Rocky brings high hopes to loaded Class AA boys' track sectional

Somewhere next to the term "cautiously optimistic," there has to be a picture of Rock Island High School boys' track coach Ed Lillis.

The running Rocks have won 18 sectional titles in the past 23 years. The hosts also are coming off a 14th straight Western Big 6 Conference title, winning in dominating fashion last weekend.

Yet, Lillis refuses the favorite's tag heading into tonight's Class AA sectional meet at Rock Island Public Schools Stadium.

The field events and running prelims begin at 4 p.m. Finals for the running events start at 5:30.

"I don't know that anybody can say they're the favorite," the longtime Rocks coach said. "There are so many teams, 19 in all, and the talent pool is so deep.

"For example; in the high jump, there are probably 10 kids who could win it. There's not much difference between the top two seeds and the 4-5 kids in a lot of events, either. So a lot of things can happen."

The Rocks have high hopes, though, for their six Big 6 champs.

Junior sprint star Richard Lewis is in four of those events — the 100 and 200 besides anchoring the 400 and 800 relay teams.

Paris Dothard (shot put) and Travis Anderson (3200) were Rocky's other Big 6 winners.

"We want to win the sectional title," Lewis said. "But that's not the focus of the meet. We just want to get as many guys downstate (next weekend) as we can.

And, if we do that, the championship will come with that."

The trouble? The Rocks and last weekend's other local Big 6 winners mix with teams from the NCIC and Western Sun conferences.


Moline's Shawn Ledbetter also won three Big 6 events last weekend — both hurdles and the high jump.

United Township's Quinton Musgrow (long jump) and Luke Martinez (pole vault) were joined by Moline's Colby Schulz (800) and Alleman's Vince Ewald (discus) among the other local winners.

Geneseo's NCIC champs include Dan Chenoweth (3200 and 1600), Andrew Walter (400) and Andrew Burnell (discus).

"This is the way a sectional should be," Lillis said. "It's going to be fun to watch."


6 Leafs Punch State Meet Tickets in 7 Events

On Friday night (5/18) the Leafs traveled to Rock Island to particiate in the 19-team IHSA Sectional Track & Field Finals. The teams were treated to magnificant weather (70 with light winds and low humidity.) The Leafs took advantage of the great weather and put on quite a show. Racking up a monsterous total of 82 points the team missed winning the Sectional Title by just 2 points. Geneseo will be well represented in Charleston and the IHSA Track and Field State Championship as six individuals qualified in 7 events. Leading the way were individual event champions Dan Chenoweth, Jeremy Peters, and Shane Reschke. Chenoweth blistered the track in both the 3200 (9:15) and 1600 meter runs (4:14. as Dan's 1600 meter run took 3 seconds off his personal best and established another school record. Jeremy Peters was seeded 10th in the high jump and shocked the field with his winning jump of 6' 03" which established a new personal best for himself by 2 inches and he barely missed clearing 6' 05". Shane Reschke blasted the homestretch in the 400 Meter Dash and came away with the gold. Also qualifying were Jacob Kuban (2nd in the Triple Jump with a monster jump of 45' 03"...close to a 2 foot personal best); Andrew Walter (2nd in Long Jump); and the 1600 Meter Team of Jacob Kuban, Shane Reschke, Nate Silver, and Andrew Walter) who grabbed 2nd as they took over 4 seconds off the season best time.)

Rocks nip Geneseo for sectional title

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Neither Rock Island's Richard Lewis nor Moline's Shawn Ledbetter managed to make individual trips to the boys' state track meet last spring.

However, both juniors turned that disappointment into inspiration, motivation and, finally, elation Friday night at Rock Island Public Schools Stadium.

Lewis, who anchored Rocky's victorious 400 and 800 relay teams again this year, also swept the 100- and 200-meter dashes to help the Rocks edge Geneseo for the team title at the Class AA Rock Island Sectional.

Ledbetter, who battled hamstring problems a year ago in failing to book a repeat trip to Charleston, finally returned in both hurdling events, winning the 300 intermediates.

All-State senior Chenoweth also advanced to next weekend's state meet in two solo events, winning the 3200 and 1600 for Geneseo.

Chenoweth's Leafs came within four points, 85-81, of winning a sectional title for the

first time. Rocky's won the local event 19 of 24 seasons now, including five straight springs.

'I told you it was going to be close," longtime Rock Island coach Ed Lillis said with a big smile. "With 19 teams here, the depth of talent was really incredible. We had a number of kids set personal records and not make it to state."

Indeed, besides the four entrants involving Lewis, the only other Rocky advancer was Clarence Hood, the runner-up in the 400.

Hood and Lewis teamed up on the 400 relay winner with Lonnie Davis and Darnell Evans. Mark Taylor joined Davis, Evans and Lewis on the winning 800 team.

"I made it downstate with the relays last year, too, but I really missed running the (100 and 200)," Lewis said. "Not this time."

Ditto for Ledbetter.

"As tough as it was to walk away from this meet last year, knowing the season that never took off was over, that's how great it feels now," Ledbetter

Sterling (66), United Township (64) and Sycamore (57) round out the top five team finishers. Galesburg, sixth with 46 points, claimed five individual state advancers. Moline was eighth (33.25); Alleman placed 14th (4).

"For a program from a community our size, to come this close to a power like Rock Island, it really doesn't happen that often," said veteran Geneseo coach Don Fredericks. "It really says something about what our guys accomplished."

Besides Chenoweth, the Leafs victories from Shane Reschke (400) and Jeremy Peters (high jump). Also qualifying for state from Geneseo were event runners-up in the long jump (Andrew Walter), triple jump (Jacob Kuban) and the 1600 relay (Reschke, Walter, Kuban and senior Nate Silver).

"Nobody expected us to do anything in the 4x4," Reschke said. "But, we managed to get another senior downstate.'

"Three of us were already going to state in other events, Walter added. "I think that

helped us relax, take the pressure off and just go out and run."

Quinton Musgrow advanced in two events - winning the long jump and teaming up with Airreo Greer, DeMykhab Teague and Nate Warden on the runner-up 400 relay.

Also qualifying for state from UT were a pair of event runners-up — pole vaulter, Luke Martinez and 800 runner Jerome Harms.

"We're a young team, so the experience of getting down state will really benefit these kids," UT coach Bob Feller said "And two seniors, Jerome and Nate, get rewarded for all of their hard work.

"I was especially glad the relay team made it. Nate was about 80-percent healthy (afters a groin pull last week knocked him out of the Western Big 6 meet). He spent more time in physical therapy than on the track.'

Moline's other advancer was the runner-up 3200 relay team of Colby Schulz, Jonathan Smith, Brian Small and Joe Zahn.
