

Harriers prepare to take on Sterling for conference title

Geneseo boys' track team traveled to Sterling for a meeting with Sterling and Freeport at the Westwood indoor track on Tuesday, March 24. Sterling won the meet with 74 points. Geneseo earned 50 while Freeport had 43.

Coach Don Fredericks noted, "Sterling is a perennial conference winner with a tremendous program. They are very sharp for this early in the season."

He feels the indoor facility is a great contributor to Sterling's capabilities.

Coach Fredericks was satisfied with the Geneseo team's performance at Sterling and sees much potential this season.

The last track conference championship for Geneseo was in 1945 and Coach Fredericks feels this year's team has a chance.

Todd Akers, Jay Reed and Larry Johnson did a "super job" at the meet and assistant coaches, Dennis Dierick, Mel Snook and Larry Lohansen are "very qualified," said Coach Fredericks.

Geneseo won the 3200 meter relay with a time of 8:48.9 and

earned a third in the 800 meter relay. Clocking in in the 3200 relay were Scott Johnson, Philip Walsh, Mike Haars and Mike Morris. Members of the 800 relay team were Steve Zobrist, Scott VanHoutte, Todd Smith and Steve Fleming.

John DeGrande placed third while Heath Lowe placed fourth in the 3200 run. Bryan Eyrich took third in the 55 meter high hurdles while Leaf Zobrist edged him out for second.

In the 55 meter dash, Fleming of Geneseo finished third while Smith took fourth.

Johnson captured second place in the 800 meter run while teammate Jeff Schneider came in fourth.

Ted Leamen won the 400 meter dash for the Leafs with a time of .54.48.

Eyrich came in third place in the 55 meter low hurdles also.

In the 1600 meter run, Walsh earned a second place with Haars earning third.

Smith of Geneseo placed fourth in the 200 meter dash while Barry Reade placed third in the long jump followed by

Leaf Bud Bennington in fourth.

Reade and Bennington also placed third and fourth, respectively, in the triple jump. Johnson placed third in the shot. Todd Akers made an impressive high jump of 6'4" for first place.

The Geneseo frosh soph tracksters won first place at Sterling with Sterling in second and Freeport, third.

Geneseo won the 3200 relay in 9:25.03 with members Jason Pirkel, Vic Dzekunskas, Joe Holavost and Chris Michaelson. A second was earned in the 800 relay consisting of Corey Gradert, Eric Carter, Jim Roberts and Tony Schefsky.

Mike Bell and Jim Henderson placed third and fourth in the 3200 run, respectively.

Chad Blunt took the 55 meter high hurdle event with a time of 8.9 and Jon McAvoy came in third.

Schefsky earned fourth in the 55 meter dash. Pirkel placed first in the 800 meter run with a time of 2:19.9 with Barry Bassier placing third and Michaelson taking fourth.

In the 400 meter Jon Puentes won with a time of .60.2 while Joe Rogers held second.

Blunt also placed second in the 55 low hurdles while Chris Bush placed fourth.

Schefsky nabbed a second while Corey Gradert earned fourth in the 200 meter.

In the 1600 meter Dzekunskas placed first in a time of 5:10.9 while Bassier earned second and Bell, fourth.

Geneseo took second in the 1600 meter relay. Members combining efforts were Pirkel, Puentes, Michaelson and Holavost.

Glenn Klopp vaulted fourth in the pole vault event while Roberts leaped for third in the long jump.

In the high jump Justin Reed won first with a jump of 6' with Schefsky finishing third.

Reed also earned first in the shot (33'10") and the triple jump (41'3 1/4").

Dan Allen and McAvoy earned third and fourth, respectively, in the triple jump.
