Brian ran a tremendously

savvy race in the 3200-m run," Fredericks said.

Senior Eric Darwin grabbed his initial first-place finish of the meet in the 110 high hurdles in 17.75, before winning the 300-m intermediate hurdles in 42.50, a lifetime best, Fredericks noted. Junior Caleb Diericx followed Darwin in the 100-m hurdles for second place in 19.09 and in the 300-m hurdles, Wolfe Repass took second in 44.59 and Diericx third in 45.05.

Geneseo also swept the 100-m dash with Russell taking the top position, edging out teammate Leamen by one-hundredth of a second in 11.12. Leamen took second in 11.13. Anderson claimed third for Geneseo, crossing the line at 11.69.

"Shaun Russell and Cody Leamen were wire-to-wire, shoulder-to-shoulder in the 100-m dash," Fredericks said. "It was very exciting. There was a lot of speed." The 800-m relay, consisting of Anderson, Shane Reschke, Jacob Kuban and junior Mason Kernan, also received first-place honors with a final time of 1:37.48. In the 400-m run, Silver took first in 55.68 followed by Nordstrom in third in 56.21, while Leamen finished in first place in the 200-m run in 23.54 and Anderson clocked in at 24.53 for third place.

Two of Geneseo's 1600-m relay teams placed in second and third with Alleman taking the top position in 3:40.02. Team No.1 for the Leafs of S. Reschke, Silver, Repass and Nordstrom took second in 3:42.32 while team No. 2, consisting of Robert Reese, seniors Byron Stanley and Corey Hopkey and Darwin, crossed the line in third in 3:52.48.

In the field events, the Leafs claimed all three top spots in the high jump with Stanley leading the way with a 6-1 final jump. Justin Heaton came in second with a leap of 5-10 followed by junior Matt Krapfl in third at 5-2. L. Reschke leaped to a first-place finish in the long jump a 19-5 effort while Kuban took third with 18-1.

Russell won both the triple jump and the pole vault events; the triple jump with a final

jump of 40-3 and the pole vault with a vault of 12-6. Diericx also placed in the triple jump event, coming in second at 37-6, while senior Brian Sandoval followed Russell to the pole vault, clearing 11-0 for third place.

"Other top performers were Luke Reschke in the long jump and the 4x100, Byron Stanley had a decent jump in the high jump and Shaun Russell gave a real strong performance in the triple jump," Fredericks said.

Junior Joe Paradiso was one of the top performances of the meet in the shot put, Fredericks said. Paradiso grabbed first place in the shot put with a final heave of 50-2 1/2 while teammate sophomore Chris Brooks came in third at 45 1/2. Brooks won the discus with a final throw of 117-4.

"Joe threw over 50 feet for the first time this season," Fredericks said. "That's about three feet better than his last throw. It is a major improvement."

The freshmen/ sophomore team ended the meet with 16 first-place finishes, 11 seconds and 10 thurds.

Claiming firsts were all four relay teams, the 3200-m relay in 10:23.75, the 400-m relay with a time of 47.35, the 800 in 1:41.68 and the 1600 at 4:01.00. Jaran Heaton won the 110 high hurdles in 18.50 while Kuban took the 100-m dash in 12.06. Jon Fleming won the 800-m run in 2:23 followed by Bren Gillespie in the 400-m run, clocking in at 57.24.

Jaran Heaton also won the 300-m intermediate hurdles in 46.31 while Elliott Kenney took the 200-m run in 26.06. Jesse Gessel claimed the top spot in the high jump at 5-8 followed by Blake VerStraete in first in the long jump at 17-2 1/2.

Tom Blean grabbed first in the 1600-m in 5:13 while Aaron Schilling won the triple jump at with a 38-2 leap. Josh Olson grabbed first in the discus with a throw of 108-9 and Jaran Heaton propelled himself to a first-place finish in the pole vault at 9-6.

Streator Meet

Geneseo added to its success with two more firsts from the varsity and freshmen/ sophomore teams at the Streator meet, Thursday, March 31. The varsity won with a score of 161 and the freshmen/ sophomore a 224 score. The other meet participants included Dixon, Flanagan, Mendota and Streator.

"The seniors really stepped up and helped us out," Fredericks said. "And things went good."

The Leafs dominated the field, clinching first place in 12 of the 18 events. All four relay teams grabbed the top place in their respective events including the 3200-m relay team of D. Chenoweth, Silver, Schlindwein and B. Chenoweth, taking the tape in 8:27.5 followed by the 400-m relay in 44.4, consisting of Glazier, Leamen, L. Reschke and Russell. The 800-m relay of Anderson, S. Reschke, Kuban and Glazier clocked in at 1:37.1 for first while the 1600-m relay of S. Reschke, Silver, Repass and L. Reschke finished in 3:35.1.

