

# Leafs pull off upset for

## NCIC championship

It was a night of miracles and outstanding performances for the Geneseo track and field team as the Leafs emerged as NCIC champions over favorite Dixon by a mere two points May 18 in Kewanee.

"Wow, we were trying to think of a headline for the Web site and Mike Harrington suggested 'Do you believe in miracles.' That is the kind of night it was because Dixon has the cream of the crop," said head coach Don Fredericks.

"We didn't even talk about winning because we knew we had our hands full with Sterling and Ottawa for second. Everything lined up for a very special night. They exploded when they found out we were battling for the title. It really raised their

level of excitement and they kept improving."

The Leafs nabbed top honors with 137 points, followed by Dixon in second with 135; Sterling in third; Ottawa in fourth; LaSalle-Peru, fifth; and Streator, sixth.

Geneseo received top performances from all of its athletes as the Leafs and Dixon battled for the top spot through the entire meet with the title coming down to the final event, the 4x400-meter relay.

Although the 4x400-m relay team of Chris Bisom, Aaron Ganson, Michael Ashpole and Billy Hamer took second in the event with a time of 3 minutes and 32 seconds, the Dukes came in third to give Geneseo the extra points it needed for the championship.

"We were all tied up (with Dixon) going into the final race,

the 4x400-m relay," said Fredericks. "Dixon was seeded No. 1 by :06, but our guys wanted it so bad.

"Chris Bisom led off and put the hammer down to catch Dixon, then handed off to Ganson, who closed the gap. Ashpole got the stick and was with the Dixon runner, but then Ashpole blew by him to give Billy a lead and he ran the race of his life. Billy blasted out and opened up the lead even more and then in the last 30 meters or so you could see the Dixon runner realize he was not going to get Billy. We went nuts, it was so unexpected."

Curt Jensen continued his dominance winning the NCIC crown in both the discus and shot put. Jensen won the shot put with a throw of 56-11 1/2 and took the discus title with a final mark of 145-09.



Aaron Kotecki also nabbed a first place finish in the 100-m dash, taking the tape in 10.8, while Bisom won the 300-m hurdles in 41.7.

In second place were Josh Lodge in the 3200-m run with a time of 10:15.6; Ashpole, 110-m hurdles, 15.9; Ganson, 800-m run, 2:06.2; and Jake Ballegeer, high jump, clearing 5-11 and the triple jump at 38-0.

Placing third for the Leafs were Thomas Sigwalt in the 800-m run in 2:07.0; Ashpole, 300-m hurdles, 42.8; Lodge, 1600-m run, 4:50.8; and Rob Barton, pole vault, 12-9.

Finishing in fourth place were the 4x800-m relay of Kenny Collis, Ganson, Kyle Reiling and John Mullin in 9:01.6; the 4x100-m relay of Kotecki, Isaac Silver, Cameron McNeil and Andrew Walters, 45.5; and Hamer, 400-m dash, 52.7.

Rounding out the top five were Bisom in the 110-m hur-

On Monday the Leafs pulled on one of the biggest upsets in the history of the NCIC as they shocked the field and came home with the unexpected championship. Dixon was heavily favored to repeat as NCIC champions and the Leafs expected to be in dog fight with Sterling and Ottawa for 2nd place. The Leafs got off to a great start in the field events and then kicked it up a couple of notches when they started announcing the team scores. The meet was tied going into the mile relay with Dixon having a 6 second advantage over the Leafs. Not to be denied the Leaf team of Chris Bisom, Aaron Ganson and Michael Ashpole all dropped their personal bests by over a second each to give the baton to Billy Hamer the lead. # Geneseo pulls off upset in NCIC track meet

The Geneseo Maple Leaf boys weren't supposed to win the NCIC Track & Field Championship.

On paper, the Leafs were 35-point underdogs. But, as the saying goes, that's why you run the races.

And, as it seems as magical track meets go, this one came down to the 4x400 meter relay and the baton in the hands of sophomore Billy Hamer against cross country state runner-up Kasey Ferrigan. Hamer wasn't going to relent for any pursuer, ripping through the quarter-mile in a blazing 50.6 split to give the Maple Leafs a 1.7-second win and their first team title since 2005 and just their sixth in the past 60 years.

When he crossed the line, the Leafs mobbed each other, celebrating the

two-point swing that made the meet.

"I've been doing this stuff for a long time," Geneseo head man Don Fredricks said. "I've never seen that type of emotion. I guess it was because it was so unexpected. We didn't really talk about winning. I thought we'd have to have a tremendous meet to even get second."

The field events got the momentum going. Curt Jensen continued his stellar senior season, capturing crowns in both the shot put and discus, while the two Geneseo high jumpers, Michael Ashpole and Jake Ballageer, each improved on their seeds and scored big points. Then, they started announcing the score.

"About halfway through the meet, they started announcing team scores after every event. Our kids

responded and took it up a notch they had never to before," Fredericks said. "We knew we were in a dogfight, and the kids just stepped up big time."

Then Aaron Kotecki won the 100-meter dash with a school record 10.71 seconds, and senior cross country captain Chris Bisom took gold in the 300-hurdles, setting the stage for the final event.

Bisom had a quick turnaround, but stayed with Dixon's top Duke, handing off to first-year runner Aaron Ganson. The senior took the baton and held position, handing off to Ashpole. The junior multi-eventer stayed with the Dukes until the home stretch where he pulled away by roughly 10 meters.

From there, Hamer was the hammer, and the Maple Leafs are wearing gold.

