

Weather can't stop

Little Hawks

ELDRIDGE, Iowa — Wind. Rain. Cold. Gloom.

Those weather conditions never stopped the United States Postal Service from delivering and Tuesday night during the Lancer Relays under the same dreary conditions, Iowa City High licked and stamped the rest of the field.

The Little Hawks took first with 103 points with Geneseo a distance second at 63. Next came Davenport North with 59 and host North Scott Scott notched 48 points for a fourth-place finish.

"We were flat tonight, maybe it was the weather conditions," Maple Leaf Coach Don Fredericks summed up. "I've never encountered weather conditions this bad at a track meet before; during the two-mile run the wind shifted and the temperature must've dropped 20 degrees. Luckily the rain stopped.

"I'm pleased with our efforts today but it's hard to draw any conclusions from them because of the weather."

Although a stiff breeze of over 30 mph made it seem like the Siberian Relays, instead of the Lancer Relays, a few meet records were set.

Muscatine's Kevin Monroe

broke one in the 100-meter dash and another in the 200. His :10.52 time in the 100 beat the old mark of :10.73 while in the 200, a :21.75 did the trick.

Brent Roth of Iowa City West erased the old 110 high hurdle mark of 14.8 seconds with a clocking of :14.3.

Iowa City High's Glenn Lomenick was a dual winner in the two-mile run and mile run.

Davenport North's Deven Daye and Chris Stovall performed well. Daye took the long jump with a leap of 21 feet, 6½ inches. He also came in second in the 100 and anchored the winning 880 and 440

relay efforts. Stovall claimed first in the 400 low hurdles with a time of :58.70.

North Scott's Todd McGhgy continued his winning ways in the shot put with a throw of 52-6¼ feet.

Mike Haars was victorious in the 880 run and Todd Akers won the high jump to help the Maple Leafs to their second-place spot.

But another performance pleased Fredericks more.

"The biggest surprise was Steve Zorbrist in the 440 hurdles. He didn't win it but in the the wind to run a sub-60-second race, that's phenomenal," he added.

Rain infested track meet yields flat racing results

Eldridge hosted the the rain and wind infested North Scott Lancer relays Tuesday, April 26 where Geneseo placed second, 63 points, to Iowa City High, 103 points.

"We were flat tonight, maybe it was the weather conditions," Coach Don Fredericks stated in regard to the 30 mile per hour winds and 20 degree temps.

Geneseo's Phil Walsh finished the 2 mile run in second while Brad Baker took fifth in the event. Chad Blunt claimed the sixth slot in the 110 high hurdles for the Leafs while Ben Mayes took the slot in the 100 meter dash.

Geneseo's two mile relay team clocked in fifth members Justin VanVooren, Mike Morris, Ted Leamen and Mike Haars.
