

# Duty highlights record track day

**GENESEO** — Doug Duty, that sturdy young athlete from Sherrard, is goal-oriented.

Last spring, his discus throw of 166 feet, 9 inches, took third place at the Class A track meet in Charleston. Duty said he wanted to throw 172 feet this spring.

So Tuesday night, in his first meet of the season, Duty uncured a toss of 172-½ — a shot that looked like it might carry clear into Whiteside County when it started out.

"I TRY TO SET realistic goals for myself," said Duty. "I guess 172 (feet) was within my reach. Now, I'll go for 180."

It almost goes without saying that Duty's throw was a Northwest Relays record, one of eight set on a raw, rainy afternoon and evening — which is the usual weather for this 11-school meet.

The emphasis is usually on individual efforts in this meet, although a talented group of sprinters and hurdlers from North Scott did give Geneseo a mild run for the team title.

Geneseo won seven events, just one more than the Lancers, but sweeps of the 800 and 300-meter runs helped the Leafs to a 111-80 first-place margin.

A **STRONG HEADWIND** was blowing, and Duty said the wind added some distance to his throw.

"That throw is beyond the state record," said Sherrard coach Joel Brunsvold. "The state record is about 170-6, set last spring by a kid from Granite City."

Only throws made at the state meet count as state records.

Duty, a 6-foot-2, 200-pounder, also ran on Sherrard's sprint relay teams. "He's fast, and that's what makes him so quick across the ring," said Brunsvold.

**PROPHETSTOWN'S DAVE GILBERT,**

second-place finisher in the Class A pole vault last spring at 13-9, won at 12-0 Tuesday, then stopped jumping in the cold.

Gilbert has cleared 14 feet indoors this season, and wants to vault 16 feet at Charleston.

"What I've got to do is work on my approach on the runway," said Gilbert, who has considerable upper body strength in his 5-9, 134-pound frame. He has bench-pressed twice his body weight.

Scott Rink paced Geneseo's win with victories in the 100 and 200-meter dashes, taking the latter in a record 23.5.

"Scott is more competitive than he has been, and as a team, I think we're competing well," said Leaf coach Jeff Quick. "Scott's best all last season was 23.2. And look at our winning mile relay time (3:31.74). Last year, it was well into May before we got down to 3:30."

**THE IMPLICATION WAS** clear; the Leafs are ahead of schedule.

One-two finishes by Leafs Keith Kincaid and Jeff Renihan in the 800, and by Brad Fleming (in a record :52.43) and Kevin DeBlieck in the 400 resulted in 16 of the 31 points that separated Geneseo and North Scott.

Alleman's Tom Logan took the metric two-mile and mile events, covering 3,200 meters in a record 9:49.72. Another Pioneer win came from Jeff Nepl, who triple-jumped 42-1½.

Quick praised his 3,200-meter relay quartet of Renihan, Rick Rhodes, John Anderson and Kincaid, who posted a record 8:21.6 clocking and won by more than 20 seconds.

North Scott's Mike Ferris, Dane Courville and Craig Power have been varsity sprinters for four seasons, and they were joined by Kevin Geary for wins in the 400 and 800-meter relays. Lancers Jason Suiter, Tim Carter, Mike Newton and Scott Smith took both hurdle shuttles, and the Lancer frosh-soph 400 relay team was victorious.

# Poor conditions can't slow Leafs

GENESEO, Ill. — To the died-in-the-wool track fans here, Tuesday's bitter, rainy weather was perfectly normal on Northwest Relays day. One veteran observer said, "I've been to every one of these for nine years and we've never had a good day."

However, the athletes must have missed the weather report. They performed like it was a sunny afternoon in May.

Out in front were the Maple Leafs of Geneseo and North Scott's Lancers. The darker and wetter it got, the better they ran. Each team broke three meet records while Sherrard's Doug Duty added another in the discus.

**GENESEO WON** the meet going away, 111 to North Scott's 80. Just as the weather was typical, this was a typical Maple Leaf

victory with green-clad runners placing in nearly every event.

Scott Rink, Brad Fleming, Kevin DeBleck and Keith Kincaid were the backbone of Geneseo's effort. Rink, a tall, powerful sprinter, won the 100 meters and broke the meet record in the 200 with his time of 23.57 seconds.

Fleming and DeBleck finished first and second in the 400 meters then ran the third and fourth legs on the Leafs' record-setting 1,600-meter relay team. DeBleck also took first in the high jump while Fleming was fifth in the long jump and second in the triple jump.

Kincaid also contributed a leg on the Leafs' 1,600 team that ran a blistering 1:31.74 — and that was after a leg on the winning 3,200-meter relay team and a first in the open 800.

**BUT WHILE** Geneseo won the big hardware, North Scott was most im-

pressive with its times in the 400 and 800 relays. The Lancers' times of 44.04 seconds in the 400 and 1:32.4 in the 800 were good enough for anytime of the year.

The runners were Mike Ferris, Dane Coureville, Kevin Geary and Craig Power. That's the same combination, with the exception of Geary, that coach Del Ryan has been using for the last two years. Geary transferred in from Tipton to replace the graduated Brian James, who now runs for Luther College.

Their experience showed in the 400, where the baton passes were rock-steady. The Lancers finished their heat 15 yards in front of Geneseo and 1.7 seconds ahead of second-place Prophetstown, which somehow got assigned to the slow heat.

"THOSE TIMES were pretty good," Ryan said. "But Geneseo has a pretty good track team; their awfully hard to beat. Until late in the meet, I think they scored in every event."

North Scott's Jason Suiter, Tim Carter, Mike Newton and Scott Smith also swept the high and low hurdle relays and with another record-setting effort in the frosh-soph 400 relay, took a 4-2 advantage in the relays over the Leafs.

But the race Jeff Quick, Geneseo's appropriately-named coach, wanted most was the 1,600 relay — and he got it. After Kincaid gave Dave Paxon the baton in second place, Paxon burst to a 15-yard lead that was easy for Fleming and DeBleck to maintain.

"Those times for North Scott were super fast," Quick said. "It made me anxious to see what would happen in the 1,600."

"I thought our strength would be in the distance races — that was just a good workout for Kincaid — but all our times were still better than last Thursday."
