# Lewis, Chenoweth head Q-C chances at boys' state track meet

### Ledbetter, Martinez also eye medals

Rock Island sprinter Richard Lewis has had to keep proving himself all season, and he's stepped up to the plate each time.

The latest occasion was last weekend's sectional when he posted a state's best time of 10.73 in the 100-meter dash and the state's second best time of 21.74 in the 200.

"It's encouraging (for him to have such good seeds), but you have to keep proving yourself time and time again," RI coach Ed Lillis said. "He's on a good roll right now."

Lewis is definitely the Rocks' best chance at medaling at this weekend's Class AA state track & field championship in Charleston, although their 4x100 and 4x200 relay teams could make it to Saturday if they get good runs and clean handoffs. No one can say they won't be ready.

"We've been prepping for this since December," Lillis said. "The kids know that this is running against the best in the state and it's always a challenge."

▶ Chenoweth to provide excitement: Maple Leaf senior Dan Chenoweth is one of the top high school distance-running seniors in the country, and will show his stuff in a pair of races this weekend.

Chenoweth has the topranked 1600-meter time, two seconds faster than the next closest competitor, and is seeded fifth for Saturday's 3200meter run, although he has the top time in the state this sea-

son and the third best time in the country in the race.

The 3200 race will be one of the premiere high-school races run in the country this year. Ranked in the top five are Chenoweth, Chris Derrick of Neuqua Valley, who has the seventh best time in the country; Marmion's David Grange, with the 12th best time; and cross country state champion Evan Jager, who has the country's 15th best 3200.

▶ Ledbetter leads Maroons: The Maroons' best chance at a medal lies in the feet of Shawn Ledbetter. The Moline junior is ranked 14th in the high hurdles, and seventh in the 300-meter lows. Ledbetter has improved consistently throughout the season, and has the chops to run with the state's best. Moline will also be sending a 4x800 relay.

▶ UT could be vaulting way to podium: Luke Martinez has established himself as one of the best vaulters in a state that is looked at as one of the elite in the country for vaulting. Preliminaries have the bar opening at 13 feet, which could almost immediately cut the field in half. Martinez had his best vault of the season last weekend at sectionals, jumping 14 feet. He'll be in the hunt for a medal if he can repeat that performance.

Another Panther right on the verge of a medal is senior Jerome Harms in the 800. Harms comes in with a time of 1:56.87, his best of the year, and is ranked 13th. To make it to Saturday, he'll have to be in the top 12, as less then a second separate sixth and 18th.

#### Saturday's State Finals Results (5/25)

- 3200 Meter Run: Racing against three of the top ten 3200 Meter runners in the country, Dan Chenoweth toed the line knowing his best chance at a state title was to push the pace and try to drop the competition. Push the pace he did as he took over the lead at 800 meters and roared by the 1600 in just 4:27. Dan held the lead until the final 200 and placed 3rd. Dan's time of 8:57.03 (FAT converted) was a school record and he helped make histiry as this was the first time in IHSA history that 3 runners broke 9 minutes in the state final. Dan's 3rd place finish is the highest Maple Leaf placer since Don Hilmer won the high jump in 1950.
- 1600 Meter Run: Mr. Chenoweth was back at it a little less than 2-hours after his amazing 3200 meter effort. Anyone who watched the race knew from the gun that Dan was still feeling the effects earlier in the day. Cheno battled hard the whole race and barely missed another all-state award as he ended up placing 11th in 4:20.62 (FAT.) His season is not over as he will race twice more (Distance Gala in Elmhurst (6/09) & NIKE Nationals 6/16.)

#### Friday's State Prelim's Results (5/24)

- High Jump: Senior Jeremy Peters' amazing season came to an end when he was unable to clear the opening height of 6' 00". Jeremy's sectional
  upset last Friday night when he was seeded 10th will be talked about for many years to come to future Maple Leafs. BELIEVE.
- Long Jump: Rookie Andrew Walter's remarklable debut season continued with a near miss at Saturday's Finals. The junior jumper's best jump of 21' 00 3/4" narrowly missed making the finals by only 1 inch. Surprisingly, the IHSA meet officials decided not to switch directions and had the athletes jump into a head wind.
- Triple Jump: Rain, Rain go Away. A rain delay of 1 1/2 hours and the decision of the Games Committee to move the field events inside (only 1 runway) doomed junior jumper Jacob Kuban to attempt the almost impossible....that of triple jumping directly after running the 1600 Meter Relay. Amazingly, Jacob popped at 43' 06 1/2" jump. It took 44' 10" to make the finals and without the 1600 Meter Relay effort Jacob probably would have made it. Chalk this one up to a Coaching error by Coach Fredericks. We should have scrapped the relay. Sorry Jacob. Next year you are going to FLY.
- 400 Meter Dash: Junior phenom Shane Reschke added to the proud Reschke tradition of 400 meter racing as he expoded out of the blocks and attacked the backstretch of his 400 meter prelim. Shaner tied up a bit in the homestretch and ended up clocking 52.35 (FAT.) Shane gained valuable experience that will be put to good use next spring.
- 1600 Meter Run: When Senior distance man Dan Chenoweth toed the line for the final heat of the 1600 Meter Run he knew he needed a time of 4:16 or better to make the finals. Dan went out and controlled the race from the gun and ran the easiest looking 4:14.65 (FAT) I have ever seen. He backed off in the homestretch to save some energy for Saturday and missed his own school record by a mear .01. Harvard is lucky to be having this young man coming to school.
- 1600 Meter Relay: The 1600 Meter Relay teams were greated with a downpoor and strong winds. The end result was as strong effort from the Leaf team of Jacob Kuban, Shane Reschke, Nate Silver, and Andrew Walter. Their time of 3:33.97 placed them 8th in their heat. Great Season Men.

