

Leafs run for history

GENESE0 — Sterling High School has won the NCIC boys track and field meet 40 times in the 54 years it has been run, including 23 wins in the 28 years DuWayne Dietz has been head coach, and 21 of the last 22 seasons.

Last year, Geneseo, picked to finish third, was pleased to place second, some 50 points behind the Golden Warriors.

That's history. And Geneseo wants to make history Friday night.

"IF WE'RE healthy, I think we could give them a run," said Geneseo coach Jeff Quick, who admits, "I'm so excited, I may have to be locked in a room."

Quick scratched out points and came up with Sterling 140, Geneseo 120. And, in a meet scored 10-8-6-4-2-1, that's pretty close. "Sterling has guys who'll win relays and score 10 points, and we've got individuals who'll win and score 10 points," said Quick. "The meet won't be won on top. We're hoping to get thirds and fourths, and we need for some of the other good kids in the league to bump down some of Sterling's guys."

The meet starts with field events and running prelims at 3 p.m. Friday in Sterling's Eades Stadium. The first running final is at 6.

Hurdler Fred Little and sprinter Trent Foltz, two key figures for Geneseo, are expected to run after suffering minor leg injuries in Friday's Geneseo Invitational. Sterling's Tim Arnold, a state-class performer in the 200 meter dash and a key link in the Warriors' sprint relays, might not be so lucky.

Arnold was working out last week during a girls' dual meet when he tried to dodge a girl — a Geneseo girl, ironically enough — and injured his right foot. He may compete Friday — and he may be out for the spring. It's a day-to-day thing.

STERLING IS DEEP in sprinters, and in distance runners. Quick figures the Warriors will outscore Geneseo by 10 points in the four relays, and he's hoping the Leafs' crack 400 quartet can beat Sterling's quick unit.

Sterling also has one-two capability in the 200 and the 800. But, he's hoping senior Todd Cahalan can break up

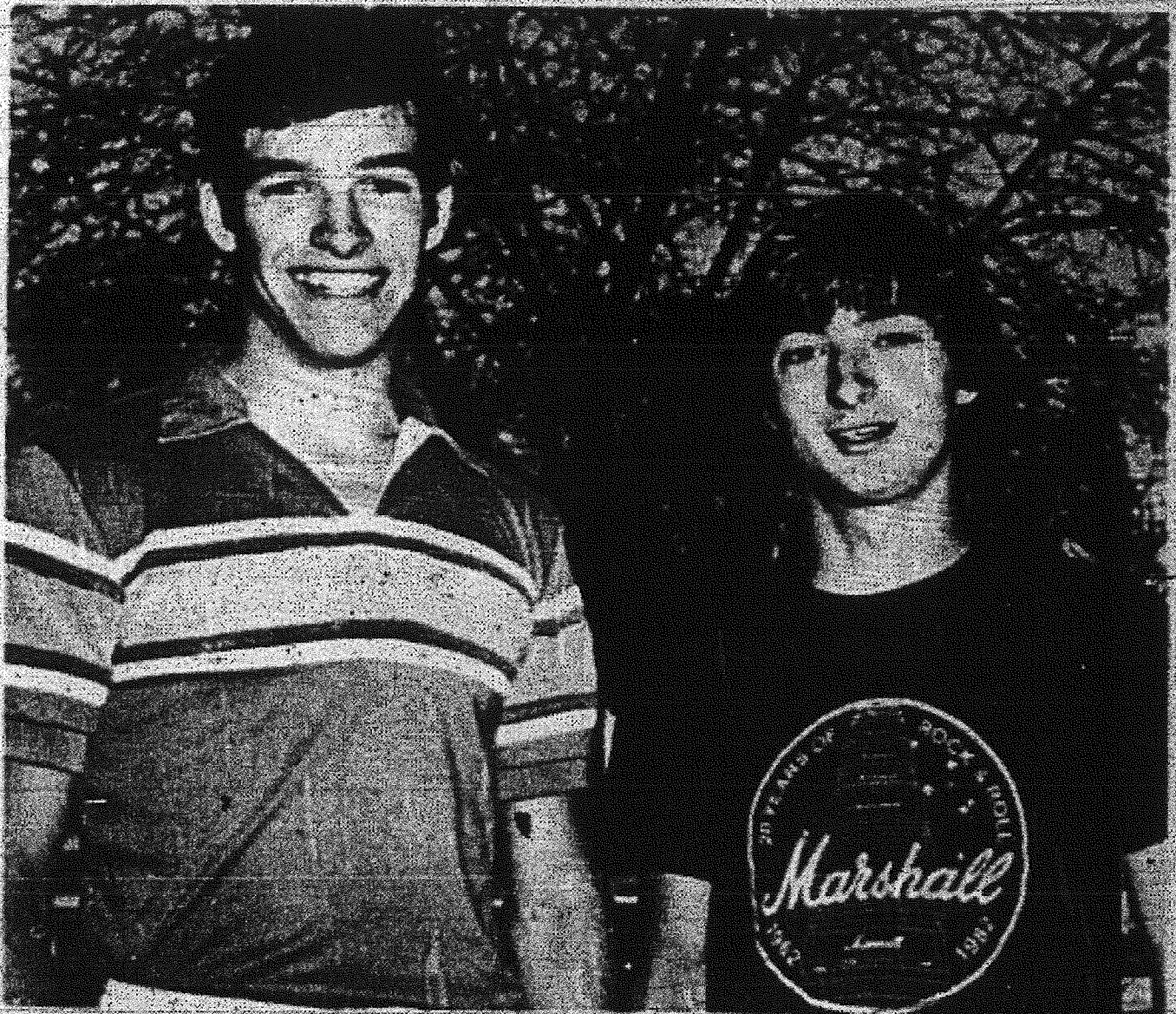
Sterling's strength in the 800, and thinks Foltz, the favorite in the 100, is strong enough to win at 200, too.

