Stewart, Ashpole, Sigwalt, and Hamer Qualify for STATE

HAMER & 1600 RELAY HEADED TO STATE

On Friday, May 21st, the Leafs traveled to Rock Island to participate in the IHSA Sectional Finals. The Rock Island Sectional is regarded as the most difficult 2A Sectional in the state. To say the least, qualifying was going to be an extremely difficult task.

The weatherman cooperated with only a little drizzle and moderate temperatures. The best part of the day was the fact the wind finally died down and was a non-factor. The team has battled more wind this season than I can ever remember during a season.

The team entries focused on maximizing qualifying opportunities instead of team point omnipotence. Michael Ashpole barely missed qualifying in both the High Jump (barely clipped the bar at the state standard of 6' 03") and 110 meter High Hurdles (missed by 1/10 of a second.) Joe Huffman continued his late season Shot Put explosion and almost broke 50 feet (49' 09 1/2") to barely miss qualifying. Billy Hamer put an end to near misses in the 400 Meter Dash with a powerful 1st place performance (50.57.) The Leafs saved the best for last as the 1600 Meter Relay toed the line. Seeded 3rd in the race in a loaded field hopes were high as Michael Ashpole and Micah Stewart both gave up mid-meet events (300 I.H. & the 400) to "save it" for one big effort in the relay. The gamble paid-off. Micah Stewart ran a tremendous opening leg handing off to Michael Ashpole in (51.15) for a personal best. Michael grabbed the baton and raced to his personal best of 52.25. To say the least, things were going well for the Leafs but the field was extremely strong and they were still in 5th place knowing they had to hit the state standard of 3:28. 400 Meter rookie Thomas Sigwalt took the stick next and roared to another personal best of 52.13 handing off in 4th place. From there Junior anchorman Billy Hamer got out hard and exploded down the homestretch as the field bunched together with 50 meters to go. When the dust had settled Billy

had run 49.75 and nailed down 2nd place. FOUR PERSONAL BESTS. It was simply one of the most exciting races I have ever seen. Now.....ON TO STATE. Job well done men. In addition the All-Freshmen 400 and 800 Meter Relay teams of Dalton Johnson, Ben Chom, Dugan Kuffel, and Ethan Reschke ran to a new school 09 record in the 800 and the 2nd fastest 400 09 relay in school history. The future looks bright. Team members who scored points in the meet are listed below:

Rock-solid sectional for Rocky boys' track

Rock Island sophomore Derrick Ellis is headed to Charleston with a chip on his shoulder.

"I didn't win all of my events (Friday)," Ellis seethed after the Class 2A Rocky-hosted boys' track sectional.

But Jerraco Johnson and the rest of Ellis' teammates knew better than to complain after Rocky qualified for next weekend's state meet in 10 of Friday's 18 events at Public Schools Stadium.

Included? Four events each by Ellis and the Rocks' senior leader, Johnson.

"I just wanted to get back

downstate," Johnson said. "That's where the pressure was; it didn't matter what place, just that you got there."

Johnson booked his trip to O'Brien Stadium by winning both hurdling events — the 110 highs and 300 lows — plus ran on the winning 4x100 relay team with Ellis, Chris Glover and Devontea Young.

Johnson and Glover also teamed with Dakota Beavers and Breshawn Hawthorne on a third-place 4x400 relay squad that eclipsed the state-qualifying standard.

Ellis also "got there" by

winning the long jump, but finished second in the 100 and 200, though both exceeded the qualifying time.

"When you qualify for state in four events, it's hard to complain," Rocky coach Ed Lillis beamed. "But then again, I think Derrick thinks he's got more in the tank, and that's got to be a good feeling heading to state."

Ellis begged to differ, though.

"I want to finish top three in all of my events (next weekend)," Ellis said. "So I have something to prove. I got humbled a little (Friday). I ran out of gas and got caught from behind in the 200, and I can't let that happen again."

Also hitting qualifying standards Friday for the hosts was Charles Pugh (fourth, shot put), the runner-up 4x200 relay (Young, Glover, Victor Jones and Rashai Pendleton) and the fourth-place 4x800 relay (Beavers and Hawthorne plus Aubrey Barnes and Marcus Gaffney).

Geneseo's Billy Hamer also won the 400, plus qualified with the runner-up 4x400 team with Michael Ashpole, Thomas Sigwalt and Micah Stewart).

