Numbers add up

to Geneseo victory

PRINCETON — Geneseo won just three events, but the Maple Leafs claimed the team title at the Princeton Invitational Tuesday night for the 14th time in the meet's 26 years.

This meet is the annual spring pow-wow for the NCIC's Southwest Division schools. Geneseo is the division's largest school, has the largest track team, and numbers were crucial to this Geneseo win.

The difference came in third-place finishes. Geneseo had 13. Rock Falls, which won eight events, and Princeton, which took six, had but two thirds apiece.

That enabled Geneseo to edge Princeton 88½-81 for the title, with Rock Falls third at 73½. Rochelle, Hall and Mendota combined would have finished a distant fourth.

GENESEO came in a prohibitive favorite. "We came off a good finish (second) Saturday at the Dixon Invitationl," said Leaf Coach Jeff Quick. "Our legs were dead, and we were not mentally ready.

"But the main thing was that we competed. That's starting to show every time out. The kids are lining the track and yelling for each other, whether its a distance race or sprint."

Princeton rolled up an early lead with four field event wins, and later the Tigers got wins from two-miler Jamie Dow, and miler Craig

Rock Falls won seven of the eight events that involved sprinting, with ace Ted Nehrkorn winning in all four races he was involved in. Princeton stayed in the hunt by placing second, one spot ahead of Geneseo, in both short sprint relays. Geneseo's Brad Fleming triple jumped 41-8 for a win. Leafs Jeff Renihan, John Anderson, Dave Paxson and Keith Kincaid won the 3,200-meter relay, and Kincaid, Paxson, Fleniand Kevin DeBlieck scored an easy win in the 1,600 relay.

COMPETITIVENESS Quick emphasized was underscored in several races Geneseo didn't win.

In the 200, Rock Falls' Nehrkorn beat Scott Rink by one hundreth of a second, after Rink led at 190 meters. In the 100, Nehrkorn beat Geneseo's Kent Shriver, with Rink a close third.

In the 300-meter low hurdles, Rock Falls' Mike Wolf nipped Geneseo's Kevin DeBlieck with a lean at the tape, with Leaf Jay Penney, attacking the hurdles well, picking up a vital third.

Leaf distance runners also provided mildly surprising help. Rich Werkheiser entered with the third best time at 3,200 meters, but

placed second; Ron Clifton, seeded seventh in that same race, placed fourth. And in the mile, Tony Snyder, also a seventh seed, placed fifth. John Anderson got third, as expected.

Two Leaf weightmen had season's bests, Soctt Rice heaing the shot 48-5 for third, while Mike Stohl's 138-8 was his best in the discus,, and gave him third behind teammate Mike Lodico's 139-11 second-place toss.
