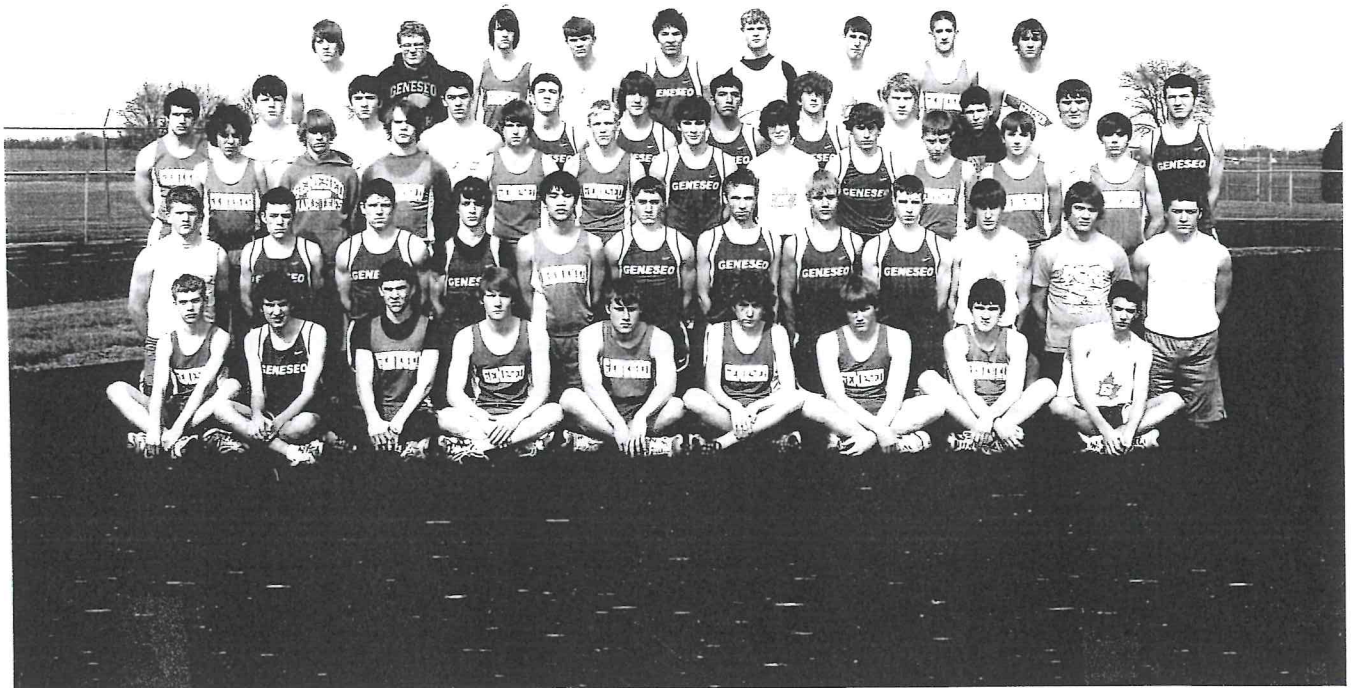

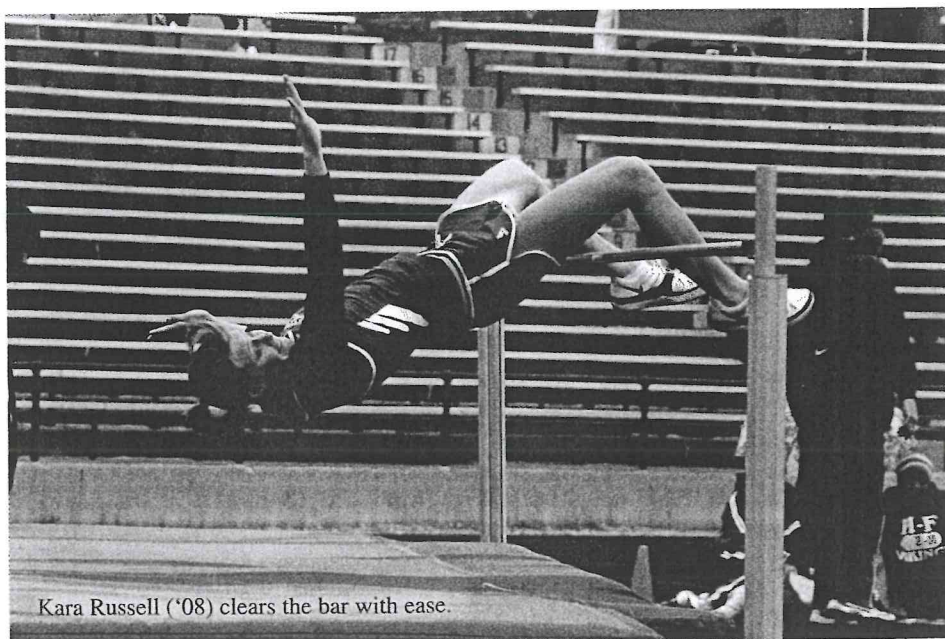

Vaulter Rob Barton ('08) clears the mark.

