United Township of East Moline, aided by a late scratch from Wendell Phillips of Chicago, won the 8th annual East Moline Kiwanis Invitational track meet Saturday at chilly and windy Browning Field in Moline.

UT, the host of the 9-team meet, took the team title away from defending champ Moline on the strength of some strong relay performances plus several top finishes in other events.

Phillips, the strong favorite for the team title with former record-breakers Sunder Nix and Jerry Monix returning, notified UT officials Saturday morning that it would not be entering.

A YEAR ago, Moline nipped Phillips 79-70 at this same meet in a controversial finish when Phillips' winning mile relay team was disqualified. The Phillips' coaches told UT athletic director Gene McCarter they would never again compete in the meet.

"They called last night and were still coming," Mc-Carter said. "This morning, they said they wouldn't be here because of some transportation problems. Apparently, there weren't any school buses to transport the team and the school has a rule against renting or chartering any transportation other than school buses."

UT wasn't able to clinch the team title until Jeff Honert's fifth-place finish in the mile run — the next to last event. The Panthers ended with 83 points with Moline second at 78 and Rockford East third at 71.

No records were seriously challenged.


HIGHLIGHTS of the meet were the victories by U'T's 440 and 880 relay teams and double victories by Moline's Ron Carpenter in the high and low hurdles; Galesburg's John Davidson in the shot put and discus; and Rockford East's Steve Clark in the one-and two-mile runs.

Panther Coach Jim Wesselman used the same lineup in both the 440 and 880 races with Todd Holman, Mark Shields, Eric Walker and Andre Cuerington. Their 440 time was 44.3 seconds, just .8 of a second off the record.

"It really helps for timing when you have the same

kids running in both the relays," Wesselman said. "Overall, we got a good performance by just about everyone.

"It sure didn't hurt us that Phillips didn't show up, but I think it changed the strategy of several of coaches as far as where he wanted to put different athletes. I'm sure some of the relay teams might have been different if Phillips were here. They definitely were the team to beat.

"YOU'D HAVE to say the 20 points we got for winning the 440 and 880 relays really helped in the team standings, but then so did the 2-3 finishes we got in the pole vault (Randy Smith and Dean Fletcher) and the two-mile run (Honert and Terry Shamsie)."

Gene Shipley, Moline's coach, was also pleased with his team's runnerup performance.

"We were looking for maybe a first place out of Mark Holmes in the discus, but he didn't even place," Shipley said. "He's been coming along slow for us.

"And it didn't help having two of our team members (Andy Graham and Doug Wyatt) on the school choir's trip to Florida. We figured Graham would place in at least three events and Wyatt runs in the sprints and on some of our relay teams.

"We don't have a lot of super athletes, but we're getting points out of a lot of individuals." **CARPENTER** spent all of last year chasing Moline's standout hurdlers Rob Johnson and Tony Jones. He had his day in the spotlight Saturday with first-place medals in both the 120-yard high and 330 low hurdles.

"I know I've got some big shoes to fill in the hurdle races," Carpenter said. "We really racked up the points in that event last year. In the Western Big Six meet, Johnson was first, Jones second and I was third. This

year, I kinda feel by myself.

"In the highs, I was getting pushed pretty good by the Rockford East kid (Keith Jackson) and in the lows, the kid from Geneseo (Kevin DeBlieck) gave me a good race."

Moline, with Carpenter winning the two hurdle races, had the most first-place winners with five. Other Maroon champs were the frosh-soph 440 relay team, the mile relay team and John Roche in the pole vault.

Rockford East had four champions with United Township and Galesburg three each.
