

Individuals steal limelight

Leafs dominate county

GENESEO — Years ago, the Henry County Track Meet was run at the fairgrounds in Cambridge. And when track buffs gather over morning coffee, they often recall certain races from those meets, not the teams that won the meets.

It's much the same now. There are some dandy races, but it will take an act of Congress to stop Geneseo from winning the team title. Geneseo is too big for the rest of the county's schools to handle in a track meet, and the Leafs proved it again Tuesday, scoring 110 points, to 50 for Kewanee, and 32 by Annawan. It's a nine-school meet.

"IT WOULD BE a good meet without us in it," said Geneseo Coach Jeff Quick, noting his team's "performances were adequate.

"The main thing for us is to get healthy by Friday. Dave Colo (triple jumper and sprinter) was out with the flu today, and Brad Fleming wasn't feeling well."

Fleming felt well enough to get one of Geneseo's 11 wins, a 42½-foot triple jump that was his season's best. And he teamed with Keith Kincaid, Date Paxson and Kevin DeBlieck for a meet record 3:31.01 1600-meter relay.

Kincaid set another record, winning the 800 in 2:04.62, with teammate Jeff Renihan coming in right behind him, an example of the kind of depth that put the Leafs out of reach.

BUT NO INDIVIDUAL had a better day than Orion sprinter Russell Frank, who won the 100 and 200, the latter in

record time.

The 100 was a photo finish, Frank hitting the line in 11.02, Gerald Hapland of Kewanee coming in at 11.23, and Tony Wancket of Atkinson was timed in 11.24.

In the 200 meters, Frank exploded out of the blocks, ran a strong curve, and held off Harland down the stretch to clock 22.67. The meet record was 23.36.

Both times were season's bests for Frank, said his coach, Jeff Padgett. "He left the others in the blocks," said Padgett. "Russ was good last year. He just got stronger. In the 200, a lot of sprinters slow down the last 20 yards, but he doesn't. And, he does run the curves stronger than last year. He should make it to state."

While Frank scored 12 of Orion's 14 points, Atkinson's Tony Wancket was busy scoring nine of his team's nine and-a-half. In addition to third in the 100 (his best previous time had been 11.4), he won the shot put with a toss of 51-2½, a bit shy of his season's best.

Annawan's Steve Robinson, the county's top-seeded long jumper, won that event at 19-3½, about a foot less than his best. And teammate Dave Nanninga was second in the 110 high hurdles, his 15.41 clocking easily beating his previous best. Nanninga also took third in the 400 dash. Ron Jones picked up a second for Annawan in the shot put.

Geneseo won all four relays on a raw, windy evening, and also got firsts from Rich Werkheiser at 3200 meters, Dave Paxson at 400, John Anderson at 1,600 and DeBlieck in the hurdles.
