

Leafs claim third against tough competition

Leafs Place a Strong 3rd at U.T. Invite



Shaun Russell placed first in the Triple Jump at Saturday's U.T. Invite with a jump of 42' 04". Also placing first were: Chris Brooks in the B Division of the Shot Put (47' 04"); Jaran Heaton in the C Division of the 110 Meter High Hurdles (17.71); and Cody Leamen in the B Division of the 100 Meter Dash (11.83)

On Saturday the Leafs traveled to East Moline to participate in the 12-Team United Township Invitational. The weather conditions were near perfect as the team responded with many season bests in the A-B-C formatted meet.

The Geneseo boys' track and field team finished a strong third out of 12 at the UTHS Invite, Saturday, April 9 against some tough competition. Rock Island took first with 227.83 points followed by UT with 185 and Geneseo with 183.33.

The Leafs claimed 34 of the top five finishes in individual and relay events; five first and second-place finishes, 10 thirds, six fourths and eight fifths.

"Third place at that meet was great; it is a high powered meet," Head Coach Don Fredericks said. "The boys had many strong performances.

"We love the concept of an ABC meet because it gives three different athletes the chance to be our No. 1 person in an event," Fredericks said. "It gives them a chance to step up and excel, many people shined at the meet."

Claiming firsts in their respective events were sophomore Bren Gillespie in high jump C, clearing the bar at 5-9, followed by sophomore Chris Brooks in the shot put B class with a heave

of 47-05. Junior Shaun Russell grabbed a first-place victory in triple jump A division with a final mark of 42-04 while senior Cody Leamen took first in the 100-meter dash B, crossing the line in 11.83 seconds. Freshman Jaran Heaton grabbed first in the 110-m hurdles C division, clocking in at 17.71.

Senior Luke Reschke claimed one of the five second-place finishes for the Leafs in the long jump A division with a final leap of 20-11 1/4. The 400-m relay team of junior Kyle Glazier, Leamen, Reschke and Russell, crossed the finish line in 44.49 for second place.

"Shaun Russell won the triple jump with a lifetime best and the 4x100 ran a great race," Fredericks said.

Senior Brian Chenoweth also took home a second-place finish with a final time of 9:39.87 in the 3200-m run A division while Russell took second in the 100-m dash A in 11.67. Sophomore Dan Chenoweth took the last second-place finish for Geneseo with a 4:39.68 in the 1600-m

run B.

"In the 100-m dash, Shaun Russell was close to first in the A division, going up against tough UT and Rock Island sprinters," Fredericks said. "And Cody Leamen won the B race. Both guys ran tremendous races.

"Brian Chenoweth ran a magnificent 3200-m race, taking 21 seconds off his lifetime best and it was a great race behind a UT All-Stater in cross-country," Fredericks said. "Brian is trying to make a point, and we are glad to have him here. He was one of our top men of the meet."

In third place for Geneseo were senior Byron Stanley in the high jump A, clearing the bar at 5-10 and junior Justin Heaton in the high jump B at 5-6. Freshman Jacob Kuban took third in the long jump B division with a final mark of 19-1/2 while senior Brady Piepenbrink claimed third in the pole vault C with a final height of 10-00.

Junior Joe Paradiso brought home a third-place victory in the shot put A division with a 51-05 final heave while D. Chenoweth

came in third in the 800-m run B in 2:06.63 and sophomore Nate Silver in the 800-m run C in 2:08.20. In the 400-m dash A, Reschke raced to a third-place finish, crossing the line in 50.73 while B. Chenoweth took third in the 1600-m run A with a final time of 4:33.89 and senior Nathan Schlindwein in the 1600-m run C, clocking in at 4:45.41.

"Joe Paradiso had three personal bests in the shot put in that meet, which is outstanding," Fredericks said. "Chris Brooks also threw over 47-feet which is a best for him."

Sophomore Corey Akers placed fourth in discus C with a final throw of 109-01 while sophomore Elliott Kenney took fourth in the triple jump C division with a mark of 37-06. Three Leafs claimed fourth-place finishes in the 300 intermediate hurdles, senior Eric Darwin in division A with a time of 43.10, sophomore Wolfe Repass in B in 44.68 and freshman Jaran Heaton in division C, clocking in at 45.43. The freshmen/

sophomore 1600-m relay team of Kenney, Kuban and freshmen Andy Collis and Chance Nordstrom raced to a fourth-place finish with a final combined time of 4:00.47.

