# Galesburs Dual

#### Galesburg

Both the varsity and freshmen/sophomore squads continued success by winning the team's dual meet against Galesburg, April 14. The varsity defeated Galesburg 77-69 and the JV won 110-36.

"(The Galesburg meet) was a great meet and a tremendous dual meet," Fredericks said. "Galesburg is extremely talented and gave us all we wanted and more. It was nip and tuck the whole way and it came down to the very end. The meet was great competition and it was tremendous opportunity."

In field events, Gillespie won the high

jump with a leap of 5-10 followed by senior Justin Heaton in third at 5-8, Gessel fourth also at 5-8 and junior Matt Krapfl fifth with a jump of 5-4. In the pole vault, Russell claimed first place, clearing the bar at 12-6 ahead of senior Brian Sandoval in third at 11-0, senior Brady Piepenbrink in fourth with a vault of 10-6 and senior Wyatt Brieser with a fifth-place finish at 9-0. L. Reschke won the long jump with a final mark of 21-8 while Kuban took fourth at 19-3 and Leamen fifth at 19-2.

Russell also won the triple jump, leaping to a 41-11 1/2 final mark, while freshman Aaron Schilling took third at 38-9 and Diericx came in fourth at 37 3/4. Brooks grabbed a second-place finish in the discus with a final throw of 121-1 while junior Andrew Hull came in fifth at 93-7. Brooks took first in the shot put with a 44-4 1/2 heave followed by Hull in fifth with a 39-7 mark.

On the track, Russell and Leamen finished two and three in the 100-m dash, both with times of 11.20. Anderson followed in fifth in 11.80. In the 200-m dash, Leamen crossed the line in third place in 23.30 followed by Anderson in fourth (24.50) and junior Andrew Martens fifth (26.80).

The Leafs claimed the top three spots in the 300-m hurdles with senior Eric Darwin taking first in 42.70 followed by Diericx in second in 43.20 and Repass third, crossing the finish line in 44.10. Schlindwein grabbed a second-place finish in the 800-m run with a final time of 2:09.00 and Reese took fourth in 2:16.20.

D. Chenoweth beat out brother B. Chenoweth in the 1600-m run as D. Chenoweth raced to a second-place finish of 4:30.93 (the second fastest sophomore 1600 in school history) and B. Chenoweth came in fourth in 4:34.86. B. Chenoweth grabbed a second-place victory in the 3200-m run, taking the tape in 9:55.50, followed by senior Jordan Wildermuth in 11:21.90 and junior Scott Mattan in 12:02 for fourth and fifth places.

In relay action, the 800-m relay consisting of Anderson, S. Reschke, Kernan and Glazier claimed first place, crossing the line in 1:36.00, while the 1600-m relay of S. Reschke, Silver, Repass and L. Reschke also grabbed first with a final time of 3:36.50. The Leafs won the 3200-m relay in 8:28.20 with D. Chenoweth, Silver, Nordstrom and Schlindwein while the 400-m relay team of Glazier, Leamen, L. Reschke and Russell took second with a final time of 44.30.

L. Reschke claimed second place in the 400-m dash, taking the tape in 49.73, followed by Silver in 55.24 and Nordstrom in 55.25. Freshman Jaran Heaton took second in the 110-m hurdles in 17.40 while Darwin came in third at 18.20 followed by Diericx in ourth with a time of 19.10.

L. Reschke raced to an inder 50-second finish in the

400 for the first time, clocking 49.73 which is the fourth fastest time in school history, Fredericks said.

"Luke ran a tremendous race; he battled the whole way," Fredericks said. "Luke went out harder than he has before, he took a chance and it paid a huge dividend."

At the freshmen/ sophomore level, Peters claimed first in the high jump, clearing the bar at 5-4, while Jaran Heaton won the pole vault event with a vault of 9-6. Schilling grabbed first place in the long jump with a 17-6 mark followed by sophomore Elliott Kenney in the triple jump, soaring to a 36-7 1/2 final mark. In the discus event, sophomore Corey Akers took first with a throw of 113-4 while S. Reschke won the 100-m dash in 11.70.

Kuban raced to a secondplace finish in the 200-m dash with a final time of 24.80. Jaran Heaton took the 300-m

hurdles, crossing the finish line in 46.50. In the 800-m run, Fleming took first with a final time of 2:24.30 and Wyffels claimed first in both the 1600-m run and the 3200-m run. Wyffels finished the 1600-m run in 5:07.20 and the 3200 with a time of 11:02.90.

The 400-m relay of Kuban, Peters, Neece and S., Reschke took first in 46.80 followed by the 1600-m relay taking first in 3:49.40 with members Collis, Gillespie, Gessel and Peters. The 800-m relay of Kenney, Peters, Neece and sophomore Sam Woolsey were second with a final time of 1:41.30 while the 3200-m relay of Kowitz, Reyes, sophomore Jesse Cross and Fleming finished second in 10:06.20. Gessel won the 400m dash in 56.80 while Repass raced to a first-place finish at 18.40 in the 110-m hurdles. .

The Leafs compete today, April 22, at the Rock Island Invite starting at 4 p.m.