Galesburg won the sectional team title with 121 points, 14 state qualifiers and four event champs. Rocky (93) was next, with

Geneseo (29) placing eighth among the 13-team, Peoria-heavy field.

"I'm even proud of the kids that didn't make it," Lillis said. "We had (personal records) across the board, and you can't do any better than give it your best shot, and that's what so many of our kids did."

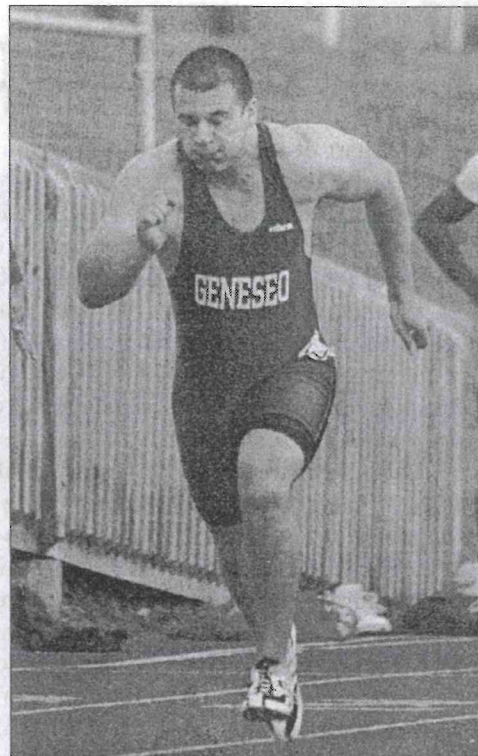
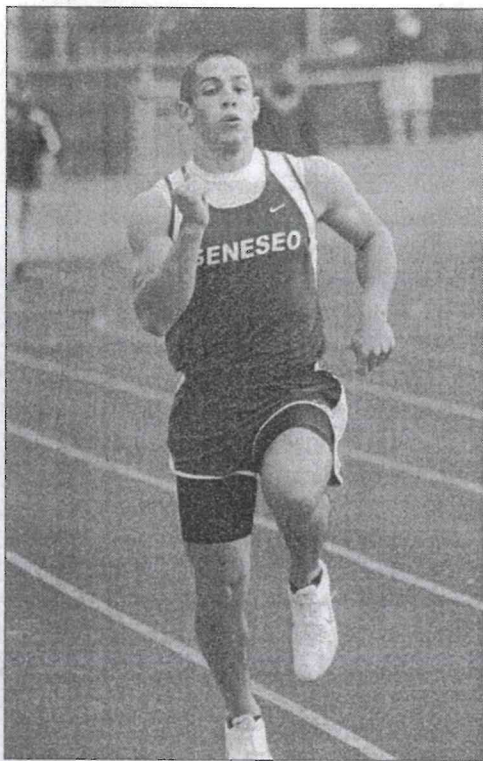
Among the other Top 6 point-scorers for the Rocks was Sergio Patterson (high jump and triple jump) and Arius Montjoy (triple jump).

Pugh (discus), Young (200) and Glover (100) also scored points in events they failed to qualify for state.

Ashpole (110 hurdles and high jump) also just missed, along with Stewart (100), Joe Huffman (shot put) and Jordan Starkey (3200).

"We had a great meet," Johnson said. "But now the challenge is to be even better next week, and see how many medals we can bring home. If we compete like we did (Friday), we'll be hauling home some (state) hardware for sure."

ericks. "Our team doesn't have a lot of those guaranteed first placers, but we have a team that will go out and fight. And now we are lucky to continue our season."

Troy Diericks placed second in his flight of shot put with a throw of 44-10 1/4, while Anthony Roome came in fifth in his flight of discus at 105-11. Ian Mattan took seventh in the pole vault with a final height of 11-3.

"As difficult as our sectional is, if you get through it you definitely have a shot to

do good things at the state meet," said Fredericks. "The goal is to bring home some state hardware."

The Leafs will be in action May 28 and 29 at the IHSA State Finals in Charleston on the campus of Eastern Illinois University.

"It is the state finals and it is what every athlete dreams of," said Fredericks. "Every athlete hopes to have that opportunity."

"Michael Ashpole is the only senior and has played in front of thousands for basketball and has experience in pressure packed situations.

