#### MARMION, STARKEY, & RIELING QUALIFY FOR STATE FINALS

On Friday, May 18th, the Leafs traveled to Ottawa to participate in the IHSA Sectional meet. The meet included teams from Aurora (Central Catholic), Aurora (Math & Science Academy), Coal City, Fairbury (Prairie Central), Geneseo, LaSalle-Peru, Mendota, Morris, Ottawa, Plano, Pontiac, Princeton, Rock Island (Alleman), Sandwich, and Streator.

The weatherman delivered a perfect day for the Sectional Meet with a daytime high of 85 degrees with relatively low humidity and winds. The only event not well-suited to the weather was the 3200 Meter Run (a bit warm.) The meet, like our season, had highs and lows. Medals were awarded to the top 6 placers in each event. In addition, qualifying for state were the top two finishers in each event plus any additional athletes that bettered or tied the state qualifying standards.

The field events led the charge and sophomore sensation A.J. Marmion popped one early to nail down 3rd place overall and qualify for the State Meet. A.J. threw over the state standard a staggering 4 times. The school record is a bit nervous. Next up was junior Jordan Starkey who had to battle the heat and two Alleman Pioneers. Jordan ran another spirited race with a tremendous homestretch run and ended up nailing 2nd-place and closing a huge early race lead on the leader to end up only 3 seconds back of 1st. Coach Harrington has nicknamed Jordan "Seabiscuit" after the great thoroughbred who fought off all challengers in the homestretch of close races. Our last state qualifier ended up in the event that was the most competitive of the meet as 5 athletes qualified for the state finals. Senior distance man Kyle Reiling ran a gutsy race,

got dropped from the pack in the last 300 meters, but somehow kicked wildly to run the sub 66 second last lap he needed to sneak in in by less than a second. Kyle has been paying his dues for many years now and it was awesome to see him book his State Meet ticket. WAY TO ROLL. ## Marmion, Reiling and Starkey earn spots at IHSA State Finals

Geneseo's A.J. Marmion, Kyle Reiling and Jordan Starkey punched tickets to the IHSA Boys' Track and Field State Finals after they reached state qualifying marks at the May 18 Ottawa Sectional. The team placed ninth overall.

"It was very refreshing to see some different teams at the Ottawa Sectional," said head coach Don Fredericks. "It was very competitive, but a nice change of scenery and we are real excited for the three who qualified for state."

Starkey, a junior in his first trip to the state track meet, nabbed the highest finish for the Leafs in the 3200-meter run in second place with a time of 9 minutes and 47.82 seconds.

"Jordan had his hands full and a real challenge on hand," said Fredericks. "The leader took off and was out of sight and Jordan was battling for second with an Alleman runner. Jordan had a tremendous last lap and ended up only 3 seconds behind the leader for second."

Marmion, a sophomore in his first trip to state, captured third place in the discus with a qualifying mark of 156-

"A.J. has had a phenomenal season and had four throws over the state qualifying distance in the discus," said Fredericks. "We are really excited to have a sophomore qualify. To get there and gain that experience is priceless. He already is the sophomore record holder and is in pursuit of the school record."

Kyle Reiling, a senior in his first trip to state, earned a spot at the state meet with a fifth-place finish in the 1600-m run as he crossed the finish line in 4:29.84.

"Oh my gosh, the 1600-m run field was loaded and was the only event that had five runners qualify in and ran a tough race. He was fighting through a bad patch and dropped from the pack, but kicked it in and closed in on the lead group on the last lap."

Other finishes in the field events included Seth Wilson, 11th, high jump, 5-7; Jay Wilson and Alex Platz, seventh, pole vault, 11-9; Zach Taber, 13th, long jump, 18-8; Tyler Rusk, 15th, long jump, 18-5 1/2; Josh Beard, seventh, triple jump, 39-7 1/2; Jordan Mielke, 12th, triple jump, 37-4 1/2; Joe Huffman, fifth, discus, 143-11 and fourth, shot put, 49-8; and Marmion, fifth, shot put, 47-3.

"The stars did not line up in every thing, and we had some areas where we thought we would qualify and didn't," said Fredericks. "I am so happy for three who qualified, but it is a bittersweet feeling in the other events because you want to see everything go

well. We had a few things that didn't go our way, but I am very proud of the team's effort."

The 4x800-m relay of Mitchell Kyle got fifth," said Fredericks. "Kyle Lamb, Griffin Welfer, Dugan Kuffel and Jacob Rahn placed third in 8:37.57, followed by the 4x100-m relay of Chase Cahalan, Landon Hoon, Rusk and Justin Seeley, seventh, 45.21.

> David Chenoweth took eighth in the 3200-m run in 10:48.21, while Lamb came in seventh in the 800-m run at 2:12.33; Josh Beard, ninth in the 400m dash in 55.08, and Jacob Miller, 14th in the 400-m dash at 56.24.


> Seeley placed fourth in the 300-m hurdles with a time of 42.07, followed by Kuffel in eighth at 43.84.





## Schilb, Adlfinger pace Pioneers to title

in class couldn't bump out the Alleman boys' track and field team Friday evening.

The Pioneers, competing at the Ottawa Class 2A Sectional after being moved up from 1A this year by the IHSA, claimed the team title Friday night while also sending five young men to next weekend's IHSA State Meet in Charleston. Alleman edged second-place Pontiac 91-89 in the team standings, with Geneseo placing ninth in the 12-team field.


"When we started at the beginning of the year, we took (the bump up to Class 2A) as a challenge," said Alleman coach Kenny Lee. "We decided to consider it a promotion. It's kind of bittersweet, because I feel bad for the seniors who didn't make it to state tonight. ... But they stepped up for us to win this tonight."

A pair of juniors led the way for the Pioneers.

Scott Schilb dominated the throwing events, winning the discus by over nine feet with a toss of 166-feet, 5-inches and the shot put by two-and-a-half feet with a throw of 53-8.

"It was a great day," said Schilb. "There was a lot of great competition here to push me, and that made me strive to do my best.

"It's exciting going to state. It's a great feeling, and I can't wait.

Alleman's Ethan Adlfinger qualified for Charleston in two events, too, winning the 3200 run with an impressive time of 9:44.58 and placing third in the 1600 with a statequalifying time of 4:28.07. It will be Adlfinger's third trip

"These types of meets are still exciting," said Adlfinger. "This is where you've got to compete to get to state, so you've got to run with enthusiasm. I was still excited, just not as nervous as I used to be."

Fellow junior Will Graham

finished right behind Adlfinger in the 1600 and will join him at state thanks to his fourth-place, 4:29.57 run. Alleman freshman Kylee Dorsey will be also be competing in Charleston on Friday by virtue of winning the high jump title by clearing 6- feet, 3-inches. Senior Ian Ferguson will join them as well thanks to his second-place jump of 20-11 in the long jump.

Geneseo will be sending three of its own athletes to state despite not winning an event. Jordan Starkey punched his ticket with a

second-place run of 9:47.82 in the 3200; A.J. Marmion placed third but qualified in the discus with his throw of 156-2; and Kyle Reiling's fifthplace clocking of 4:29.84 in the 1600 came in just head of the state-qualifying time of

"The kids competed hard," Geneseo coach Don Fredericks said. "We qualified three guys, but we also had some disappointments tonight. I'm not sure I want to talk about those right now. Instead, we'll focus on what we were able to accomplish."
