In spite of a dual meet record of one win, seven losses, and one tie, the Geneseo Boys Varsity Track Team did set a new school record. The Distance Medley team, consisting of Tim Renihan (800), Chris Swain (400), Rich Werkheiser (1200), and Eric Zeitler (1600), ran a record time of 10:54.5. In some of the invitationals, Geneseo placed second at the Northwest Relays, fourth at the Geneseo Invitational, sixth at NCIC, and tenth at District. In the final meet of the season, the Geneseo Night Relays, GHS placed first. Two boys, Pat Fortune (discus) and Mark Bouwens (pole vault), qualified for state. Steve Green and Mitch Fickling were chosen most improved, Rich Werkheiser was most valuable, and Kent Shriver and Gordon Cox were elected co-captains.


