

Alleman's Billingsley wins at McCormick

GENESEO — The wind was howling Friday night, but Alleman's Matt Billingsley wound up blown away for a different reason at Geneseo's annual McCormick Invitational.

The Pioneer junior won his second race of the track and field season, bettering a 1600 bunch that included Galesburg's Lucas Junk and Gabe Moreno, a week ahead of the Western Big 6 Conference meet at Rock Island.

"Going into the meet, the only team I was worried about was Canton, because they're the only ones we could see at (the Class 1A) state (meet)," Billingsley said. "So the rest of them I was just, 'If I beat them, I beat them.' Instead, I beat them all. So this gives me a lot of confidence going into the next couple of weeks, for conference, sectionals and state."



While Billingsley was the only local winner at the event, many of the other competitors from Alleman and Geneseo shared the feeling.

Included was Michael Ashpole, a four-event point-winner for the hosts, who scored 64 points to finish behind only defending champ Galesburg (107) and eventual winner Peoria Richwoods (107.3).

Alleman (34) placed seventh in a 12-team field drawing from the Quad-Cities, Peoria, Rockford and the disolving NCIC.

"Seed-wise, we were supposed to be fifth or sixth and instead we got third to some

really good teams and against a tough field that should produce a bunch of guys with state medals around their neck," Geneseo coach Don Fredericks said.

"Ashpole tied for second in the high jump, and it's only his second year out. He also placed (top four) in both hurdling events. There was a little mishap in the 4x4, when he got stepped on from behind, which took his spike off. But he still ran the last 300 meters with one shoe on, which will tell you what kind of competitor he is."

Ashpole and 4x400 relay teammates Billy Hamer, Thomas Sigwalt and Micah Stewart settled for third place.

Hamer also finished second in the 400, and ran on a point-producing, sixth-place 400 relay with Stewart, Aaron Kotecki and Luke Lembke.

Stewart (400) and Sigwalt (800) also added fourth-place points.

Geneseo scored in 12 of the 19 events with Jordan Starkey and Carlisle Evans-Peck finishing 2-3 in the 3200. Joe Huffman also placed in both the shot and discus, and Kotecki was sixth in a loaded 100. Geneseo also got fifth-place

points from freshman Dugan Kuffel in the 300 hurdles, and the 3200 relay team of Kyle Reiling, Chad Ford, Kenny Collis and Tyler Fox.

"We're still a work in progress," Fredericks said. "We'll certainly make a few tweaks for next Friday's NCIC meet (at Sterling). But we certainly have some fighters on this team."

Ditto for Alleman, which got runner-up finishes from two relays — the 4x100 (Andrew Randleman, Michael Westbrooks, Justin Quintana and Mamadou Barry) and 4x800 (Andrew Hoogerwerf, Sean McGuire, Ethan Adlifinger and Billingsley).

Third-place points came from Quintana in the 200 and the 4x100 weightmen's relay (Scott Schilb, Jacob Irving, Jeremy Sellers, Jamie Maloney). Tim Cornelis (pole vault) and Liam Otto (3200) also scored with sixth-place finishes.

"Our 4x1 was under (state) qualifying, and we would have been in the 4x2 if we hadn't dropped the baton. Our pole vaulter also PR'd," Alleman coach Kenny Lee said. "We still have some things to clean up, but everything seems to be coming together."



Leafs 3rd at invite

At Geneseo's annual John McCormick Invite, the Geneseo boys' track and field team battled against a tough field and unseasonably cool temps and came away with a third-place finish behind Peoria Richwoods and Galesburg May 7.

"It was a raw, cold night and was one of the colder nights since this meet has been held," said head coach Don Fredericks. "We definitely had to have the meet, but it was barely warm enough to have

the meet, the wind was blowing. It was not an enjoyable night."

Geneseo's highest finishes for the day were second-place honors from Jordan Starkey in

the 3200-meter run with a time of 10 minutes and 16 seconds, followed by Billy Hamer in the 400-m dash in 50.73 and Michael Ashpole in the high jump, clearing 5-11.

"The team performed magnificently," said Fredericks. "And our guys took a nice step forward.

"Michael Ashpole continued his phenomenal senior season and ran his leg of the 4x400-m relay without one of his spikes after a competitor stepped on his heel and he had

to kick off the other one. It was a pretty gutsy performance."

Placing third for Geneseo were Carlisle Evans-Peck in the 3200-m run at 10:24; Ashpole in the 110-m hurdles with a time of 15.10; and the 4x400-m relay of Hamer, Ashpole, Thomas Sigwalt and Micah Stewart, 3:35.55.

In fourth place were Sigwalt, 800-m run, 2:05; Stewart, 400-m dash, 52.75; Ashpole, 300-m hurdles, 42.75; and Joe Huffman, dis-

cus, 141-10.

Rounding out the top five finishes were the 4x800-m relay of Kyle Reiling, Chad Ford, Kenny Collis and Tyler Fox in 8:45.13 and Dugan Kuffel, 300-m hurdles, 44.38.

"The field was very strong and that is what you want at your home invite," said Fredericks. "We were seeded seventh and I was pleasantly surprised we finished third."

"Right now, Dixon is the favorite to win conference, followed by Sterling in second and then it is us and Ottawa battling it out for third," said Fredericks. "It will be interesting how the seedings go, but anything can happen."

"It should be an exciting meet and I hope to see continued improvement from our guys. And I want to see the hunger and desire from our team to win the final NCIC title."
