Brian Chenoweth Leads Leaf Effort with All-State Performance in 3200

Brian Chenoweth destroyed his personal best by over 7 seconds to nail all-state honors in the 3200 meter run on Saturday. Brian is the first Leaf to earn All-State honors since 1991.

In Friday's Prelim's the Leafs had several strong efforts but unfortunatley, came up short on advancing to Saturday's Finals. Leading the charge were Brian Chenoweth who ran a 4:22 mile (4 second P.R.) and the 400 Meter Relay team of Augie Anderson, Luke Reschke, Cody Leamen, Shaun Russell who ran a P.R. of 43.06 and narrowly missed the our school record by only 2/100's of a second. Luke Reschke ran a strong 400 (49.93) and narrowly missed qualifying while Byron Stanley, competing with shin splints, cleared 6' 00" and Shuaun Russell (LJ & TJ) had problems with his steps and was only able to get one successful jump in in each event (19' 05 1/2" and 42' 00 3/4".)

The Leafs also had two athletes competing in the 1st annual Open Races held Friday night. Eastern Illinois University held open races that were F.A.T. timed in the 100, 400, and 1600 meter distances. Dan Chenoweth and Nathan Schlindwein both participated in the 1600 running 4:34.34 and 4:48.98 respectfully.

Pioneers, Panthers eye state track

honors in 3,200 relay

> Strong hurdle efforts pace Q-C Class A track participants, D4

CHARLESTON — Alleman's 3,200 relay team members already have one state title to their credit, won last fall in cross country. The Pioneers would surely like to complete the distance team double today.

United Township doesn't have a cross country title, but the Panthers would gladly like the respect that a medal in the 3,200 relay would bring.

Both teams have a chance — Alleman in Class A and UT in AA — to bring home medals in the distance relay in today's finals at the IHSA state boys' track and field meet, located at O'Brien Stadium on the Eastern Illinois University campus.

In its preliminary Class A race, the Pioneers needed a lap from opening leg Alex Knobloch to get his legs underneath him. He then took over the lead in the second lap, and teammates Shane Shemek, Nathaniel Hird and Troy DeBlieck never relinquished it until the last lap.

"I just wanted to make sure I had a little left for (today)," said Knobloch, who with DeBlieck also ran on Alleman's 1,600 relay. "I normally like pacing myself a lot and then run a sub-split (going faster than on the first lap) on the second one. I'm really happy with that, and I want to try to keep doing it."

Nathaniel Hird's third leg was an extremely solid one and helped ensure a finals qualification with an 8:09.32 clocking. That was well below the Pioneers' best time and seventh-best in qualifying.

"We're looking for another championship," Hird said of his team. "Today was just a day where we wanted to see where everybody else was."

UT wasn't very happy to finish second in the slowest of three 3,200 AA heats. But the Panther team of Jordan Jennings, Chris Matthews, Kyle Cameron and Damon Bautista still ran a solid 7:58.06.

"I just had to get out and make sure that I didn't get boxed in," said Jennings, who led off and gave UT the lead.

Matthews held it, with one small exception. "I knew I was going to run my race and I knew I could come back," he said, and he did regain the lead during his second lap.

Their primary competition in the heat, Elmhurst York, loaded up their its third and fourth legs, and Cameron couldn't hold the lead, but he didn't give up any more ground against some quality opposition. "Going through the first time is easier, but the second lap, when you have to fight for everything, that's when it counts," he said.

Bautista, too, didn't give ground, but he couldn't gain any, either, against a formidable York anchor. "Both of their three and four dudes were really strong," he said of York's last two legs. "We're there (in the finals) and that's the main goal for us. We talked about getting to the finals and the finals will take care of itself."

Rock Island had three entries

qualify for finals. Weight thrower Zach Johnson qualified for both the shot put and discus, but wasn't happy with his first-day performance in either event. He's currently seventh in both the shot (53-feet, 7-inches) and the discus (171-2), getting his qualifying marks on his final preliminary throws in both.

"It's been an up-and-down day, mostly down," said Johnson. "Everything was there (in his throws) but each time there was like one or two things that were off. There's always something in the back of my mind, but I wasn't trying to think about (last year's early out in the discus at state). Now I've got to get a good night's sleep, do some dry drills at the hotel and come back (today)."

Johnson's fellow senior, high jumper Aaron Strickland, also qualified for the finals, but it was dicey. He sailed over the first two heights, 6-0 and 6-2, on his first attempts easily enough, but missed twice before making his third attempt at 6-4, good enough to tie for first with 16 other

jumpers. The finalists start over again today.