## Untied and tested: Reagan comes down to final event for 2nd-place Dukes

**KEWANEE** — Kasey Ferrigan wanted to catch Billy Hamer.

As hard as the Dixon senior tried, the runner-up in the Class 2A state cross country meet just couldn't make up the head start the Geneseo runner had in the final leg of the 1,600-meter relay.

The Maple Leafs finished second behind Sterling in the relay. The Dukes were third.

The 1,600 relay, the last event of the NCIC meet, broke the tie between Geneseo and Dixon, giving the Maple Leafs the crown with 137 points. Dixon (135) was second, while Sterling (108) finished third.

Mendota won the NCIC Lincoln with 134 points. Rock Falls (109) was second.

"He's a good runner and he had a good 10 or 15 meters on me," Ferrigan said. "I thought I closed the ground a little bit, but I couldn't make it all up."

Ferrigan was joined by Thayne Rooney, Ben Smith and Eric Dewey on the relay, which finished in 3 minutes, 33.7 seconds. Geneseo finished in 3:32.0.

Ferrigan won the 800 in 2:00.7. He also was on the winning 3,200-relay team with Kyle Boone, Ross Kavanagh and Aaron Grady (8:39.9).

"We just didn't get off on the right foot today in the field events, and that carried over to the track a little," Dixon coach Mark Nelson said. "We were just waiting for something to happen to get the ball rolling and it just never happened."

Other Dixon winners on the track were Wes Heniff in the 200 (22.9) and Nate Jones in the 3,200 (10:14.9).

Preston Lumzy set the Reagan record in the high jump by clearing 6 feet, 3 inches.

Dixon was without senior distance runner Matt Logan, who is out for the season with a stress fracture in his leg.

The Sterling camp did nearly as much celebrating at the conclusion of the 1,600 relay as Geneseo.

The Warriors team of Corey Hartz, Kyle Mason, Chevy Bushaw and Josh Kunde ran a time of 3:28.2.

The state qualifying cut is 3:28.24.

"All we really wanted to do was beat Dixon because they were seeded with a better time," Bushaw said. "I never expected to go under the state cut time. That was like 4 seconds less than our best this season."

Kunde was the link to Sterling's success. He ran on the Warriors' winning 400, 800 and 1,600 teams.

"I think it shows what kind of depth we have," Kunde said. "It's more of a team effort and we want to run well for each other."

The 400 team of Kunde, Hartz, David Nelson and Ryan Coppotelli won in 44.0 seconds. The 800 team of Kunde, Coppotelli, Bushaw and Mason won in 1:33.3.

Niko Rivera won the long jump (18-10 1/2). Teammate Clay Hadley was second (18-8 1/4).

Rock Falls was led by senior Alec Dorathy, who won the 100 (10.5), the 200 (22.9) and the 400 (51.5).

The Rockets finished second in the 400, 800 and 1,600 relays.

"I didn't load up the relays as much as I could have," Bontz said. "I could have added Dorathy to the 400 relay, but we didn't want to push him much more."

"We went from fifth last year to second this year. I can say I am happy with that kind of improvement."



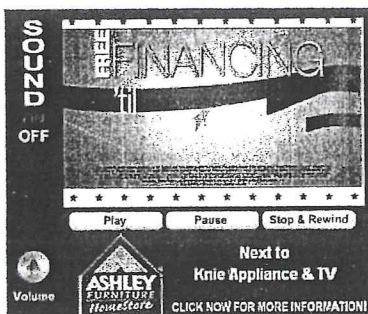

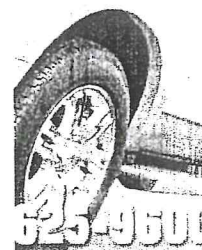

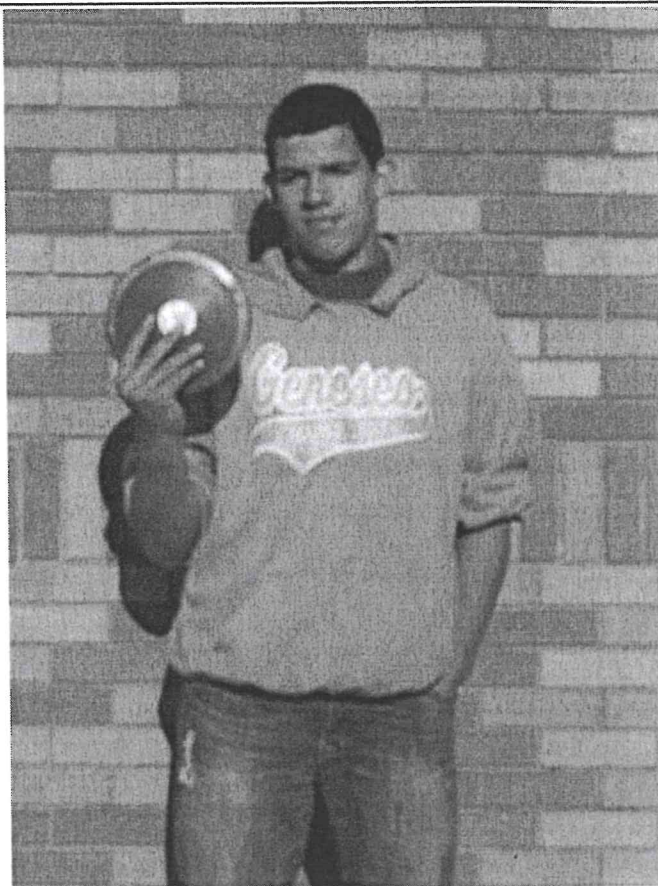
