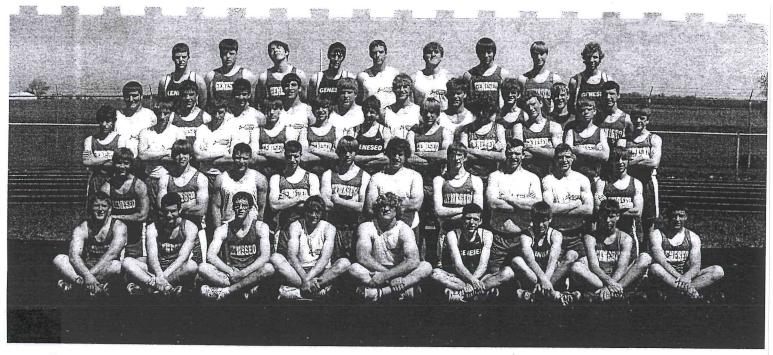

Track Jake it on the run





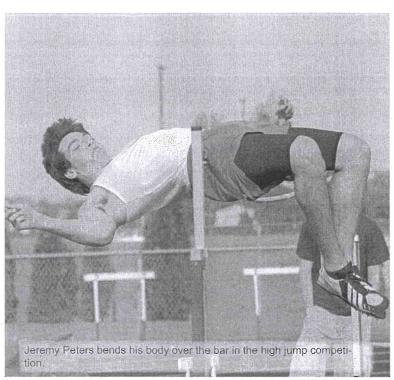
