Chenoweth Takes Down 21 Year-Old 3200 Meter School Record as the Leafs Place 7th

On Friday night, Geneseo traveled to Rock Island to participate in the powerful Rock Island Invitational. Considered the premier invitational in the state this weekend, the Leafs put up a plethora of personal bests and placed 7th as a team in the 14-team field. The Leafs competed without Star Senior Shaun Russell who was held out with a sore hamstring.

Pacing the charge was Junior Dan Chenoweth who blistered a solo 9:17.15 (F.A.T. converted) to take down Tim Arnett's 1985 school record of 9:21. Dan then came back and scared the 1600 meter school record with a strong 3rd place effort in 4:21.61 (F.A.T. converted.) The following Leafs earned hardware in this prestigious meet:

Chenoweth takes down 21-year-old record

Record-breaking feats for the boys' track and field team are now beginning to be a regular occurrence for Geneseo. This time, Dan Chenoweth took his turn doing the record-breaking on the track at the high-powered Rock Island Invite April 21 where the Leafs placed seventh out of 14 teams.

Chenoweth took down a 21-year-old Geneseo record in the 3200-meter run set by Tim Arnett in 1985. Chenoweth took the tape for first in nine minutes and 17.39 seconds in the A division, which is well under the state-qualifying cut at 9:35 and was the Leafs only first-place finish.

"There are a lot of impressive school records and this is one of the most impressive records," Head Coach Don Fredericks said. "This record has stood the test of time and the way Dan broke it was extremely impressive. He was pretty much by himself most of the race and the plan was if he felt good at the mile he would go for it and he did. He was a little behind going into the last lap, but threw down a great last lap to get the record."

"Dan was so happy and had a huge smile on his face, it was a special moment," Fredericks said. "This was a classic example of if you work hard for it, it means even more."

Placing second for Geneseo were Chris Brooks in shot put B with a heave of 46 1/2, and Shane Reschke in the 400-m B dash with a time of 51.81.

The Leafs nabbed five third-place finishes from Jesse Gessel in high jump B with a leap of 5-9, Jeremy Peters in high jump C at 5-7, and Drew Croegaert in the 110-m high hurdles C in 16.75. Also, Gessel took third in the 400-m C dash in 53.63, Wolfe Repass in the 300-m intermediate hurdles A with a time of 41.53, and Chenoweth in the 1600-m run A division, crossing the finish line in 4:21.85 (the third fastest in school history).

In fourth place for the Leafs were Curt Jensen in discus B with a toss of 127-2, Jacob Kuban in long jump B with a mark of 19-8, Tom Peal in pole vault C with a leap of 9-6, and Joe Paradiso in shot put A with a heave of 48-11 1/2.

"Kids had a ton of personal bests," Fredericks said. "And Shane Reschke had the third

fastest sophomore 400-m dash, which was a great performance, and Curt Jensen had a nine-foot improvement in the discus."

Others taking home fourth-place finishes were Tyler Root in shot put C at 42 3/4, Ryan Kotecki in the 3200-m B run in 10:32.20, Josh Lodge in the 3200-m C run with a time of 10:45.28, and Jaran Heaton in the 110-m high hurdles at 16.72.

Others competing for Geneseo were Root in discus C at 111-8, Bren Gillespie with a leap of 5-7 in high jump A, Reschke in the long jump with a mark of 20-3 1/2, and Aaron Schilling in long jump C at 17-10. In the triple jump, Elliott Kenney, B division, finished with a mark of 37-7 1/2, and Croegaert, C division, at 36-7 3/4. The 800-m freshmen/sophomore medley relay of Schilling, Cameron McNeil, Logan Patton and Kuban crossed the finish line in 1:43.07, while the 400-m relay of Tyler Loucks, Beau Neece, Peters and Mason Kernan finished in 45.81.

