LEAFS GIVE IT THEIR ALL AT STATE MEET

On Thursday, May 23rd, the Leafs took off for the 4-hour drive to Charleston to participate in the IHSA State Track Finals hosted at Eastern Illinois University. The prelims were held on Friday morning for Class AA (that's us.) They call it the STATE MEET for a reason and the competition was what you would expect. The best of the best.

The 3200 Meter Relay team got things started for us with a strong 8:28.90 that was good enough for 23rd place overall. Considering that none of these boys had ever been to the "Big Dance" before, they all ran very respectfully. We front end loaded the order with Mitchell Lawson and David Chenoweth who were followed by Chaise Blakley and Mitchell Lamb.

Next up was A.J. Marmion in the Shot Put. A.J.'s 3rd preliminary throw was well over 51 feet and would have qualified him for the finals except he was called for a foot foul (we didn't see it.) His best of 47' 09 1/4" was good for 20th place. He followed that up with an off-day in the Discus

that saw him throw 141' 09" good for 16th place overall. He will still have a chance to become Geneseo's only male thrower to win All-State Honors in more than one year in 2014.

Mitchell Lawson was up next with the difficult assignment of doubling back in the 800 from the 3200 Meter Relay. He ran a tremendous race of 2:01.75 which was lifetime open best by a ton and placed him 17th overall. It's hard to compare apples to oranges but a strong argument could be made that he had Geneseo's best performance of the meet.

Up next was Senior Ethan Reschke who toed the line in the 400 Meter Dash. Ethan was in the 3rd of 3 heats and raced in lane 8. He got out strong and ran a solid race with a time of 50.99 which placed him 17th overall. What an amazing season of comeback he put down. Monmouth College will be lucky to have Ethan and Jordy on their roster in 2014.

Jordan Starkey closed the book on the 2013 season with a strong effort in the 3200 Meter Run (fast heat.) Jordan looked great for the first 3/4 of the race which saw him take it out in 4:40 (fastest first mile of his life.) He ran into a bad patch with 800 meters to go and lost touch with the pack that he was running with (they all ended up All-State.) It happens, and we were all very proud of his effort. He enjoyed a phenomenal career and barely missed All-State Honors with his 16th place finish.

Additional highlights of the weekend were the Friday lunch buffet at the Chinese Restaurant, a great game of Ultimate Frisbee against Elmwood Park High School (Rocko and Ivan ran on their 3200 Relay team), the pizza feast at Paglia's, and a lot of quality time together. To top it all off was a stop at Avanti's on the way home. Thanks for a great season, Men.

Leafs' Marmion throwing it all in

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GENESEO — Hoping to reach the elusive 180-foot discus mark this season, Geneseo junior thrower A.J. Marmion recently measured out the distance beyond the practice ring.

Resting on the mark is a tire.

With one weekend left to reach a goal that carries significance both competitively and personally, Marmion is doing everything he can to be at his best. In order to reach that level when the Class 2A state meet opens Friday at Eastern Illinois University's O'Brien Stadium, he placed the tire on the ground to serve as a reminder of the distance needed to attain his goal.

"I'm putting everything together," Marmion said. "My form is coming together like I'm hoping it would."

