Geneseo gets charged up at McCormick Invite

The Geneseo boys' track and field team prepared itself for the race for the NCIC title with a win over Annawan/Wethersfield and a third-place finish in the John McCormick Invite.

Geneseo vs. Annawan/Wethersfield

In a May 9 showdown between two area teams, the Leafs defeated the visiting Annawan/Wethersfield Titans, 98-48.

"We did a good job," Head Coach Don Fredericks said. "We always enjoy this meet to compete against neighboring schools since a lot of the kids know each other.

"We did hold a large amount out," Fredericks said. "And it is nice to have the option to compete or not. The people who did compete did a nice job, it is a tune-up meet for the NCIC meet."

Nabbing firsts for Geneseo were Chris Brooks in the discus with a throw of 128-7 and in the shot put with a heave of 45-6; Elliot Kenney in the triple jump with a leap of 39 1/2; and the 3200-meter relay of Blake Wyffels, Chance Nordstrom, Robert Reese and Jon Fleming, taking the tape in eight minutes and 58.81 seconds.

Also, the 400-m relay of Kenney, Beau Neece, Jeremy Peters and Mason Kernan in 46.96; Sam Woolsey in the 100-m dash with a time of 11.87 and in the 200-m dash in 24.44; Andy Collis in the 800-m run in 2:13.31; the 800-m relay of Kenney, Neece, Peters and Kernan in 1:39.70; Ryan Kotecki in the 1600-m run, crossing the finish line in 4:57.46; and the 1600-m relay of Kenney, Nordstrom, Collis and Nate Silver in 3:44.58.

Placing second for the Leafs were Corey Akers in the discus at 120-4, Bren Gillespie in the high jump with a leap of 5-11, Alex Guiscern in the long jump with a mark of 14-11 1/2, Tom Blean in the pole vault, clearing the bar at 10-0 and Tyler Root in the shot put with a mark of 40-10.

Other second-place finishers included Dyson Wake in the 3200-m run in 11:58.44; Tom Peal in the 100-m hurdles with a time of 17.77 and in the 300-m hurdles at 45.28; Kernan in the 100-m dash at 11.90; Silver in the 400-m dash in 54.73; Josh Lodge in the 1600-m run in 5:00.78; and Peters in the 200-m dash in 24.61.

Those bringing home third-place finishes were Neece in the 200-m dash at 24.65 and the 100-m dash in 11.96; Ben Koenig in the 300-m hurdles in 46.13 and in the 100-m hurdles in 18.88; Fleming in the 400-m dash with a time of 58.00; Garrett Harris in the 800-m run at 2:27.47; Austin Swanson in the long jump with a leap of 14-10 1/2; and Blake VerStraete in the discus with a toss of 116-3.

John McCormick Invite

Led by Dan Chenoweth, who gave the Leafs their only two first-place finishes of the meet, Geneseo came away with third at its own John McCormick Invite May 4.

"We won the meet last year," Fredericks said. "We didn't have a great night with some things going wrong. All and all, it was disappointing. We were hoping to make a run at Galesburg, who has a great team."

Chenoweth paced the Leafs in the 1600-m and 3200-m runs, taking the tape in the 1600-

m run with a time of 4:20.50 and the 3200-m run in 9:44.96.

"Dan ran a tremendous 4:20 mile, the third fastest in school history," Fredericks said. "We had a lot of strong efforts across the board."

Shane Reschke grabbed two more top-five places for the squad with a second-place finish in the long jump with a leap of 20-0, and third in the 400-m dash in 52.96. Shaun Russell also took home two top-place finishes with third in the triple jump with a mark of 42-7 1/2 and the long jump at 19-8 1/4.

The 4x400-m relay of Reschke, Justin Heaton, Jacob

Kuban and Wolfe Repass took third with a time of 3:31.00, followed by the 4x800-m relay of Nordstrom, Wyffels, Reese, Fleming placed fourth in 8:54.90. The 4x100-m relay of Tyler Loucks, Reschke, Kuban and Kernan also came away with a fourth-place finish in 44.98, while Kuban took fourth in the triple jump at 42-0 and Brooks in the shot put with a heave of 48-10 1/2.

Placing fifth were Loucks in the 100-m dash, crossing the finish line in 11.35; Repass in the 300-m hurdles in 41.65; and Gillespie in the high jump, clearing the bar at 5-9.


Others competing for the Leafs were Silver in the 800-m run in 2:03.76; Loucks in

the 200-m dash with a time of 23.55, and Peters in 24.06; Drew Croegaert in the 300-m hurdles in 42.84; and the 4x200-m relay of Loucks, Kenney, Kuban and Justin Heaton in 1:35.97. Also, Jaran Heaton in the pole vault with a leap of 10-3, Root in the discus at 113-10, and Curt Jensen at 112-5.

The Leafs vie for their second NCIC title today at 3 p.m. in Ottawa.


"Sterling is the team to beat and, hopefully, we can contend with them," Fredericks said. "Dixon and Ottawa are also dangerous teams."

"We look for the guys to have season-best efforts (at the NCIC meet)," Fredericks said.
