LEAFS BATTLE STATE'S BEST AT THE I.T.T. INVITATIONAL

On Saturday, March 23rd, the Leafs traveled to Illinois Wesleyan University's Shirk Center to participate in the Illinois Top Times Invitational. The meet is recognized as the "unofficial" indoor state meet. Admittedly, not all qualified athletes participated. However, the fields were still elite and the Leafs performed admirably.

To start the day off the boys met Coaches Harrington and Moe at the high school at 5:15 am for a 5:30 am departure time. Yup, they rolled out of bed at 4:30 am. Rumor has it the two hour trip down to Bloomington was pretty quiet.

The vaulters got things going first at 9:00 am following weigh-ins. There was a blood pressure rising half hour where Senior Jay Wilson (and all the other 13 footers) were told there had been an error made with their invitations and they would not be allowed to compete. Following a written protest from Coach Harrington and the other boys' coaches there was a games committee meeting where they voted to allow the boys to compete. DUH. We received an email from the meet management with invitations for the all 7 boys to compete (this INCLUDED JAY WILSON.) Following the roller coaster drama Jay tied his lifetime best with a vault of 13' 00" which placed

him 13th overall. Fellow senior Alex Platz cleared 14' 00" for the 3rd time in his life to place 8th on misses and had the same clearance as the 4th place finisher. Great job men.

Next up for the Leafs was Junior Thrower A.J. Marmion whom was up against an extremely strong field. A.J. ended up throwing 48' 07" which placed him 9th and hungry to do battle with these boys come May. He is also excited to bring in his best event called the Discus where is he a returning ALL-STATERS. Any "Big-Meet" experience gained is priceless and will prove to be extremely valuable before the season is over.

Last up was the 3200 Meter Relay. Following a wonderful Coach Phillip Moe led warm-up the boys toed the line with a loaded field. The boys passed the "prime time" test with 3 of the 4 running personal bests. Sophomore David Chenoweth led off with a strong personal best of 2:05 point. Senior Mitchell Lawson took the stick next and rolled to a personal best of 2:04 low. Next up was Junior Mitchell Lamb who rolled through the quarter in 61 and ran into trouble on the 2nd lap finishing in 2:14. He was disappointed but welcome to the major leagues. Your dedication has been solid all season long so let this experience inspire you to keep doing the little things to attack the sub two barrier. Senior Jordan Starkey anchored in a season best of 2:03 high and helped carry the Leafs to a solid 9th place showing. Solid races men. Dugan Kuffel did a great job as the alternate and will be seeing plenty of action very soon. Can you say sub 2 AND sub 40 AND sub 50? That's da goal.

Geneseo competes at IL Top Times

Geneseo track and field was represented by 12 athletes at the Illinois Top Times Meet March 23 at Illinois Wesleyan.

Hannah Vanderheyden grabbed the highest finish for the Lady Leafs in the 60-meter hurdles as she took third place with a time of 9.33 seconds in the finals.

Rayne Bodeen placed sixth for the Lady Leafs in the 60-meter dash with a time of 7.96 seconds in the finals; while Emily Ford took eighth in the 800-m run as she crossed the finish line in 2:24.71.

Jamie DeFauw took home eighth in the high jump as she cleared 5-0; while Hannah Waller finished 10th in the preliminaries in the 60-m hurdles with a time of 9.78, but did not advance to the finals.

Alex Platz was the highest finisher for the boys' team in eighth place in the pole vault as he cleared 14-0; while Jay Wilson took 13th in the pole vault at 13-0.