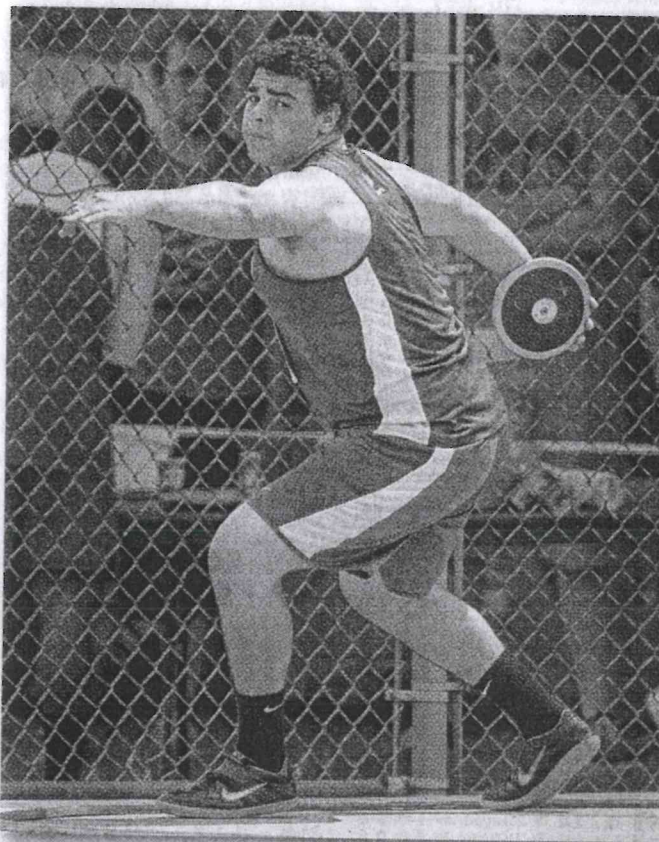
All the work and motivation set up Marmion for what could be a historical weekend. A year ago, he went from an unknown to a state medalist as he finished ninth in the discus, becoming the third Geneseo thrower in four years to do so.

A state qualifier in both the discus and the shot put, Marmion is seeded sixth and 12th, respectively, despite taking third in each event at the Plano Sectional. Earn a medal in either event and he becomes the first thrower in school history to accomplish the feat in back-to-back state meets.

"It would be nice to do that," Marmion said.

Helping him near his goal is aiming for the tire.

Marmion already owns the school record in the

discus, setting the mark of 172-10 two weeks ago at the Northern Illinois Big 12 Conference meet. While he did throw a personal-best 51-6 in the shot put at the sectional, his attention — evident by the tire — points

toward getting the discus distance.

"At this point, he wants to prove to himself" what he can throw, Geneseo throws coach Tom Ferguson said. "The big thing is getting that mark."

