

Track season starts on "the right foot"

It's early in the season, however, things are going quite well. Coach Don Fredericks comment summarizes the "start on the right foot" approach by the Geneseo track teams.

Geneseo's varsity tracksters took first with 50 points Tuesday, March 17 in Westwood, Dixon, winner of the N.C.I.C. track title last year, took second with 33 points while Rochelle trailed 33.

"It's very early in the season and we're still pulling our line up together, however, things are going quite well and we're very excited about moving to the outdoor season," Coach Fredericks stated.

Senior Scott Johnson and Junior Steve Fleming are an example of the "quite well" accomplishments of the track squad.

Johnson earned firsts in the 3200 relay, the 800 and the 1600 relay. Fleming also marked three firsts, one in the short sprint, the 800 relay and the 300 meter.

Other members of the first place 3200 relay squad with Johnson were Brad Baker, Ged Woelke and Jeff Schneider. The group clocked an 8:51.3 for the top spot.

Johnson, Mike Morris, Rod Sandberg and Ted Leamen combined efforts for a 3:45.1 first place finish in the 1600 relay.

Aiding Fleming in the 800 relay were Steve Zobrist, Scott VanHoutte and Todd Smith. The team stopped the clock at 1:48.3.

Junior Philip Walsh gave Geneseo a boost by taking first in the 3200 meter event. Third and fourth places were earned by Leafs Mike Haars and Shawn Alexander, respectively.

Several other top finishers aided in the meet victory. Second, third and fourth places were earned by Leafs in the 1600 event. Walsh clocked in second, followed by Haars in third and Baker in fourth.

Woelke crossed the line third in the 800 followed by teammate Schneider for fourth. Three shots were earned by Leafs in the 400 meter race; also Leamen nabbed second while Sandberg and Morris took third and fourth, respectively, in the event.

Bryan Eyrich edged out Leaf Zobrist in the short sprint, low hurdles for second, handing Leamen a tight third.

Matt Shoemaker earned Geneseo a point by taking fourth in

the 300 while Larry Johnson added yet another with a fourth in the shot.

Second place honors were handed to Todd Akers in the high jump. Coach Fredericks praised Akers for the event. The junior had the performance of the meet for us, jumping a near school record 6'4" in the high jump. Teammate Dean Lewis took fourth in the event.

Todd Erbst vaulted into second place in the pole vault event while Leaf Steve Durick placed third.

Mark Roede earned two second place honors. Roede leaped 19'6" for second in the long jump while kicking 39'8" in the triple jump for second. Akers took fourth in the triple jump.

An overwhelming victory occurred in the freshman division of Tuesday's meet. Geneseo tallied 108 team points while Dixon marked just 50 and Rochelle 20.

Several firsts contribute to the spectacular defeat. Fourteen of 15 events were won by Leaftrack tracksters.

Three relays took first: the 3200, the 800 and the 1600. Members of the 3200 relay were Jason Pirkl, Mike Bell, Christian Michaelisen and Brian Walsh. The 800 relay squad consisted of Corey Graden, Eric Carter, Jim Roberts and Tony Schelsky.

Combined efforts by Pirkl, Matt Denton, Barry Bassler and Michaelisen earned the first for the 1600 relay.

David Dow tossed a 48lb shot for first place while his teammate, Chad Harder, took fourth.

Justin Reid leaped 5'6" to tie for the top spot in the high jump while jumping 40'0" for sole

ownership of the triple jump title.

Daniel Allen tied for fourth in the high jump event before taking third in the triple jump. Chris Bush marked fourth in the triple.

Glenn Klopp soared 10'6" for first in the pole vault while Brian Klopp marked a 10'0" height and tied second place.

A 17'7" long jump leap by Roberts earned him first place honors while Joe Rogers took fourth.

First and second places in the short sprint were taken by Leaftrackers. Graden clocked in at 7.2 for first followed by Schelsky.

The top three spots were earned by Geneseo cindersmen in the 3200 meter event. Vic Brekunskas took the tape for first while Joe Holscher finished second and Jim Henderson, third.

Jason VanVoren led the pace in the 800 with a time of 2:15.95. Michaelisen and Gary Driggs took the next two slots, second and third, respectively. VanVoren also placed first in the 1600 meter race with a time of 3:06.85. Brekunskas took second.

Jon Puentes and Rogers took the leads in the 400. Puentes took first with a tape time of 1:21.14 while Rogers held second.

Top notches were earned by the Leaftrack in the 300 meter race. Taking first with a 40.9 was Schelsky followed by Chad Blunt, second, Eric Carter, third and Graden, fourth.

Junior Jon McAvoy and Bush took second, third and fourth, respectively, in the short sprint low hurdles.
