Leafs to NCIC

second place

Sterling has won the last ten N.C.I.C. varsity boys meets but this year the winning streak was broken. Dixon took the N.C.I.C. meet held here in Geneseo, Friday and Saturday, May 9-10 with a total of 144 points. Geneseo followed in second place, tallying 120½ while Sterling brought up third place with 83.

Dixon took seven events while Geneseo took four of the 18-event meet.

Varga took three of the four first places for Geneseo and was a member of the fourth first. Varga took the 300 meter low hurdles in 38.88, the 200 meter dash in 22.42, the 110 high hurdles in 14.69 and teamed with Brad Rink, Jeff Morales, Steve Fleming for the 400 meter relay, 43.99.

Geneseo beat Dixon on the track, 92-90 points but Dixon tallied 54 to Geneseo's 28½ in the field events.

"We were beaten by an outstanding team, and we beat an outstanding team" commented Geneseo coach Don Fredericks. "Varga had an awe-

some night."

Sterling managed only 31 points on the track but produced 52 in the pits, but an injury-riddled sprint and distance corps prevented the Sterling Golden Warriors from making a serious run at another title.

Rink and Morales executed a crisp baton exchange in the 400 meter relay; after that, it was mostly speed which beat second-place Kewanee by one-hundredth of a second. "Fleming took off a

little slow but he made up for it," Morales said. Varga added, "I thought Kewanee made the final exchange before we did, but they were out in the curve, and I was able to make up some ground right there."

Taking seconds for Geneseo were Mike Lohman in the shot put and the 3,200 and 800 relay teams. "That 8:07.0 was the best for the 3,200 team by 11 seconds, said Coach Fredericks, praising the opening 1.58 split by Todd Puckett.

A surprise for the Geneseo Leafs came from junior jumper Barry Reade who posted personal bests of 19-3 for a fourth in the long and a 41-2 for third in the triple. Reade's previous best in the triple was 39-8.

Frosh-soph tracksters win NCIC boys meet

Geneseo's frosh-soph track team captured first place in its portion of the N.C.I.C. competition held in Geneseo Friday.

May 9.

Geneseo took the meet with 126 final points followed by Sterling in second with 104 and Ottawa in third with 99 1/2.

Geneseo held first place finishes in six of 18 events. Ted Leaman captured first in the 400 meter dash in 53.42 while teammate Mike Morris took the 800 meter run in 2:05.2. Maice Quayle, Todd Smith, Pat Coppens and Steve Zobrist teamed for the winning 400 meter relay (45.11) while Morris joined Tim Moran, Mike Johnson and Ged Woelke for the 3200 meter relay and a winning time of 8:40.21.

Zobrist also contributed to Geneseo's victory with a first in the 300 low hurdles (41.44). Marty Frymire took the high jump event with a 62" leap.

A new N.C.I.C. record was set in the discus during the Friday, May 9 N.C.I.C. boys frosh-soph track meet. Koplin of LaSalle Peru gave the discus a mighty

heave for 146 3/4" and a new record. Second place went to Kyaraggard of Sterling with a toss of 138 5/8".