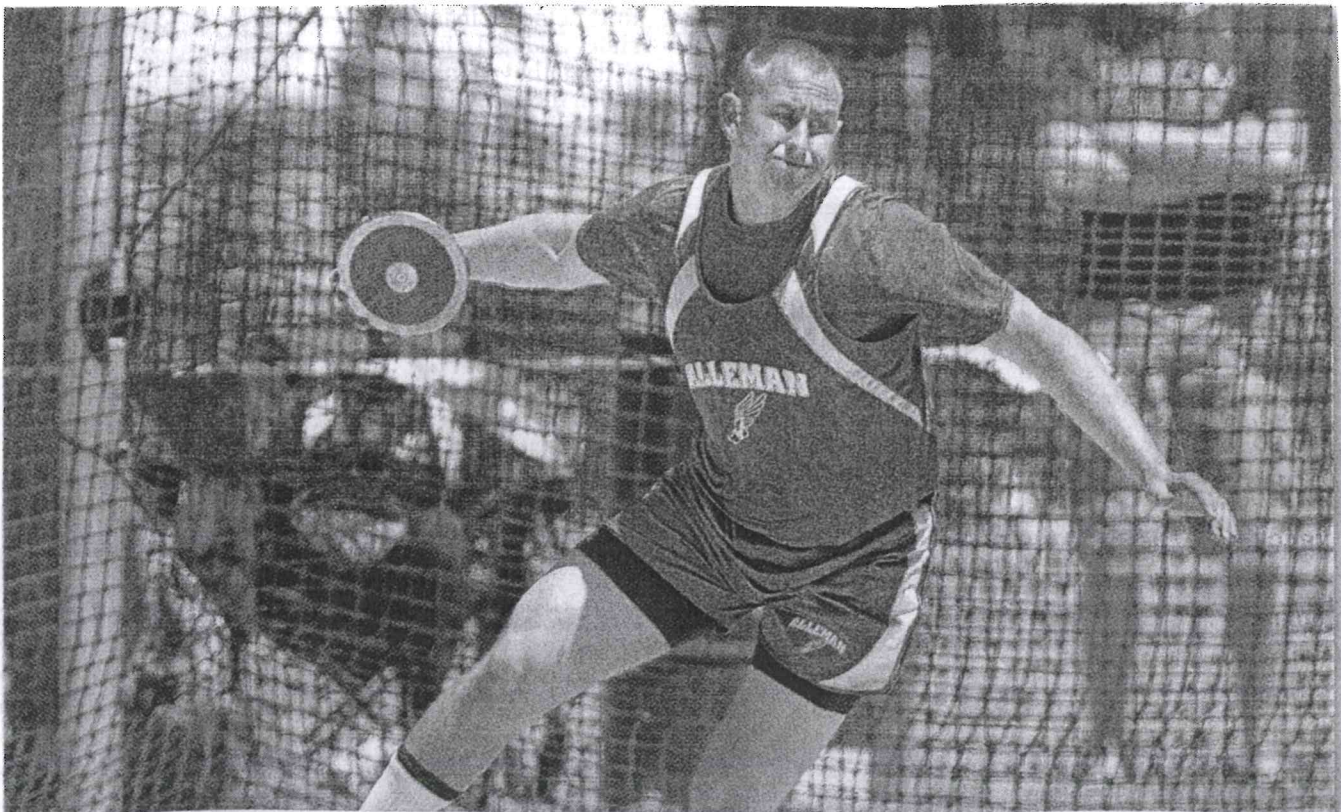

'Up-and-down' day gets Schilb to 2A finals

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CHARLESTON — The result played out as Alleman senior thrower Scott Schilb expected, with a personal best and a so-so performance carrying him into the Class 2A state finals.

There is, however, a caveat to his day.

Schilb actually set his personal best in the shot put — an event he entered with tempered excitement — before experiencing a less-than-desired result in the discus on Friday. Either way, he qualified for the finals at O'Brien Stadium in both events for the first time in his career.

"It's crazy down at state," Schilb said. "It's hit or miss. Some people have huge (personal bests) and big days. Other people just don't show up. That's the way things play out."

No wonder Schilb described the day as "up and down."

The start was a high

as he threw a career best 56-feet-10 3/4 in his first shot-put attempt. All three attempts were better than his previous best.

A year after throwing 48-9 1/2 in the shot-put preliminary, Schilb enters the finals with the third-best throw. Peoria High senior Josh Augusta has the top seed at 62-4.

"I was just relaxed and comfortable in my surroundings," Schilb said. "I had some good warmup throws. That boosted my confidence. I got one out there and it felt great."

Between the shot put and discus, Schilb was all smiles as he carried "confidence" into his go-to event. What followed was a self-described "downer."

Schilb fouled on his first attempt and only reached 149-7 on his second, which was nearly 24 feet below his sectional best. On his final attempt, he threw 155-6.

Entering the finals, that places him eighth.

"I was hoping to carry

over the momentum," Schilb said. "It didn't happen."

After further review, the day was not so bad. Schilb knows his best discus toss can be reached, and the shot put provides a boost as well.

With three more throws in each event, he could become the school's first athlete to medal in both throws in the same season. Only one other Alleman athlete has earned two individual medals at the same state meet.

"I have nothing to lose," Schilb said. "I want to end on a high note. I might as well make them count."

Geneseo junior A.J. Marmion missed the finals in both throws. Marmion threw 141-9 in the discus and 47-9 1/4 in the shot put.

Adlfinger reaches 1600 finals: For the second consecutive year, Alleman senior runner Ethan Adlfinger qualified for the 1600 finals. Adlfinger completed the race in 4:27.17, putting him as the 12th seed.

A year ago, he took ninth in the 1600.