Then come the two hurdles races, where Geneseo could pick up 30 or more points on the Golden Warriors. Little is top-seeded in both races; sophomore Jim Varga is the third seed, and Sterling would be pleased to get a place finish in either race.

Another key figure for Geneseo: distance ace Tim Arnett. "Brad Onken from Sterling has the top time over 1,600 meters, but I'm not sure if he's recovered enough from an injury to be strong in both that and the 3,200," said Quick, who's hoping for third or better in both races from Arnett.

"A key for us will be to get some places in the field events," said Quick, knowing that too is a key for Sterling, which isn't terribly strong in this area after 15-1 pole vaulter Mike Murray. "Our shot putters, Brad Stohl and Kelly Scott, and our discus throwers, Chuck Girten and Gary Fortune, are capable on a given day," said Quick. "So is Brian Jones in the long and triple jumps. Tim DeKezel could place at 6-2 in the high jump, so could Jeff Thies at 6 feet. Dave Knepp, our vaulter, could score."

Geneseo last won the NCIC title in 1945.

Fred Little wins sole Leaf N.C.I.C. crown

Sterling's boys won the N.C.I.C. track meet for the 41st time in the meet's 54 years, amassing 134½ points. Rochelle was second with 82 points; Geneseo finished third with 63½ points. The meet was Saturday, May 12.

Geneseo's only victory came in the 110-meter high hurdles, when senior Fred Little and sophomore Jim Varga went one-two, Little clocking :15.19, Varga :15.38.

The Leafs' Trent Foltz, top-seeded in the 100-meter dash, pulled up and didn't finish. Sterling's Kevin Milliron and Tim Arnold finished one-two, unseeded Leaf Karl Tubbs got a fourth-place finish. Foltz and Little were nursing hamstring pulls.

Little placed second (in :39.13) in the 300-meter lows later in

the meet.

Junior distance runner Tim Arnett lost a first place battle to Dixon's Sid Aurand in the 3,200 meter race, but the Leaf thin-clads clocking of 9:29.52 broke Randy Pobanz' school record. Arnett came back with a 4:29.68 in the 1,600 to take sixth, but was his personal best and the third fastest metric mile ever run by a Geneseo athlete.

Leaf Brian Jones missed the finals by an inch with his personal best long jump of 20 feet, 3 inches. He placed sixth.

Sterling rolls past NCIC field again

STERLING — Sterling did it again. The Golden Warriors, getting the state's best pole vault this spring (15 feet, 6 inches) from Mike Murray, and two record-setting runs, by its sprint relay team, crushed a 12-team field Friday night in the North Central Illinois Conference meet.

In winning for the 41st time in the meet's 54 years, Sterling won six events and amassed 134 ½ points. An expected challenge from Geneseo ended early, and Rochelle sneaked by the Maple Leafs 82 to 63 ½ for second place.

Geneseo's only victory — and the high point of the evening for the Maple Leafs — came in the 110-meter high hurdles, when senior Fred Little and sophomore Jim Varga went one-two, Little clocking :15.19, Varga an un-sophomoric :15.38. That cut Sterling's lead after seven events to just 41-37. But the wheels came off Geneseo's wagon in the next event.

THE LEAFS' Trent Foltz, top-seeded in the 100-meter dash, pulled up lame and didn't finish. Sterling's Kevin Milliron and Tim Arnold finished one-two, and although unseeded Leaf Karl Tubbs got a respectable fourth-place finish, damage had been done.

Foltz was through for the evening and Little, although he would place second (in :39.13) in the 300-meter lows later in the meet, was hurting, too. Both have hamstring pulls — Little had trouble getting his lead leg over hurdles properly — and Leaf coach Jeff Quick said both are questionable for next week's sectional.

"No excuses, but all season we've revolved around three guys, and when two aren't able to perform at their best, it has a tremendous psychological effect on the kids," said Quick.

The third guy — junior distance ace Tim Arnett — wasn't hurting a bit. He lost a splendid battle to Dixon's Sid Aurand in the 3,200 meter race, but Arnett's clocking of 9:29.52 broke

Randy Pobanz' school record. Arnett came back with a 4:29.68 in the 1,600. That took sixth, but was his personal best, and the third fastest metric mile ever run by a Geneseo athlete.

STERLING'S MURRAY Murray, a 6-foot-1, 175-pound junior, used a combination of speed and upper body strength to equal a 15-6, best-in-Illinois vault he'd made earlier this spring. "My run wasn't strong, but I felt smooth on the pole," said the junior, who noted he'd like to beat the state record of 16 feet, ¼ inch this spring, then go for 16-6 next year.

"I walk on my hands a lot and hit the weights to develop strength," said Murray. "I need work on pulling and turning when I come off the pole."

Records don't go down easily in a 54-year-old meet. But, besides Murray's new NCIC mark, Sterling's quartet of Milliron, Arnold, Bret Clark and Kirk Sanders set league marks in the 400 (:42.70) and 800 (1:29.49) relays.

Rochelle's Tim Trosper won the high jump at 6-6, the 400 in :49.60, and anchored a winning 1,600 relay team. Kewanee's Eric Welgat won the long and triple jumps at 22-8 ½ and 45 feet, ¼ inch, respectively.

THE TRIPLE JUMP was a tough event. Sixth place went at 42-11; a lifetime best of 42-1 by Geneseo's Brian Jones missed finals by an inch. Jones' best long jump, 20 feet, 3 inches, placed sixth, and drew Quick's praise.

"I compliment Sterling; they did everything well and got everything that had been expected — maybe more," said Quick. "And Rochelle really rallied around some guys who performed well. We need to develop more depth, and more consistency."
