

Leafs dominate triangular with 113 point victory over two foes

Four firsts by Ben Mayes and three from Steve Zobrist led the Leaf harriers to an outstanding 113 point victory in the Princeton and Streator triangular in Geneseo Thursday, April 28.

Todd Akers, Phil Walsh, Bud Bennington, Todd Smith and Mike Haars each took two firsts for the day.

First places were racked up for Geneseo throughout the entire field.

Zobrist earned his first in the 110 high hurdles, 15.84, as a member of the 400 meter relay team and as a member of the 1600 relay.

Mayes joined Zobrist in the 400 relay victory and also took first in the 100 meter dash, the 200 dash and as a member of the 800 meter relay.

Results for each event showed Derek Allen earned second in the shot with Curt Seel taking fourth.

Allen also claimed first in the discus, 148'3" followed by Steve Nitz in second while Geneseo racked up all three slot in the high jump.

Akers' jump of 6'4" was good enough for first place while Dean Lewis followed in second and Don Turner in third.

Second, third and fourth were taken by the Leafs in the pole vault with Todd Erbst leading the way followed by Steve Durick, and Brian Klopp.

Akers added yet another first with his 18'6" effort in the long jump followed by a third place finish in the triple. Durick took fourth for the Leafs in the triple jump.

Walsh, Brad Baker, Mike Morris and Haars did their effort toward the firsts with a 3200 meter relay finish in 8:47.9.

Joining Mayes and Zobrist in the winners circle for the 400 relay were Bennington and Smith.

Barry Bassier, 11:26.0, clocked in first in the 3200 meter race followed by Leaf Mike Chavez in second.

Zobrist was followed through the 110 high hurdles by Chad Blunt in second while Smith followed Mayes over the line in the 100 meter dash.

Morris took second behind Haars, 2:03.09, in the 800 meter run with Shawn Alexander following in fourth.

Bennington, Smith and Ted Leamen joined Mayes at the top in the 800 relay with a combined time of 1:35.22.

Jason Wachtel and Tyrone Jackson took second and fourth, respectively, in

the 400 race while Mark Reade, Zobrist and Durick, took second, third and fourth in the 300 low hurdles.

Walsh finished the 1600 meter race in 4:38.3 for firsts followed by Baker in third while Mayes took the 200 meter dash, 23.54 followed by Smith and Bennington in second and third.

Reade, Jackson and Leamen combined talents with Zobrist in the 1600 relay.

Earlier in the week Geneseo competed in the 10th annual Dixon Invitational on Saturday, April 23. Geneseo took the contest with 120 points followed by Sterling with 78 points.

The surprise of the meet, according to Coach Don Fredericks, was the first place finish by the 1600 medley relay team of Bennington, Mayes, Joe Holevoet and VanVooren. The foursome clocked in at 3:50.5 to take the tape.

Coach Fredericks dubbed the victory a "solid team effort. The weather was kind of bad, but the team's performance made it a sunny day."

The Leafs scored tops in three field events and two relays. Besides the 1600 medley the 3200 relay also took first. Morris, Adam Boardman, Baker and Walsh combined talent in this relay.

From the field a solid throw from Nitz, Allen and Jason Mason gave Geneseo the discus event. Akers, Lewis and Turner handed the Leafs the high jump award while Justin Reed, Durick and Akers took care of the triple jump honors.

The 440 low hurdle shuttle team of Reade, Durick, Blunt and Zobrist also brought home the gold for the Leaf harriers.

Seel, Ken Talbot and Allen claimed the second place in the shot put event. Also taking seconds were the 440 high hurdle shuttle of Reade, Jon McAvoy, Blunt and Zobrist, the frosh-soph 800 relay of Chad Loucks, Brad Dierickx, Ryan Verbeck and Mayes, the distance medley relay of Alexander, Leamen, Baker and Walsh and the frosh-soph 1600 relay of Chad Harder, Joe Rogers, Dierickx and Boardman.

The pole vaulting event earned Geneseo a third place finish from Durick, Glenn Klopp and Brian Klopp. The 400 weightman's relay of Allen, Talbot, Mason and Seel also took third for the day.

The 1600 relay took first place while

the 400 relay, and 800 relays claimed sixth place finishes.