"It didn't go exactly as I thought it might," Adlfinger said. "I got out quickly, but still in last. It took me a while to get past the three guys ahead of me. Once I was out there, I felt pretty comfortable until about 500 (meters) to go. I just didn't have quite the (finishing kick). Hopefully, I'll have it (today)."

Alleman senior Will Graham ran a 4:29.16, finishing 13th overall in the prelims. Graham was one spot away from the finals.

"The last lap, I really fell off," Graham said.

Geneseo did not advance any of its three events. Ethan Reschke (50.99, 400) and Mitchell Lawson (2:01.75, 800) each finished 17th in their respective races.

Lawson, David Chenoweth, Chaise Blakley and Mitchell Lamb ran an 8:28.9 in the 4x800, finishing 23rd.

"It was tough, but it was a good race," Lawson said. "Overall, we did rather well. A pretty good race."

Alleman duo makes state track history

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CHARLESTON — When it comes to historical performances within the Alleman boys' track and field program, Saturday pretty much set the standard.

Actually, history was doubled.

With senior runner Ethan Adlfinger and senior thrower Scott Schilb each earning two state medals at the Class 2A state meet at O'Brien Stadium, the Pioneers had done something they had never done before. Adlfinger becomes the program's first athlete to medal in four state meets and Schilb is its first thrower to medal in back-to-back years.

"It really shows how hard-working our group is and what the coaching staff has done," Schilb said. "The coaching staff works their butts off, putting in a lot of time and effort. It really shows."

Adlfinger and Schilb are proof of the effort.

After placing ninth in the 3200-meter run, Adlfinger had his fourth medal in as many state meets. No other Alleman athlete had ever done so in more than two.

"A great honor," said Adlfinger, who completed the 3200 in 9:29.53. "It's a great feeling."

Ninety minutes later, he capped his career with an eighth-place finish in the 1600, completing the race in 4:27.46.

"I got two medals," Adlfinger said. "Throw out times (because) I'll take the hardware any day."

Schilb offered the same perspective, allowing him to end his career as the most decorated thrower in Alleman history. He started the day with his first-ever shot put medal, taking fourth

despite three scratches.

Carrying over his career-best toss of 56-feet-10 3/4 set in Friday's preliminaries, Schilb still earned the school's highest finish from a thrower.

"I'm not going to complain," Schilb said. "I'm happy with it."

Scratching on two of his three discus attempts, Schilb carried over his best preliminary throw of 155-6 to take ninth. Three of the four throwing medal Alleman has earned now are from Schilb.

"It's disappointing," Schilb said of the ninth-place finish, "but walking away with another medal is great."

Both earned two state medals on Saturday, joining 2002 graduate Nick Hird as the only athletes to win multiple individuals medals the same year. However, the other accomplishments from Adlfinger and Schilb add separation.

"A good ending," Adlfinger said.