"The nerves were getting to me, all the good people that are here," Strickland said. "I was just thinking, 'Oh God, I have to do good or a lot of people are going to be upset.' That third attempt, I just had to go with it. It was all or nothing — 6-4 is not up to my usual standard, but I think I can get it (a medal). I won't be as stressed."

Two metro entries in the 3,200 run, Brian Chenoweth of Geneseo in AA and Alex Kelly of Alleman in A, will compete for the one and only time in that event today as well.

Otherwise, all other metro entries failed to qualify. Geneseo ran a 400-meter relay time that would have qualified had the Maple Leafs been in another heat.

"It hurts a lot, knowing we were faster than a team that made it to finals," Maple Leaf Luke Reschke said. "It should happen that the fastest guys run in the finals. ... The level of competition is so high here. The only way you can advance is to be really good and work hard enough to get there."

Leafs compete with

the best of the best

Geneseo was represented by six athletes in the 2005 IHSA State boys' track and field meet last weekend, Friday and Saturday, May 27-28, in Charleston.

"Boy, the competition is tough," Head Coach Don Fredericks said. "And this group has accomplished a lot this season that no team has in a long while."

Competing in field events were junior Shaun Russell in both the long jump and triple jump and senior Byron Stanley in the high jump. Russell finished 10th in preliminary flight No. 1 of the long jump with a leap of 19-5 1/2 and took sixth in the triple jump in prelim flight No. 1, with a final mark of 42 3/4. In the high jump, Stanley cleared the bar at 6-0 for an 11th place finish in prelim flight No. 2.

"Shaun Russell had a tremendous accomplishment, qualifying in the triple and long jump and, hopefully, this will be a learning experience," Fredericks said. "Byron Stanley was battling shin splints and was frustrated, but realizes that his best jumping days are ahead of

him. And being a two-time state qualifier is a tremendous accomplishment."

On the track, the 4x100-meter relay of seniors Augie Anderson, Luke Reschke and Cody Leamen, and Russell, raced to a third-place finish in prelim heat No. 5 with a time of 43.06 seconds, while Reschke came in fourth in heat No. 4 of the 400-m dash in 49.93.

"The 4x100 ran their fastest of the season, just missing a second record by two-one hundredths of a second," Fredericks said. "They did a tremendous job.

"Luke Reschke blazed another strong race and was in the hunt, but just missed the finals," Fredericks said.

Senior Brian Chenoweth placed in the top 10 in both the 3200-m run and the 1600-m run prelims. Chenoweth took seventh in prelim heat No. 2 in the 1600-m run, crossing the finish line in 4:22.78, and ninth in the final section No. 2 of the 3200-m run with a time of 9:25.25. Chenoweth destroyed his personal best by more than seven seconds to nail all-state honors in the 3200-m run on Saturday. Brian is the first Leaf to earn All-State honors since 1991,

Fredericks said.

"Brian Chenoweth ran the 1600 the first time fresh and took advantage and ran a personal best," Fredericks said. "He ran a tremendous race.

"And in the 3200, he ran an extremely tactical race that played to his benefit," Fredericks said.

The Leafs ended the season with a NCIC championship and six state qualifiers. Plus, nine first-place finishes out of 12 competitions, two thirds and one fifth.

"We had a very successful years in the past and, in my mind, this year's team was the strongest boys' team we've had," Fredericks said. "Top to bottom, this team gave any thing we wanted and more.

"We had a lot of fun and memories and there will be big shoes to fill next year," Fredericks said. "But right now we are going to savor this season.

"I saw a tremendous amount of potential and the team improved by leaps and bounds," Fredericks said. "We are sad to see the season end and the guys were at their best when it counted the most and it is something to be very proud of."









UT relay, RI's Johnson collect bronze

CHARLESTON — Who were those guvs? Mighty Elmhurst York, kings of the distance running events for years, both in cross country and track, seemed more than a bit surprised that a team in black and orange briefly was ahead of them on the last lap of the 3,200 relay Saturday in the IHSA Class AA state boys' track and field meet at O'Brien Stadium on the Eastern Illinois University campus.

Yes, the Dukes came back to win. But on the awards stand, some introductions to the United Township relay members, who wound up a gutsy third, were definitely in

"All year, it seems, we've been the underdogs," UT senior Kyle Cameron said of his teammates. "We were underdogs in cross country last fall, and we were underdogs here. We came in in fifth place and came out of nowhere to get third. Even at the awards stand, they (the York guys) were asking who we were.'

UT blazed to an early lead when Jordan Jennings ran a strong split (1:55) to put the Panthers second, with second leg Chris Matthews taking the lead from there.

