

# Geneseo boys win their own invitational; girls are third

Geneseo high school hosted separate Geneseo Invitational track meets for boys and girls on Friday, May 4 and Monday, May 7, respectively. The Leaf boys won, baring second-place Rochelle 130 1/2-92 while the girls were third with 131 points, behind first place Moline (153) and second place United Township (130).

The Maple Leaf boys scored in 17 of 19 events.

Senior hurdler Fred Little beat his meet records in the 110-meter high and 300 lows. But Geneseo's 400 relay quartet stole the show, topping a meet record — and a formidable Geneseo school mark.

Karl Tubbs, Todd Calahan, Rich Willenkens and Trent Foltz flashed around the track in 45.71, topping a 1977 school mark set by Dave Anderson, Wayne Strader, Pete Poulos and Dave "Red" Anderson.

Little's hurdle times were 15.0 in the highs and 39.44 in the lows. Foltz edged Allemen's Louis Ritchie to win the 100 in 11.06 while Scott Hinton, Brad Rink, and Doug Emerick joined Tubbs as Geneseo won the 800 relay.

For the girls, Geneseo received wins from its 3,200 and 1,600 relay quartets. Anchor runner Priscilla Gomer was third when she took the baton in the 3,200 event. In the 1,600, Larri DeBleck, Nadine VanDeKerckhove, Gwen Cox and Konni Davis won in 4:20.38.

Cox was second in the open 400 while discus thrower Denise Yoder's personal best of 112 1/4 was second by just over one foot.

Geneseo scored in 17 events but won just two.

The girls' sectional is Saturday.

# Leaf boys poor hosts

GENESE0 — Depth was the bread and butter, and three records were the spice Friday night as Geneseo buried an 11-team field to win the Geneseo Invitational boys' track meet.

The Maple Leafs, scoring in 17 of 19 events, totaled 130½ points; Rochelle was next at 92.

Senior hurdler Fred Little beat his meet records in the 110-meter highs and the 300 lows. But Geneseo's 400 relay quartet stole the show, topping a meet record — and a formidable Geneseo school mark.

Karl Tubbs, Todd Cahalan, Rich Willemkens and Trent Foltz toured the oval in 43.71, topping a 1977 school mark set by Dave "Bones" Anderson, Wayne Strader, Pete Poulos and Dave "Red" Anderson.

Little's hurdle times were 15.0 in the highs and 39.44 in the lows. Foltz edged Alleman's Louis Ritchie to win the 100 in 11.05, and Scott Hinton, Brad Rink, and Doug Emerick joined Tubbs as Geneseo won the 800 relay.

Leaf coach Jeff Quick, who had to juggle some relay lineups at the last moment, got positive results, and praised his team's depth. He cited

Cahalan: "He was in on a school record in the 400 relay, his 1:59.55 (second place) makes him one of the 10 fastest half-milers in Geneseo history, and his 51.7 split in the mile relay was his personal best. Overall, it was his best day ever for us."

Quick, noting a 49-3 (fourth-place) shot put by Kelly Scott, said, "He's added three feet in about two weeks. Jim Varga ran 15.8 in the highs and 40.5 in the lows, and those are great times for a sophomore."

The Leaf coach also had praise for sprinters Willemkens, Brad Rink and Doug Emerick.