## Geneseo standout ready to go the distance

CHARLESTON — Distance races aren't supposed to be real exciting. But when you have four or five of the nation's top mile and 2-milers, the races have a whole new meaning.

Geneseo's Dan Chenoweth owns the third fastest time in the country in the 3200 meter run, and qualified himself for the mile race on Friday, although, after the 3200 (which is the second event of the day) who knows if he'll

have anything left.

"I'm looking forward to the minute I cross the finish line and see how everything played out," Chenoweth said. "It's going to hurt and I'm going to hate myself, but that's what it takes. This is when you want all those hard workouts, long hours and extra mileage to pay off."

Chenoweth has been making his extra work pay off all season long, and came into the state meet with the fastest qualifying mile time. He took it easy in the preliminary, making sure to qualify, but relinquishing the lead on the homestretch.

"Kicking it out on the last 100 would be tough and I wanted to save something for (Saturday)," Chenoweth said of taking second in his heat. "If going a couple tenths slower today saves me a second tomorrow, I'll take that trade-

The tradeoff might not take effect until the mile which will be near the end of the day, and if Friday was any indication, the mile will be fast.

The two heats Chenoweth was not in were much faster, with runners in one heat running their first quarter mile at a sub-4 minute mile time. Loyola's Tom

Robbins used the fast start to put himself in position to make a move on the final stretch, crossing the line in a stunning 4:10.72.

While Chenoweth doesn't have the best seed time in the 3200, there's no doubt all eyes will be on him as the favorite. After all, he has the best time in the state this season, running an 8:57 with no competition after the first half

Today's race could see as many as five runners break the 9-minute barrier. To put that into a historical perspective, in state history on 19 times has that barrier been broken, and only three times in the last 10 years.

"If we're all on it could be an amazing race with some really fast times," Chenoweth said. "I wish I could watch it, but I gotta run it."

### RI star all about winning

CHARLESTON — Richard Lewis had just one thing on his mind when he finished his day.

"There's no doubt in my mind I'm winning the 100 meters (on Saturday);" the Rock Island senior said.

It will be Lewis' only race as he failed to qualify for the state finals in the 200, running a 22.26, missing the final spot by .04 seconds.

¿ Lewis had a pretty rough day overall. Not only did he not make it to the finals in the 200, but both the 4x100 and 4x200 relays he anchored were well behind a top 9

spot needed to race today.

'I was just drained from the relays. The 4x200 took a lot out of me. I didn't just give it all I had, I gave it more than all I had,' Lewis said. When asked whether there was any discussion of putting someone else on the last leg of the relays that were seeded in the teens, Lewis said he wouldn't have stood for it.

"I knew the team needed me in those relays so I didn't even suggest it," he said.

Another challenge Lewis had was coming back from a weather delay of more than an hour. He ran the 100 and 4x100 before the track got wet, and the pair of 200's afterward.

"It was hard re-gearing and gearing back up," Lewis said. 'My 200 time could've been much faster."

Lewis' top time of the season in the 100-meter dash is 10.57, just three-hundreths off the school record, and just two tenths off the Illinois state meet record.

For the first time this season, Lewis will get a fresh run at the 100, and won't have to worry about coming back to run any races. Those variables make an equation that could turn a rough Friday into a record-breaking Saturday.

Lewis isn't ruling it out either.

"You never know. I wouldn't count (running a state record 10.37) out," he said.



### Geneseo senior ran personal best

CHARLESTON, Ill. — It wasn't the way they had played it out in their heads, but Saturday at the IHSA State Track and Field meet turned out OK for Geneseo's Dan Chenoweth and Rock Island's Richard Lewis.

For United Township's Jerome Harms, though, it was a heartbreaking half-mile that brought his prep career to a close.

