

Moline edges Geneseo in dual Tuesday meet

Moline edged out Geneseo in a dual varsity track meet Tuesday, May 19 in Geneseo by a final score of 80 1/2-65 1/2.

"We were a little flat following our big John McCormick Invitational on Thursday," Coach Don Fredericks commented. "But overall I am very pleased with the results."

"The biggest thrill was seeing senior quad captain Barry Reade return to action following a six week lay-off due to a broken foot," the track coach continued.

On his return Reade won the triple jump with a distance of 40'3" and placed third in the long jump at 19'6".

The Maroons earned ten golds to Geneseo's eight in the 18-event meet.

The Leafs took firsts in the high jump, discus, 3200 relay, 110 high hurdles, 300 relay, 300 low hurdles and in the 1600 run in addition to Reade's triple jump title.

Scott Johnson, Mike Haars, Mike Morris and Phil Walsh teamed for the 3200 relay and clocked a winning time of 8:24.2 while the 300 relay team of Bud Bennington, Scott VanHoutte, Jason Shoemaker and Todd Smith marked a winning time of 1:36.9.

The second slot was also earned for Geneseo in the triple jump. J. Reed's distance of 40'1" edged out the Moline opponent.

All three places were claimed by Geneseo in the high jump, well, almost. Todd Akers cleared 6'2" for first followed by Dean Lewis in second. Leaf J. Reed and Seth McLean, Moline, tied for the bronze medal position in the jump.

Another highlight for the Leafs was a 145'1/4" throw by Steve Nitz in the discus for the gold while Leaf Matt Shoemaker (137'4") rounded out the scoring by taking third place.

Bryan Eyrich earned first in the 110 high hurdles and in the 300 low hurdles. Eyrich took the tape in 15.95 in the 110 high hurdles followed by teammate Steve Zobrist (18.24) in second. He then clocked a 40.8 in the 300 low hurdles for the lone Leaf finish in the event.

Walsh went solo in the 1600 run to claim the first place honor. He took the tape in 4:35.6, the only Leaf to place in the top three slots in the event.

The Leafs also stacked place finishers in the shot put and 3200 meter run. Larry Johnson (45'10 1/4") and Curt Seel (45' 1/2") joined forces in the shot to claim the silver and bronze for Geneseo while Heath Lowe (11:25.4) and Shawn Alexander (11:30.0)

claimed the same two medals in the 3200 meter run.

The Leafs were also awarded second place finishes in the pole vault, 400 relay and in the 1600 relay. Steve Durick took the honor in the pole vault with his height of 11'6" while team efforts claimed the title in the two relays. Members of the 400 relay were Bud Bennington, Scott VanHoutte, Todd Smith and Zobrist while Haars, Ted Leamen, Rod Sandberg and Mike Morris combined efforts in the 1600.

Reade kept Moline from taking all three in the long jump with his third place finish while his teammate VanHoutte was doing the same in the 100 meter dash with his time of 11.91. Rod Sandberg was the sole Leaf finisher in the top three positions of the 300 run, coming in third with a time of 2:05.9 while Zobrist took the bronze in the 200 dash with his time of 24.01.

Frosh-soph tracksters roll over Moline squad

Geneseo's frosh-soph tracksters took their claim to fame during a dual meet with Moline in Geneseo Tuesday, May 12.

The Leaflets scored 92½ points while Moline mustered just 54½.

Eleven golds were earned by the Leaflets versus the seven by Moline's frosh-soph boys. Ten silver medals were earned by the hosting squad.

Relay squads taking first for Geneseo include the 3200 meter, 400 meter, 800 meter and 1600 meter.

Clocking an 8:56.01 in the 3200 relay were Barry Bassier, Brian Walsh, Jason VanVooren and Christian Michaelsen. Combining leg strength in the 400 relay were Corey Gradert, Eric Carter, Jim Roberts and Tony Schefsky. The foursome clocked 47.6.

Gradert, Carter, Roberts and Schefsky were also instrumental in the gold earned in the 800 relay when they clocked 1:40.48. Michaelsen and VanVooren were joined by Chad Harder and Chad Blunt for a winning 1600 relay time of 3:54.79.

Geneseo took all three top slots in the high jump and pole vault events. Brian Klopp earned first with a high jump of 5'4" followed by Schefsky (5'2") in second and Dan Allen (5'0") in third. Glen Klopp topped the pole vaulting bar at 10' and claimed the first place title. Leaflet Scott Hemm cleared the same height for second while Pat Lawrence tied Marr of Moline for third.

Geneseo also stacked finishers in several other track events and in one other field event. Brad Ottis threw the disc 119'4" for first in the event while Leaflet Todd Versluys gave a third place throw of 106'3½".

Dave Karauel of Moline took the 3200 run with a time of 10:57.83 but Geneseo wrapped

up the remaining two places. Victor Dzhekunskas clocked an 11:54.4 for second followed by Joe Holevoet (12:07.9) in third.

First and second were claimed by Leaflets in the 110 high hurdles with Blunt taking the tape in 15.83 followed by John McAvoy in second with his time of 19.56.

Moline's Chris Ruggles took the 100 meter dash tape in 12.21 for the gold while John Doe (12.51) and Gradert (12.59) captured second and third for the Leaflets.

Harder aided in the victory with his gold in the 400 meter run in a time of 56.90 while Andy Hahn rounded out the scoring with a third place time of 57.42. Blunt added another first to his credit when he took the 300 low hurdles in 45.20. Glen Klopp held tight to the second place finish with a time of 45.86.

Geneseo also doubled up in the 1600 run with Bassier clocking in at 5:09.31 behind Moline's Karauel's 5:08.93. Mike Bell took the bronze medal with a time of 5:20.

Ruggles of Moline captured the top slot in the 200 meter race by the skin of his shoes. Ruggles' time of 24.37 just beat out Carter, who claimed second place honors with 24.48. Hahn then wrapped up third in 25.94.

Dave Dow marked Geneseo in the first place slot for the shot put event with his toss of 42'6½" while Leaflet Michaelsen was holding fast to second in the 800 run. In addition, Brian Klopp earned third in the triple jump while Roberts grasped the silver in the long jump.

Michaelsen narrowly lost the top title in the 800 with his time of 2:13.7. Moline's Taylor bettered him with 2:13.19. Roberts was edged out of the long jump title when his distance of 15'4½" was bettered by Taylor's 18'6½".
