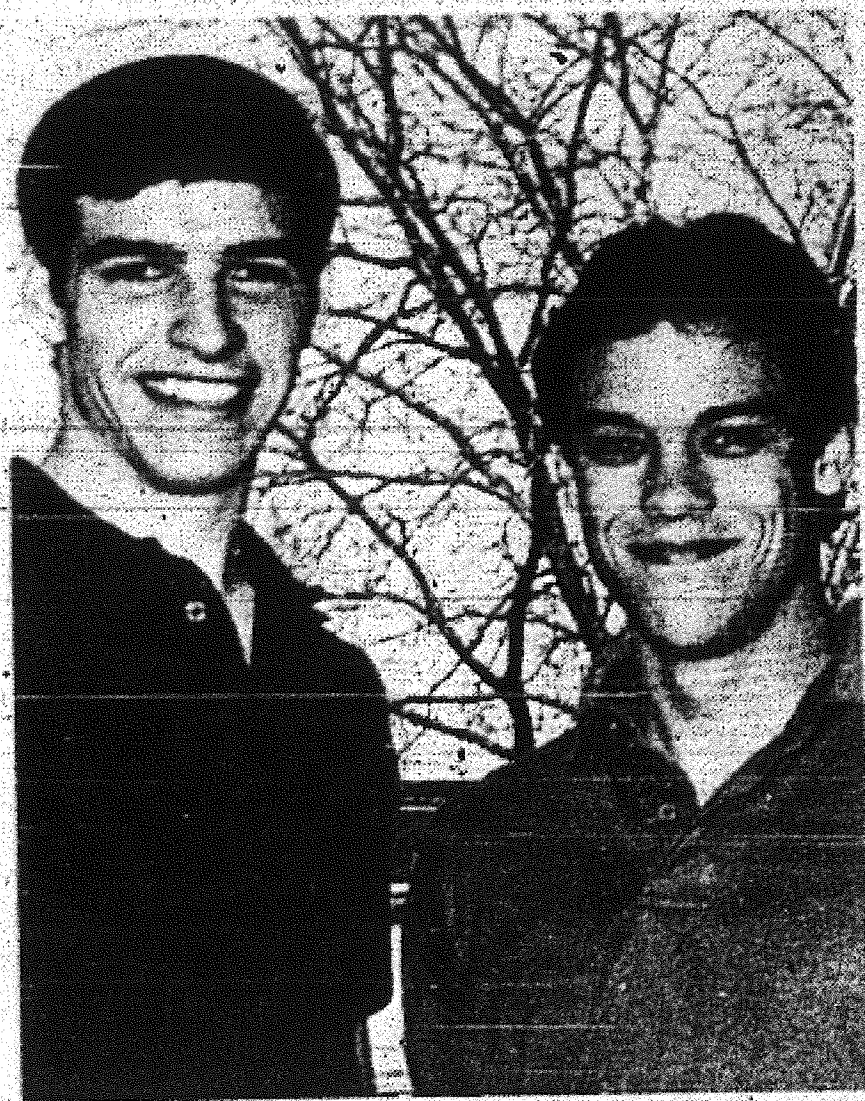

Set records

Fred Little, left and Trent Foltz recently set Geneseo school track records. Foltz' :10.7 clocking in the 100 meters broke his own mark of a year ago while Little shattered the 110 high hurdles mark of :14.8 held jointly by Richard Anderson and Paul DePauw. Little's clocking was :14.6.

Both records were set at the Betterdorf Invitational on Friday, April 20. They are the sons of the William Foltzes and Manfred Littles.

Dash mark missed

GENESEO — Geneseo High School has produced its first-ever sub-10-second sprinter.

Maple Leaf senior Trent Foltz is a 9.9 man — and his feat, accomplished two weeks ago, almost went unnoticed.

"That's because Trent ran behind Thomas Adams from Rock Island," said Leaf coach Jeff Quick. Adams posted a 100-meter time of 10.42 seconds to win; Foltz was second in 10.75. That came April 13 at the Bettendorf Invitational.

Nine-tenths of a second are deducted from 100-meter times to equate them with 100-yard dash times. That would give Adams a blazing 9.52; Foltz a 9.85. For Adams, a great time, and a nice win. But for Foltz, well, he made Geneseo history, shattering a 47-year-old school record.

Last May 6, Foltz ran a wind-aided 10.94, and for record purposes, Geneseo's coaches listed that as a 10-flat 100-yard dash, tying the mark Roger McKenzie had established in 1937.

At the time, Quick knew he would get some argument about listing a 10.94 (converted 10.04) as a 10-flat 100. Some local track buffs, noting that times weren't kept in hundredths of a second in the '30s, insisted that all hundredths of a second be rounded up to the next tenth of a second when converting for record purposes.

Thus, Foltz' 10.94 (converted 10.04) became a 10.0, not a 10.1.

It's not that folks in Geneseo weren't rooting for Foltz; probably, the opposite has been true. It's just that some were trying to honor and protect history.

It doesn't matter now. The 10.75 Foltz ran at Bettendorf converts to 9.85 for 100 yards, or 9.9.

Fred Little wins three hurdle race top places

Leaf trackster Fred Little won three hurdle races at the East Moline Kiwanis track invitational and the Bettendorf Invitational held recently.

At East Moline, Little won the 300 low hurdles and the 110 high hurdles while taking the 400 lows at Bettendorf. The 400-meter Leaf weightman relay team won the event; the only other Geneseo first in either meet.

Geneseo was third at Bettendorf and fourth at East Moline.

Trent Foltz notched second in the 100-meter dash at both meets.