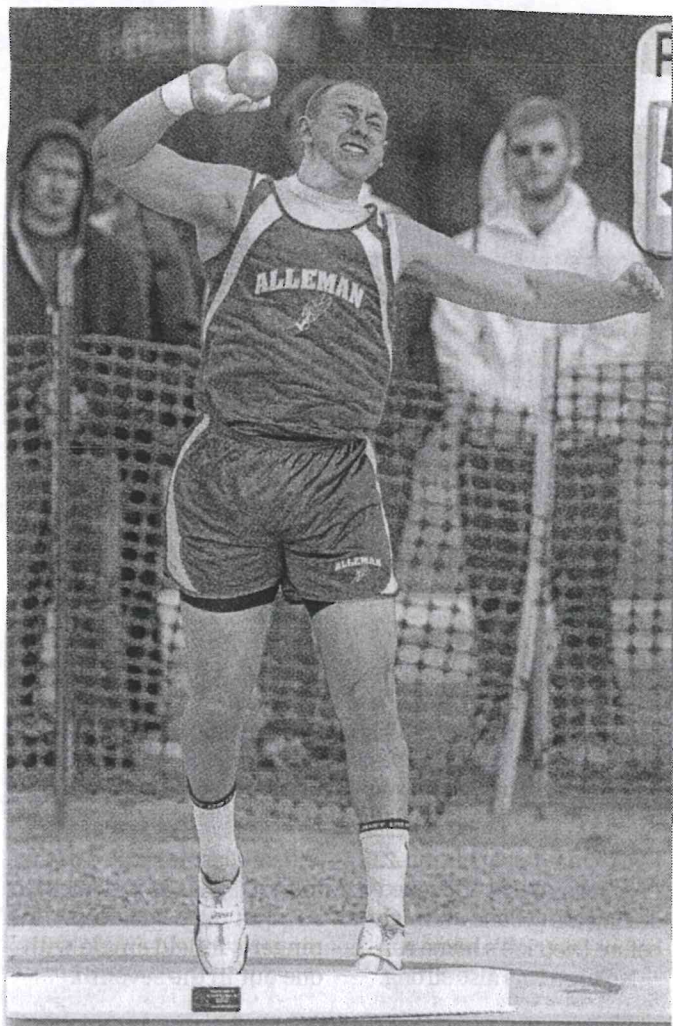
Hird, Perry earn medals: Alleman junior runner Zach Hird earned his first state medal after taking eighth in the 3200. Hird, who ran a career-best 9:29.08, joins his brothers Nathaniel and Nick as a state medalist.

"One of my best days ever," Hird said.

United Township senior thrower Levi Perry ended his career with a first-ever state medal. Perry took eighth in the Class 3A discus.

After carrying over his preliminary-best throw of 156-8, Perry earned the school's first throwing medal in 35 years.

"It's a great feeling," Perry said. "That was one of my goals at the beginning of the year. I've done everything I've come out here to do."

Leafs battle at state

The Geneseo boys' track and field team concluded the 2013 season May 24-25 at the IHSA Boys' Track and Field State Finals in Charleston.

"It wasn't everything we hoped it would be, but they call it the state finals for a reason because it is the best of the best," said head coach Don Fredericks. "You have to be clicking on all cylinders to come back with medals and that was not the case for us."

Jordan Starkey closed out his high-school career with a 16th-place finish in the 3200-meter run with a time of 9 minutes and 41.73 seconds.

"Jordan's goal was to be All-State and he has been so close so many times," said Fredericks. "He went out faster than he ever had, was in great position, but hit a bad patch and lost contact with the pack. Once that gap was established he couldn't close the gap down. He ran a really smart race, and is still the second fastest race in his life."

Ethan Reschke ended his senior year with an eighth-place finish in the prelims of the 400-m dash in 50.99; while Mitchell Lawson placed fifth in the prelims of the 800-m run with a time of 2:01.75.

"Ethan ran a real strong race for him," said Fredericks. "Mitchell ran his lifetime best, and doubling back in the 800 after the 4x800 is awfully tough to do, so for him to come back and run a lifetime best is awesome."

The 4x800-m relay of Lawson, David Chenoweth, Mitchell Lamb and Chaise Blakley came in eighth in the prelims at 8:28.90.

"It was really awesome the 4x800 relay qualified and we knew it was a long shot to make the finals, but they ran a great race and it was a great experience," said Fredericks.

A.J. Marmion finished sixth in the prelims of the shot put

with a toss of 47-9 1/4 and took eighth in the prelims of the discus with a throw of 141-09.

"The goal for A.J. was to make the finals in the shot put, but his last throw was over 51-0, which we thought was good, but it was called a foul," said Fredericks. "In the discus, his first throw was out of bounds, and he really seemed to be lacking confidence in his last two throws. He had one of those days where he was just a little bit off."

"It is a little disappointing we didn't come back with any medals, but we still had a great season," said Fredericks. "We have a good group coming back next year."

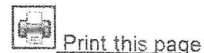