In the 100-m dash, Reschke completed the race in 11.63, Loucks in 11.87, and Kuban, 12.04. Those racing for Geneseo in the 800-m run were

Nate Silver in 2:04.08, Robert Reese with a time of 2:17.44, and Jon Fleming in 2:12.66, while Justin Heaton finished the 400-m dash in 53.38.

"Tyler Loucks also had a great night and he has never looked better," Fredericks said. "He looked very strong and good in all his events."

Croegaert and Diericx finished the 300-m intermediate hurdles B and C divisions in 43.39 and 45.75, respectively, while Blake Wyffels crossed the finish line in 4:49.17 of the 1600-m run B race and Kotecki in the C race with a time of 5:00.86.

Also, Kuban ended the 200-

m dash in 24.77, Loucks in 23.97, and the 1600-m relay of Repass, Gessel, Croegaert and Justin Heaton with a time of 3:33.84.

The Leafs will next compete in the Sterling Invite at 5 p.m. today, followed by the John McCormick Invite in Geneseo at 4:30 p.m. May 4.

RI relays in top form

'We're probably
the best around'

They made it look so smooth.

But the evidence of just how hard it was for the Rock Island sprint relay team to pull off wins in both the 400- and 800-meter events at Friday's Rock Island Invitational was just as apparent, if a bit more behind the scenes.

There was leadoff leg Raphael Brown, gimping around the Almquist Field infield on a bad right foot (broken bone), despite motoring to an outstanding night (two individual wins in the B flight 100 and 200 dashes as well as the relay wins), which helped the Rocks finish second as a team in the 14-team event.

"We've got four more meets until we have sectionals. We've got (anchor) Richard (Lewis) back and now we've got good chemistry, so the hands (hand-offs) were good," said Brown, who grouched a bit about running the B individual sprints, in part to nurse the foot. "We ran our best times so far in both (relays)."

For his part, Lewis — who'd missed the UT Kiwanis Invite two weeks ago because of a funeral — proved he'd poured everything into his sprint efforts by disappearing into one of the Public Schools Stadium tunnels to the Rocks' locker room, where he had a close encounter with a Rocky bathroom facility.

"I want to say I'm satisfied, because everyone gave it as much as they could tonight," said Lewis, a bit unsteady but better after his episode. "Right now, we're probably the best around, but we're looking for medals at state. We're moving in the right direction."

Not only was Rocks coach Ed Lillis happy with the relays, but the whole team's effort.

"Ecstatic. How about that for a one-word answer?" said RI coach Ed Lillis. "You hate to overstate it, but those kids have a great chemistry. They're working so hard on doing things right. (Overall) I'm so happy for the kids. We had tremendous efforts all around the place."

The efforts started with the relays, where, despite the injuries and illness, the Rocks put up top efforts. The 400 time (43.15) was .01 seconds off the state-qualifying cut and the 800 time (1:29.34) was .9 seconds under, which bodes well for RI's chances.

"Right now we have a lot of injuries, and the team looks to the relays to make up some points," said Eric Lanus, who, with Darnall Evans, mans the key middle legs of the relays. "We'll get it done, once we get stronger. We're going to do some hill work, and we'll get a lot faster. It only gets better from here."

That's true also for Geneseo junior Dan Chenoweth, who blazed to a school-record time in the 3,200-meter run, finishing in 9:17.39, well under the state-qualifying cut, and win-

ning by more than 36 seconds.

"When I came out tonight, I was unsure whether to go for the two-mile (3,200) or the mile (1,600), but the weather was so good. Coach (Don Fredericks) gave me the go-ahead for the school record," said Chenoweth, noting with emphasis that the record was 9:21.

Moline's Dan Hall was the only other local A-flight winner, and he came from behind in the 400 dash to nip Naperville Central's Matt Somers by .01 seconds, finishing in 50.72.

"All four years, it's been more apparent that the quarter (400) was the best race for me. I don't know where that kid (Somers) came from," said the St. Ambrose-bound Hall, who also set a personal-best time in the A-flight 200.
