

Akers ties for tenth in finals

Todd Akers, Geneseo's only sectional qualifier, advanced to the finals in the high jump event at the 93rd annual Illinois High School Association's state track meet in Charleston Friday, May 29.

Akers joined a group of 17 high jumpers in the final round, all with jumps of 6'6".

But Saturday, May 30, the Leaf jumper couldn't get past the height of 6'4" and finished in a tie for 10th place. "When I cleared 6'4" early," Akers recalled, "I thought maybe I might have a good day. But then I got off my steps, and lost my concentration."

Saturday's finals were hampered by a two-hour rain delay when thunderstorms hit the area.

The junior Leaf stated, "Then it started to rain and the lightning started to bounce around, the officials stopped the jumping. I never could get back into it after that."

The winning jump in the finals was 6'10" by Stegall of Olympia Fields, Rich Central.

Akers tied for second in the

high jump at a mark of 6'3" during sectional competition Friday, May 22 for his state meet berth. The sectional meet was also centered around weather conditions which left few state qualifiers in any event.
