Sterling, Bright love the

rainy night at Ottawa

Senior wins three events; Warriors win title

OTTAWA — On a gloomy night, Sterling simply looked on the Bright side.

Led by triple-winner Sean Bright, Sterling ran away with top honors in the NCIC boys track meet Friday night at King Field in Ottawa.

The Golden Warriors finished with 144 points, well ahead of runnerup Geneseo (99). Rounding out the top five were Ottawa (84), Rochelle (62) and Dixon (45).

According to the seeds, Sterling and Geneseo were about even, but the Warriors came up big.

"We've been looking at this for a couple of years," Sterling coach Bob Brown said. "I'm almost speechless at this point. The kids just did an unbelievable job.

"We knew it was going to be an awful night weather-wise and we told our kids, 'Just forget it. Just go out there and compete.'

"All year our kids competed, but we've always had something

unlucky. Somebody was hurt, somebody was sick, somebody was gone — it's been kind of a rollercoaster year. I just told them to go out and compete, and it will make it all worthwhile if we win it."

Bright agreed.

"All Coach Brown and the other coaches did was prep us," Bright added. "They were like, 'We looked at the sheets and you guys are as good as anybody out there. You guys can run with Geneseo. You guys can compete with Geneseo.' They said we could handle it, and we did it."

Bright was the star of the meet with wins in the high jump, triple jump and 110-meter high hurdles. He lost a close race to Geneseo's Wolfe Repass in the 300 intermediate hurdles.

"The high jump was the first one I won, and the long jump was right after that," Bright said. "All right, I had two, but then came the 110s. I had just started running 110s this year, so that was a big shock to me. Everybody was like, 'You can sweep. You can sweep.' That was in the back of my mind, but I was more focused on the team NCIC championship."

The Golden Warriors were dominant in the field events. Joining Bright in the winner's circle were Joe Schneiderbauer in the triple jump and Colin Fane in the shot put. Schneiderbauer's 44-3 3/4 was a personal best by seven inches.

Sterling also racked up big points in the pole vault, where Tim Gaumer and Schneiderbauer were second and third.

"We came out of the field events so well," Brown said. "Our kids did a tremendous job in the field events, and then we kept it going on the track. It was a great night."

The Golden Warriors wrapped up the evening in style as the 1,600 relay team of Kymin Hussung, Jordan Rodriguez, Sam Megli and Schneiderbauer finished first.

The title was Sterling's 46th in 76 years of NCIC track and field. Next year, the conference will hold two meets, one for the small-division schools and one for the big schools.

Leading the way for Rochelle were a pair of champions, Marcus Peters and Joey Johnson.

Peters edged Sterling's Megli by .04 in the 800 meters. It was a photo finish and took several minutes to determine who the winner was.

Johnson threw of 160-9 to win the discus, a personal best by four feet.

"I just kept it in my head that I've got to get one good one," Johnson said. "I knew there was good competition here. I knew I could get one out there that was pretty decent. The first one I scratched, but the second one, I got after it."

Dixon struggled all night. The Dukes best finish was by James Wohrley, second in the high jump. Andrew Burnell was third in the shot put and discus.

For Rock Falls, Lance Mallot was third in the 800 and fourth in the 200. Chris Ratliff was third in the 1,600. Jeremy Hardy was fourth in both hurdles races, while Cody Gridley was fourth in the high jump and triple jump.

Leafs battle weather to

place second in NCIC

With four first-place finishes, the Leafs' boys' track and field team couldn't quite defend its NCIC title as the squad came in second to Sterling May 12.

"We certainly wanted to win conference but, unfortunately, it wasn't in the cards," Head Coach Don Fredericks said. "I would like to congratulate Sterling on having a tremendous meet."

Dan Chenoweth nabbed two firsts for the team in the 1600-meter run with a time of four minutes and 32.61 seconds, and in the 3200-m, taking the tape in 10:08.03. Wolfe Repass took home a first in the 300-m hurdles in 41. 16 and the 4x100-m relay of Tyler Loucks, Shane Reschke, Jacob Kuban and Mason Kernan

crossed the finish line in 45.22 for first.

