The boys varsity and freshmen/ sophomore teams grabbed two more first place victories this past week at Galesburg and Ottawa.

Ottawa

Geneseo's varsity raced to one of its first-place finishes in Ottawa Tuesday, April 19 with 173.3 total team points while the freshmen/ sophomore team claimed another first with 153 points. Ottawa came in second followed by St. Bede, LaSalle-Peru and Streator in the varsity meet while Ottawa took second, LP third, Streator fourth and St. Bede fifth in the freshmen/ sophomore competition.

"We went to the Ottawa meet to gain experience for the NCIC championships that are held at Ottawa," Head Coach Don Fredericks said. "It is a wonderful facility and we wanted to familiarize ourselves with the facility. We believe it was worth the trip."

The varsity Leaf relay teams all had a successful day on the track, with three out of four relay teams claiming first place. The 3200-meter relay of senior Brian Chenoweth, freshman Chance Nordstrom and sophomores Blake Wyffels and Nate Silver grabbed first place, taking the tape in 8 minutes and 59.15 seconds while the 400-m relay of juniors Kyle Glazier and Shaun Russell and seniors Luke Reschke and Cody Leamen finished with a final time of 44.45 for first. The 1600-m relay of freshman Shane Reschke, Nordstrom, sophomore Wolfe Repass and Silver took the final first-place victory in 3:41.56 while the 800-m relay of senior Augie Anderson, S. Reschke, junior Mason Kernan and Glazier took second, crossing the line in 1:36.34.

L. Reschke added three more firsts to his 400-m relay first place, grabbing wins in the long jump with a final leap of 20-11 1/2, the 400-m dash with a final time of 51.24 and the 200-m dash, taking the tape in 22.72.

"One top performance of the night was from Luke Reschke in the 200-m dash," Fredericks said. "It was a real eye opener. It was the first time this season he has run the 200 and we thought we would take a look at him in that race. We were very pleased with what we saw. He ran a tremendous race."

Geneseo also had four other athletes place first in their respective events; junior Joe Paradiso won the shot put event with a final heave of 49-4 3/4, sophomore Dan Chenoweth took the 3200-m run, crossing the finish line in 10:08.80, Silver finished at 2:08.02 for first in the 800-m run and B. Chenoweth won the 1600-m run, taking the tape in 4:30.83.

"The second top performance came from Brian Chenoweth," Frederick said. "It is interesting to watch the Chenoweth brothers, they love each other dearly, but there is sibling rivalry. Brian tried to beat Dan's time in the 1600 from Thursday. It is a healthy rivalry, they really push each other and it is fun to watch."

Placing second for the Leafs were senior Byron Stanley in the high jump, clearing the bar at 6-0 followed by Leamen in the long jump with a final mark of 19-9. Sophomore Chris Brooks took second in the shot put behind Paradiso with a toss of 45-00 1/4 while freshman Aaron Schilling jumped to a second-place finish in the triple jump at 37-11. Senior Nathan Schlindwein ended the 3200-m run in second with a final time of 10:30.27 while Leamen grabbed another second in the 100-m dash in 11.15. In the 300-m intermediate hurdles, senior Eric Darwin took second in 42.81 while D. Chenoweth came in second to brother B. Chenoweth in the 1600-m run in 4:37.96.

Russell claimed third in the pole vault at 11-00 while junior Caleb Diericx took third in the triple jump with a final leap of 37-02. Junior Robert Reese came in third in the 800-m run with a time of 2:17.78 followed by Nordstrom in the 400-m dash, crossing the line in 56.21. Leamen added a third-place finish in the 200-m dash with a final time of 23.31

while Schlindwein finished in third in the 1600-m run, taking the tape in 4:53.14.

In freshmen/ sophomore action, sophomore Josh Olson won the discus event with a final throw of 106-10 1/2 while sophomore Jeremy Peters took the high jump with a bar-clearing height of 5-6. Sophomore Andrew Timmerman won the pole vault, clearing the bar at 9-0, followed by sophomore Elliott Kenney claiming first in the triple jump with a final mark of 37-7 1/2.

The 3200-m relay of sophomore Erik Kowitz and freshmen Andy Collis, Sammy Reyes and Jon Fleming won the race in 9:43.62, followed by the 400-m relay of freshman Jacob Kuban, Peters, sophomore Beau Neece and S. Reschke with a first-place finish in 47.00. The 1600-m relay of Collis, sophomores Bren Gillespie and Jesse Gessel and Peters took the field in 3:56.24.

Freshman Ryan Kotecki claimed first in the 3200-m run for the Leafs with a final time of 11:19.74 while Fleming won the 800-m run in 2:21.88. Sophomore Tom Blean ended the 1600-m run with a first-place finish for Geneseo in 5:11.87 followed by Kuban taking the 200-m dash in 24.82.

"The conditions were very windy, which affected our performances—we were battling the wind," Fredericks said. "We put up good efforts and accomplished our goals. We strongly believe this experience will be invaluable."