"A top performance was Luke Reschke anchoring the 1600-m relay with a 52.8 anchor leg," Fredericks said. "That was tremendous. It showed how much he wants it in this race. He showed senior pride and leads by example."

Russell and Reschke both finished the meet with multiple first-place finishes in individual events; Russell ended with three

and Reschke two. Russell claimed first in the 100-m dash in 11.3, the triple jump with a mark of 40-0 and the pole vault, clearing the bar at 11-0. Reschke took first in the long jump with a final distance of 20-4 and in the 400-m dash, crossing the line 52.2.

Others taking home first-place honors were Reese in the 800-m run with a time of 2:11.6; B. Chenoweth in the 1600-m run in 4:36.1 and Stanley, clearing the bar at 6-1 in the high jump.

Leamen also had a successful day in individual events, placing in three events. Leamen took second place in the 100-m dash with a time of 11.4 on the heels of Russell in first and added another second in the 200-m dash, crossing the line at 23.4. In the long jump, Leamen took third with a mark of 18-4 for his final finish.

"Another top performance was from Brian Chenoweth running a nice race in the 1600-m run against Dixon's sectional champion," Fredericks said. "And Cody Leamen running a strong 100 to tie with Shaun Russell."

In the 110 high hurdles, Darwin finished in second place in 17.6 along with another second-place finish in the 300 hurdles in 42.7. Brooks took second in the shot put with a 44-11 heave and finished fifth in the discus with a final throw of 115-9. Wyffels grabbed the final second-place finish in the 3200-m run with a final time of 10:56.9.


Repass ended the meet with

two third-place finishes, the 110-m high hurdles with a time of 18.1 and the 300-m hurdles in 46.1. Senior Brady Piepenbrink took third in the pole vault, clearing the bar at 10-0, while D. Chenoweth took third in the 1600-m run in 4:42.5.

The Leafs had five fourthplace finishers, Wildermuth in the 3200-m run in 11:19.8 and Schlindwein in the 1600-m run with a time of 4:47.9. In the field events, Heaton claimed fourth in the high jump with a jump of 5-6, Paradiso in the shot put with a throw of 44-1 and Brieser in the pole vault with a clearing height of 8-6. Martins took fifth in the pole vault with a final vault of 7-6.

The freshmen/ sophomore team ended the meet with 15 first-place finishes out of the 18 events, 10 second places, six third and fourth-place finishes and two fifths.

Placing first for the Leafs on the track were Kotecki in the 3200-m run in 11:17.8, Jaran Heaton in the 110 high hurdles

with a time of 17.5 and Kuban in the 100-m dash, clocking in at 12.3. Fleming took the 800-m run event in 2:21.5 while Silver won the 400-m dash-in 56.5 and Heaton the 300-m hurdles, crossing the line in 45.9. Rounding out the track events were Blean racing to a first-place finish in the 1600-m run in 5:41.1 and Kenney in the 200-m dash in 25.9. Two relay teams also won their respective races for Geneseo: the 400-m relay of Kuban, Sam Woolsey, Beau Neece and S. Reschke in 47.5 and the 1600m relay consisting of Andy Collis, Gillespie, Gessel and Jeremy Peters with a time of 3:54.20.

In field events, Gillespie won the high jump, clearing the bar at 5-8 while Ben Woolsey took the shot put event with a 32-11 heave. Schilling won both the long jump and triple jump events; the long jump at a 16-4 mark and triple jump at 35-2. Heaton claimed first in the pole vault at the 9-6 mark.

"We have a team with a tremendous amount of competitors," Fredericks said. "And the

good stuff is yet to come.

"Cody Leamen still continues to amaze me and the 100-m dash (Tuesday night) was fun to watch with the (friendly) rivalry between Leamen and Shaun Russell," Fredericks said. "Pushing each other helps out a lot and they have the hunger and desire to compete."

The Leafs will be in action this Saturday, April 9 at the UTHS Invite at 12 p.m. Teams compet-

ing at the invite with Geneseo include, Alleman, Freeport, Mackenzie Park Harlem, Moline, Pleasant Valley, Rockford East, Rock Island, Plainfield South, Sherrard, Sterling and UT.

"It is a good invite anytime the Western Big Six powerhouses are there," Fredericks said. "It is going to be a great meet and we want that competition."