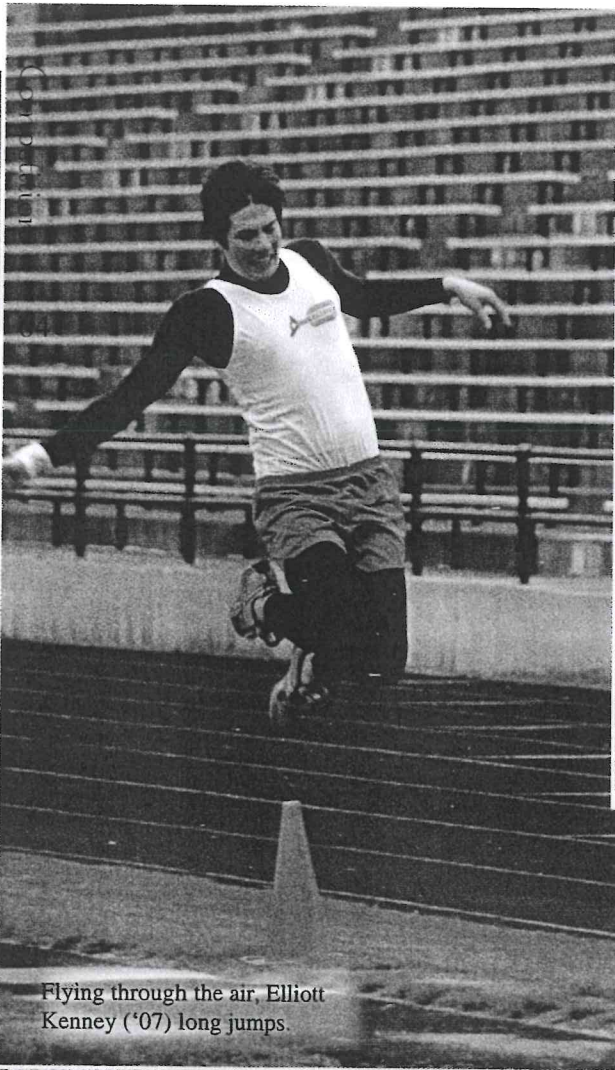

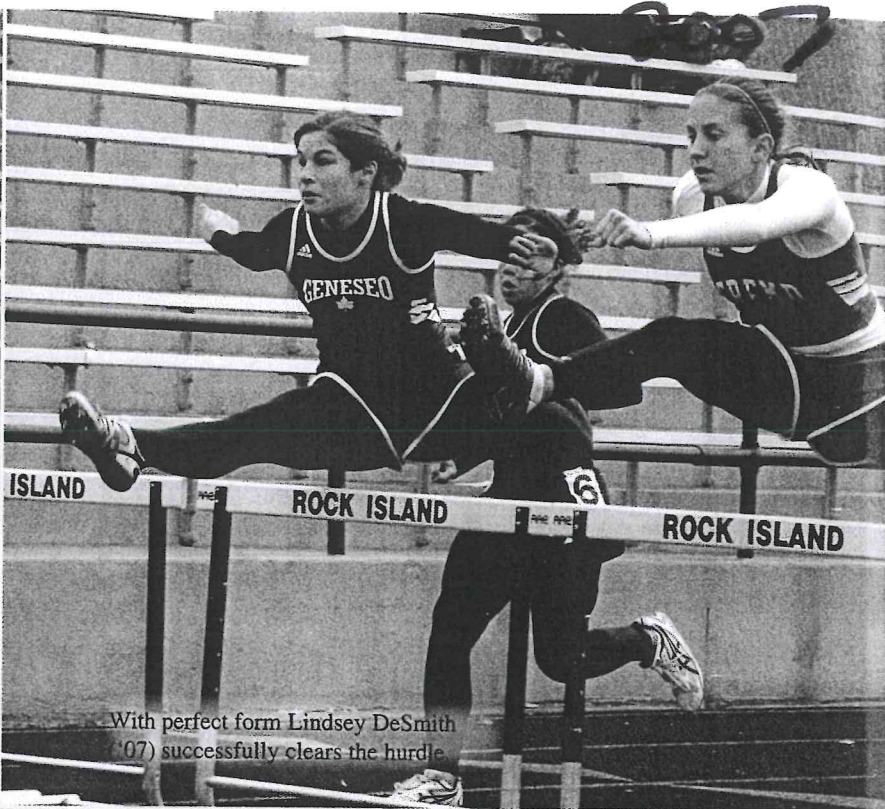


Kara Russell ('08) clears the bar with ease.

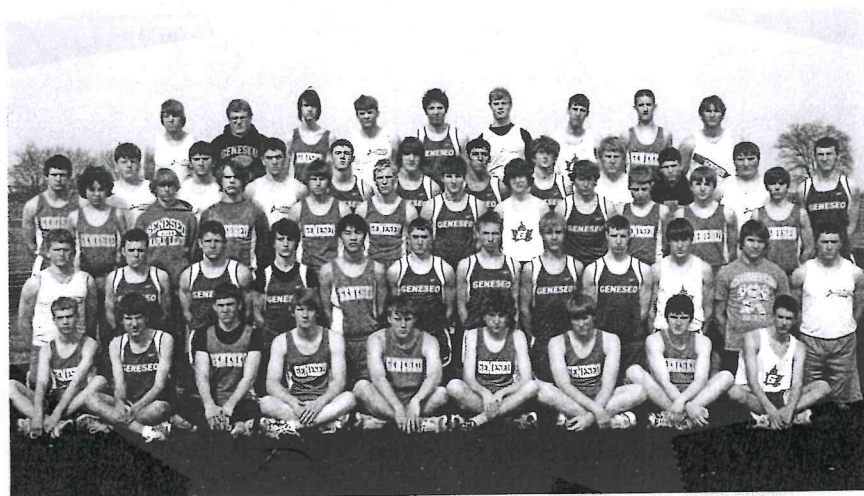


Bending his body, Ben Koenig ('08) clears the high jump bar.