Placing in fifth for Geneseo were Leamen in long jump C with a final leap of 18-3 1/4 and senior Brian Sandoval in the pole vault B division, clearing the bar at 11-00. Freshman Aaron Schilling took fifth in the triple jump B division with a 38-

06 mark while the 3200-m relay team of Schlindwein, Silver, Nordstrom and D. Chenoweth also came in fifth, crossing the finish line in 8:24.28. In the 3200-m run B division, sophomore Blake Wyffels finished fifth with a time of 10:52.49 and freshman Ryan Kotecki finished the 3200-m C in fifth in 11:08.65. Freshman Shane Reschke ended the 400-m dash B division in fifth, clocking in at 54.44, while senior Augie Anderson took the tape in fifth in the 200-m dash B in 24.88.

"Our goal is to have personal bests and compete for personal bests," Fredericks said. "And if we keep achieving this goal we will be pretty good. Competing for personal pride and best is a good approach and that will lead to a successful season.

"We are moving in the right direction for the big meets," Fredericks said. "The momentum is in the right direction."

The Leafs will be in action this Tuesday, April 19 for their next NCIC match-up at Ottawa at 4:30 p.m.

Rocks run away with Kiwanis Invitational title

The local Class AA boys track contingent had a banner day at Saturday's United Township Kiwanis Invitational.

Rock Island took the team title with 227.83 points, outpointing second-place United Township (185), third-place Geneseo (183.33), and fifth-place Moline (143.5). Other locals fared well as Pleasant Valley (98 points) took seventh, Alleman (64.33) 10th, and Sherrard (62) 11th.

While all local teams had successful days, no team was as successful as the Rocks.

In the A-B-C formatted invite, the Rocks relied on their throwers, who scored two firsts and a fourth in the shot and one first and two seconds in the discus. Zach Johnson won the Class A shot (56-feet, 6-inches) and second in the discus (160-5.5). Cordale Thornton (42-9) won the Class C shot. Cody Bower (139-6) won the Class B discus.

"Our throwers did their normal things for us," said Rock Island coach Ed Lillis. "Plus, Aaron Strickland had a nice 6-4 finish in the high jump to finish first. Our field events were very solid today."

On the track, the Rocks also received solid performances by their relays and sprinters. Rock Island won the 1600-, 800- and 400-meter relays, as well as titles in the 100 A and C divisions.

"We thought we'd have our hands full in a lot of the sprints and relays," Lillis said. "There was some tough competition today, but we had a lot of great efforts in every event."

Perhaps giving the Rocks some of their best efforts was Raphael Brown. The day's "Golden Boy" grabbed firsts in the open 100 (11.52 seconds) as well as part of the 1600, 800 and 400 relays.

"He's (Brown) progressed so much," Lillis said. "He's really starting to take over both on the track and in the leadership role. His work ethic is showing in his and his teammates' performances."

Almost matching Brown's point production was UT's Jordan Jennings. He took top A

honors in the 200 (23.34) and 400 (50.44). He also ran a blazing final lap of the 1600 relay to give UT a second in the event.

"I took off a little early and cost my team in the 400 relay, so I wanted to make it up to them," Jennings said. "Westbrooks (Terrell) ran a great race in the 1600, and I didn't want to let that go to waste."

Jennings also ran hard in his individual races.

"The 400, I was a little disappointed," Jennings said. "But in the 200, I felt a lot faster against some of the best competition we've faced all year."

While Jennings may have been humble about his performance, his coach had nothing but rave reviews.

"He just refused to lose out there," UTHS coach Mike Patterson said. "He kept out-kicking the guys in the 400, and the 200 he had to come back to win. He really battled."

Also drawing high praise from Patterson was UT distance

runner Kyle Cameron, who won the 3200 (9:38.61) and was second in the 1600 (4:30.20).

"He had two excellent races," said Patterson. "He had PRs in each, and really ran both well down the stretch."

Third-place Geneseo was led by Shaun Russell and Brian Chenoweth. Russell was tops in the triple jump (42-4) and second in the 100 (11.67). Chenoweth was second in the 3200 (9:39.87) and third in the 1600 (4:33.89). Luke Reschke added a second in the long jump (20-11.25).

For Moline, Matt Brown had a second in the 'A' 400 (50.65) and Shawn Ledbetter had a pair of golds in 'B' 300 (42.07) and 110 (16.25) hurdles.

Alleman's Pioneers were led by Nathaniel Hird's fourth in the 3200 (9:49.65).

For Sherrard, the 800 relay team of Ray Crawley, Kris Myers, Josh Wilson and Matt Warner took a second place finish in 1:34.37 and Warner (11.70) was third in the 100.