"We didn't need to worry, we just stayed calm. The teams we spent our time worrying about, should have been worrying about us," Matthews said. "I felt good during that first 200, but I might have taken it out too

Still, UT was never any farther back than third. The Panthers' anchor leg. Damon Bautista, stayed on the heels of York and Mt. Prospect, which wound up second. On the backstretch of the final lap, Bautista even went into the lead for about 75 meters. only to be passed on the far turn.

"I wanted them to have to earn it from me; I wasn't going to give it to them." Bautista said of his gutsy move. "That's the way I run. I've never been passed before in

this race except for right now."


Alleman, too, picked up a medal in the Class A 3,200 relay. After briefly leading in the first leg, the Pioneers wound up sixth.

"We knew Eureka (the eventual race winner) would try to destroy everybody else. I was just wanting to get Shane (Shemek, the second leg) a headstart," leadoff leg Alex Knobloch said of his leg, a 1:58 split.

But there was a sense of urgency that the Pioneers weren't all that used to seeing in the races they'd had throughout the season.

"It was the first time that we really ran against competition all season. We didn't run against UT at the Big Six; they didn't run their elite team there," anchor Troy DeBlieck said. "We didn't really have to prove anything to anybody in this relay. We did our best. We had a title in cross country. and I was the sixth runner and didn't get a lot of attention, so it's cool to be able to run with these guys. No doubt in my mind, we'll be back next year."

Rock Island's Zach Johnson was the only

metro track athlete to earn two individual medals. On his final throw in the Class AA shot, he had a put of 57 feet, 1 inch, which vaulted him from ninth to third. Then, later in the afternoon in the discus, he was able to find a couple more feet over his qualifying effort Friday, finishing with a throw of 173-9 to move him up from seventh to sixth.

"I couldn't get it (his discus throws) to stay flat. Everything else was there. But it's all right. It would be better if I was higher, though. I haven't finished this bad all season," Johnson said of his sixth-place effort. "(RI alums Marcus King and Eddie Williams), they called me last night, and they told me to keep a cool head and to stay

That's what happened on his last shot effort. "Everything just came together; the pressure is always there on every throw," Johnson said. "If I could have gotten it higher, it would have been at least a 59 (feet put). The block was there, the release was just too high.'

Johnson knows he's now part of the tradition of RI throwers. "I'll have them ready for next year, guaranteed," he said of his younger teammates.

Brian Chenoweth of Geneseo had a stated goal of placing in the Class AA 3,200. It looked like an uphill challenge, given his 24th seed, but he pulled it off by steadily moving through his heat field, finishing ninth overall.

"Things really turned out exactly like I wanted. I think I looked up, with about 600 to 1,000 meters to go, and figured out I was in ninth and felt good about where I was,' Chenoweth said. "I thought I could pass a kid or two, but that didn't happen. This (finish) was the best I've ever been, individually."

Aledo's Jon Swanson earned some family bragging rights with a fourth-place medal in the Class A 110 hurdles, nearly matching his brother Jeromy's silver in the 300 back in 2001. "He's still got the 300, but I've got the 110s now," Swanson said. "It's a great way to finish a career, hopefully it's a good enough time that I can show the coach at Illinois (where he hopes to walk on)."

Morrison's Sammy Biggs medaled for the second time in as many years in the 300 hurdles, but he wasn't happy with his

fourth-place finish.

"I'm really disappointed. I knew I had a good chance to win this year, but I didn't run a clean race and I stuttered (in front of the hurdles) too much. I didn't have a clean race all year, and that really upsets me,' Biggs said. "I've just got to come back and train harder next year."

Westmer's Keith Lincoln put the final touch on his high school career and the Warriors' athletic history with a ninthplace finish in the 110 hurdles.

"It just feels great to make it to Saturday: I've been trying for three years," Lincoln said. "To be one of the top nine in the state, it makes you feel as big as a mountain. It was awesome, just an awesome feeling.'

Fulton's Matt Ottens had some trouble down the homestretch of the 300 hurdles final, nearly stumbling over the last two hurdles to wind up eighth overall in 40.80. Still, he remained upbeat.

"When I started coming around the corner, I started hitting them and I could never get back to to the right form," Ottens said. "It always seemed like this year was always me in back of Ted and Sammy. It's just unbelievable that we all can get medals and stand on the podium together. It's a great

Bureau Valley got two medals from junior Mike Grieve in Class A Saturday. Grieve took third in the 3,200 and eighth in the 1,600, while Storm teammate Josh Coyle wound up fourth in the discus. Rock Island's Aaron Strickland just missed out on a medal in the AA high jump, missing all three attempts at 6-6 and tying for 10th place overall. Alleman's Alex Kelly (19th) and AlWood's Cliff Miles (27th) competed but did not place in the Class A 3,200 run.