▶ Chenoweth runs season's best time, takes third: In the last 10 years, only three runners had broke the 9-minute barrier in the 3200-meter run. On Saturday, three runners did it, including Geneseo senior Chenoweth, who ran a season's best time of 8:57.27 to finish third.

Chenoweth took the lead at the 800meter mark, and led the field until Highland Park Jacob's Evan Jager ran his last lap in 60 seconds to take gold in 8:52.33.

"I thought I could go faster. I really wanted to come through with a 60 or 61 on the final lap, and it just didn't happen," Chenoweth said. "I'm disappointed in the end, but third place in this field isn't all that bad either."

Thanks to Saturday's runs, Illinois now boasts three of the top five fastest 3200 prep times in the country.

"I thought if I wanted to win I'd have to get out and be in the lead," Chenoweth said. "It just shows how much depth we have as a state. The field was absolutely stacked."

The Maple Leaf senior also tried to double up in the mile, but finished two spots off the podium.

▶Lewis fifth in the 100: After a long day on Friday, junior Richard Lewis'

legs weren't willing to cooperate on—Saturday. The Rocky sprinter ran a 10.75 in the 100 meter dash to finish fifth, losing to Demarcus Brooks of Springfield Southeast who won in 10.57

What makes it tough to swallow for

Lewis is that Brooks' time looks awfully familiar.

"I know I've already done that," said Lewis who clocked a 10.57 at the Rock Island Invite this year. "That's what hurts the most. I'm still hurting from yesterday." On Friday, Lewis ran on two relays that failed to make it to the finals, as well as the 100- and 200-meter dashes. Next year, his goal is to make days like Friday more realistic.

"I've got to build up the strength to run four events in one day," Lewis

said. "I know when my knees don't have power that they're too fatigued."

Overall, Saturday's race was just a bonus for the Rocky junior who feels he overachieved all season long.

"This year I didn't expect to be ranked this high," Lewis said. "I'm going to use it as a building block for next year. It's always a good experience to run at state."

▶ Harms DQ'd in 800: With just 180 meters left in the half-mile race, United Township senior Jerome Harms said he tripped over Huntley's Todd Farbink.

The umpires saw it differently. After getting up and finishing 11th, two spots out of medaling, Harms was told by an IHSA official that he was disqualified for stepping on the rail (metal rail that lines the track), tripping and falling, which impeded the race for the runners behind him.

"They said I stepped on the rail, which I didn't. I didn't touch the rail. The kid fell down in front of me, and I had nothing to do with it," said Harms, who also said the first time he touched Farbink was when the Huntley runner was already on the ground.

To add more suspicion to the race, Farbink wasn't on the inside of the track next to the rail.

"In the last turn I was trying to pull outside and pass, and someone clipped the back of my foot," Farbink said.

After Harms was DQ'd, the officials asked Farbink, who was running in fifth at the time, if he wanted a rerace. The Huntley junior declined and let the results stand.

# Chenoweth races

# to third in state

The phenomena that is "Chenoseo" came to an end May 24 and 25 as standout distance runner Dan Chenoweth ran his last races for the Leafs, taking third and 11th overall at the 2007 IHSA State Track and Field Meet in Charleston.

Chenoweth crossed the finish line in third place in the 3200-meter run with a time of eight minutes and 57.27 seconds. In the 1600-m run, Chenoweth took 11th overall in 4:20.62 and placed second in his heat with a time of 4:14.65.

"This year was a lot more fun having more people at state," Chenoweth said. "It was a good team experience.

"I really didn't have a whole set plan in the 3200-m run. We all know each other and we recognized it was

going to be a fast race.

"It has been a great experience (at Geneseo) with the fans and coaches."

"Dan qualified for the 1600-m finals and was winning his heat, but backed off and cruised in," Head Coach Don Fredericks said. "In the 3200-m run, the high temps and humidity made for tough conditions. Nobody led the

race, but then Dan took the lead and was leading with about 200 meters left, but the other racers came back to beat him out. Dan set a new school record in the 3200-m run and I was proud of his effort."

Geneseo's Andrew Walter finished the long jump preliminaries in second place with a leap of 21 3/4, but was unable to advance on. Jeremy Peters finished the high jump prelims with no height.

"Andrew Walter just missed the finals by one inch and for a first-time track athlete that is pretty remarkable," Fredericks said.

Jacob Kuban took eighth in the triple jump prelims at 43-6 1/2, while Shane Reschke placed eighth in the 400-m dash at 52.35.

The 4x400-m relay team of Walter, Nate Silver, Reschke and Kuban also finished eighth in the prelims with a time of 3:33.97.

"It was a great season," Fredericks said. "You take what you get and smile about it. We have a lot coming back next year with big shoes to fill. Some one will step up, but the question is who.

"We appreciate the effort of our seniors and they gave us tremendous efforts and leadership."