Billy Hamer went to state as a freshman and played in the state football game, so he has that experience. Micah Stewart was all-state in Georgia last year, so he has that experience and Thomas Sigwalt has run in front of thousands at Detweiller Park in cross country, so he has that experience. I think they all can handle adversity well.

"My No. 1 goal is to enjoy the experience. This is special stuff because it is a situation that doesn't happen to most. Hopefully they can perform at their highest level and I hope for personal bests."

head to state

Billy Hamer, along with members of the 4x400-meter relay, Micah Stewart, Michael Ashpole and Thomas Sigwalt advanced to the IHSA State Finals out of a very tough Rock Island Sectional May 21.

"I felt like we had four events that legitimately could qualify and two did," said head coach Don Fredericks. "Our sectional is loaded and is the toughest 2A Sectional in the state. It is extremely difficult."

Hamer is headed to state in the 400-m dash after placing first with a time of 50.57 seconds.

The 4x400-m relay of Stewart, Ashpole, Sigwalt and Hamer earned a second-place finish at the Friday sectional to advance to state with a time of 3:25.90.

"Michael Ashpole had a shot in three events and he just barely missed in the other two," said Fredericks. "He barely missed the state qualifying mark in the high jump of 6-3 and missed advancing in the 110 highs by one-tenth of a second. He had a phenomenal season."

"The 4x400 didn't mess around. All four guys ran personal bests and ran extremely inspired. They were not taking any chances. Billy's home stretch run was phenomenal for how far he dug down."

In other sectional results, Ashpole placed third in the 110-m hurdles finals with a time of 15.14 and third in the high jump at 6-1, while Jordan Starkey took fifth in the 3200-m run at 10:12.82 and Joe Huffman, sixth in the shot put at 49-9 1/2 and ninth in the discus at 126-08.

Also, Stewart took sixth in the 100-m dash finals in 11.64, while Aaron Kotecki

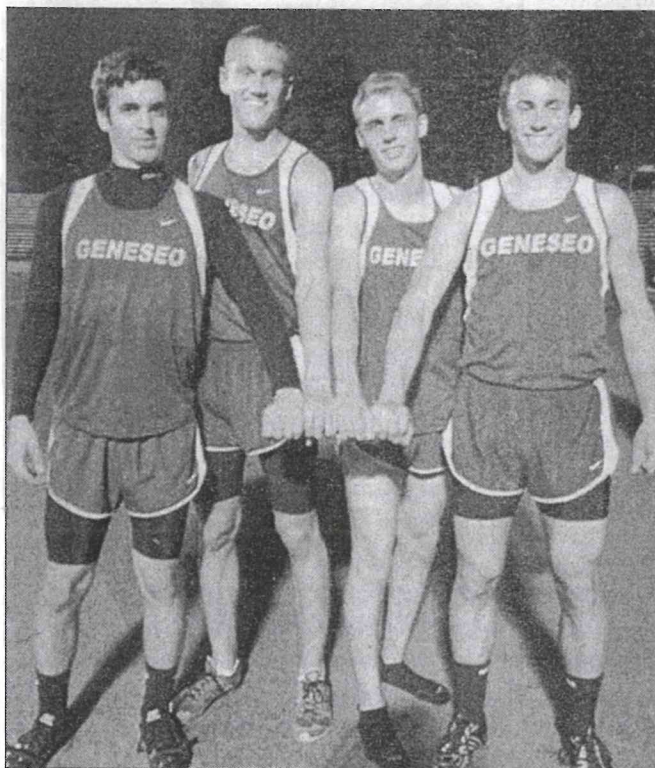
placed fifth in his heat at 12.00. Luke Lembke took fifth in the 200-m dash prelims in 24.68, while Andrew Walters came in sixth in 25.08.

Chad Ford placed 10th in the 3200-m run prelims with a time of 10:34.73, while the 4x100-m relay of Dalton Johnson, Ben Chom, Dugan Kuffel and Ethan Reschke came in third in their heat at 47.12.

In the 800-m run, Kenny Collis took second in his section in 2:08.19, while Sigwalt came in 10th at 2:01.90 in his section. The 4x200-m relay of Johnson, Chom, Dylan Waggoner and Reschke took third in 1:36.88, while Kyle Reiling and Carlisle Evans-Peck went one-two in their heat of the 1600-m run in 4:42.13 and 4:42.31, respectively.

"I am happy overall with how things went," said Fred-
