

Leaf cindermen are second at two meets

Geneseo's boys took their second straight second place finish in three days at the 12-team Dixon Relays Saturday, April 7. The Leafs finished second in the nine-team Pleasant Valley Spartan Relays Thursday, April 5.

With the Leafs leading in the 400 relay, anchor Trent Foltz dropped the baton and the Leafs failed to place in the event at Pleasant Valley, costing a possible title. In the opening meet of the year, the Leafs took second in the nine-team field, bowing to Cedar Rapids Kennedy by 5 1/2 points.

Geneseo coach Jeff Quick would have liked to have picked up the victory, but was pleased with his squad's effort. "It was a good meet for us," Mr. Quick noted. "The big thing was that the 10 kids we had in field events, nine of them scored. That area has been a weakness for us the past few years."

Tim DeKezel took second in the high jump for the Leafs while Chuck Girtten took second in the discus and Brad Stohi second in the shot.

Mr. Quick also noted the efforts of Fred Little, who took first in the 110 high hurdles and second in the 400 low hurdles, and Tim Arnett, who took first in the 3,200 and second in the 1,600. He also felt that Foltz ran well for this early in the season when he took second in the 100 to Alleman's Louis Ritchie.

At Dixon, the Leafs took firsts in the 440 high hurdle shuttle, 440 low hurdle shuttle relay and the 400 weightmen's relay, while finishing with 89 points to host Dixon's 111. The weightmen's relay did not count in the official scoring, however.