"Great things did happen," Fredericks said. "Dan won the 1600 and the 3200 and the 4x100 won, which was a highlight. Also, Wolfe Repass ran a great race in the 300-m hurdles."

In second was the 4x400-m relay of Reschke, Kuban, Justin Heaton and Repass, with a time of 3:35.29; the 4x800-m relay of Nate Silver, Blake Wyffels, Chance Nordstrom and Chenoweth in 8:21.09; and Shaun Russell in the long jump with a leap of 20-7.

"A lot of kids got personal bests on a nasty day," Fredericks said. "The weather was a challenge and the guys did the best they could with the weather and we are proud of their efforts. Our goal was to get personal bests and com-

pete with the competition and we are proud of the guys."

Reschke came away with third in the long jump with a mark of 20-5, followed by Kuban in third in the triple jump at 41-10.

Justin Heaton placed fourth in the 400-m dash with a time of 52.54, while Loucks took fourth in the 100-m dash in 12.06. The 4x200-m relay of Loucks, Elliott Kenney, Kuban and Kernan came away with a fourth-place finish in 1:35.52, while Chris Brooks finished fourth in the shot put with a heave of 47-4 1/4.

Jaran Heaton ended the pole-vault event in fifth place with a leap of 11-3, and Silver took fifth in the 800-m run in 2:07.97.

Others placing for the Leafs were Loucks in the 200-m dash at 24.34; Robert Reese in the 800-m run with a time of

2:21.49; Wyffels in the 1600-m run in 4:57.98; Ryan Kotecki in the 3200-m run in 10:24.93; Repass in the 110-m hurdles in 16.51; and Drew Croegaert in the 300-m hurdles in 43.62.

Also, Bren Gillespie in the high jump with a leap of 5-9; Jeremy Peters also in the high jump, clearing the bar at 5-5; Tom Blean in the pole vault at 8-5; Kenney in the triple jump at 39-6; Joe Paradiso in the shot put with a heave of 46 1/2; Brooks in the discus with a throw of 128-6; and Corey Akers at 121-3 in the discus.

The junior varsity also came away with second place in conference to Ottawa.

Placing first were Josh Lodge in the 3200-m run, taking the tape in 10:48.19; the 4x100-m relay of Tom Peal, Logan Patton, Cameron McNeil and Jaran Heaton in

47.32; and Curt Jensen in the discus with a throw of 131-2.

In second, the 4x400-m relay of Andy Collis, Aaron Schilling, Jake Ballegeer and Nordstrom with a time of 3:49.26; Jaran Heaton in the 110-m hurdles in 17.45; Nordstrom in the 800-m run in 2:08.44; and Patton in the 400-m dash with time of 55.17.

Lodge came in third in the 1600-m run with a time of 5:00.01, and Tyler Toom took third in the pole vault at 9-3. Peal placed fourth in the 300-m hurdles in 45.33 and Ballegeer took fourth in the high jump, clearing the bar at 5-8, while Koenig followed in fifth at 5-4.

Others competing for the Leafs were Shane Miller in the discus with a toss of 91-9; Jensen in the shot put at 40-6 1/4; Joe Snyder in the triple

jump at 32 3/4; the 4x200-m relay of McNeil, Schilling, Koenig and Jaran Heaton with a time of 1:42.09; Koenig in the 300-m hurdles in 46.18; and Eric Windsor in the 3200-m run at 12:29.18.

Also, Kotecki in the 1600-m run in 5:17.00; Jon Fleming in the 800-m run with a time of 2:16.43; and Patton in the 200-m dash at 25.27 and the 100-m dash in 12.48.

The Leafs will vie for a chance at state competition today at 3 p.m. in the Sterling Sectional meet.

"There are 19 teams in the meet, which is the largest and the most competitive sectional," Fredericks said. "We better show up ready to compete. Our goal is to qualify some individuals for state. Also, to have everyone have personal bests. What more could a coach ask for."
