Trackmen capture six gold at Sterling invite

Geneseo took first place in six events of the Sterling Invitational Track meet held Tuesday, May 5, for a second place overall finish for the day.

The Leafs tallied 80 points, second to hosting Sterling who marked 98. Clinton and Bettendorf finished out the four-team event with 47 and 34 points, respectively.

On the track, Geneseo took first in the 3200 relay, 800 meter run, 800 relay and 300 low hurdles while field events taken by Leafs were the high jump and triple jump.

Phil Walsh, Rod Sandberg, Brad Baker and Scott Johnson teamed together for a first place time of 8:14.1 in the 3200 relay. Bud Bennington was joined by Scott VanHoutte, Tony Schefsky and Todd Smith in the 800 relay for a time of 1:36.4.

Mike Haars captured first in the 800 run for the Leafs with his time of 2:01.6 while Bryan Eyrich crossed the line in the 300 low hurdles in 40.4.

Todd Akers' jump of 5'4" was the winner for the high jump and another first for Geneseo. Leaf Jay Reed took top honors in the triple jump with his leap of 41'5 1/2".

Both the first and second place finishes were tied up by Leaf cindermen in the 800 run and in the triple jump. Haars was followed through the tape by teammate Mike Morris in the 800 while Akers wrapped up second in the triple jump behind

Reed.

Second and third place finishes were taken by Leafs in the discus with Jeff Sandy nabbing second followed by Steve Nitz in third.

Seconds were also earned by Walsh in the 1600 run, Larry Johnson in the shot put and by the 1600 relay team. Thirds were earned by the 400 relay team, Eyrich in the 110 high hurdles, Ted Leamen in the 400 run and by Steve Durick in the pole vault event.
