

Leafs' cindermen look sharp in triangular win

GENESE0 — Geneseo won 10 of 18 events, including one-two-three sweeps in two individual events, and easily defeated Galesburg and Alleman in varsity triangular track and field action Thursday afternoon.

Coach Don Fredericks' Maple Leafs rolled up 86 points, to 55 by Galesburg and 44 by the Pioneers.

"We're coming along nicely," Fredericks said. "We're not that far now from the big meets. If we can get some good weather now, I think we'll see big drops in times and increases in distances in the field events."

Fredericks said sprinter Ben Mayes had a big day, with wins in the 100

(11.8) and 200-meter dashes (24.4), while also anchoring winning efforts in the 400 and 800-meter relays.

"Derek Allen won the shot put and discus in competition with two solid weight guys from Galesburg," Fredericks said.

Allen's throw in the discus, 146'7", won by 10 feet, while his shot put heave of 48'10 1/2" won by three inches over one Silver Streak and by about one and one-half feet over another.

Leaf senior distance runner Brad Baker won the metric mile in 4:37.0, and led off for a winning 3,200-meter relay team. Baker had a split of 2:04.2

in that relay, while Adam Boardman came on with a 2:03.5 leg. Mike Bell and Barry Bassier brought the Leafs home in first.

Geneseo's sweeps came in the 300-meter intermediate hurdles and in the pole vault.

Tyrone Jackson (42.7), Chad Blunt (43.89) and Shane McKibbon (44.19) swept the hurdles, while Pat Lawrence (11'6"), Brian Klopp (11') and Troy Bjork (10'6") took the three top spots in the pole vault.

Leaf relay team took the rest of Geneseo's wins. Chad Loucks, Ryan Verbeck, Blunt and Mayes clocked

54.04 to win the 400, while Loucks, Verbeck, Andy Hahn and Mayes won the 800 in 1:36.89.

In the sophomore portion of the meet, the Leaflets overwhelmed their competition, winning 17 of the 18 events. Geneseo rolled up 137 points, to 30 by Galesburg and 17 by Alleman.

Geneseo's varsity boys track team had a highly successful week as it downed Galesburg and Alleman in a three-team meet on Thursday, April 13 and placed seventh in a strong field at the Peoria Relays on Saturday, April 17 in Peoria.

The Leafs won 10 of 18 events on their way to a 86-55-44 win over second place Galesburg and Alleman.

Junior sprinter Ben Mayes led the way for the Leafs as he won the 100 and 200 meter dashes and also ran legs in the winning 400 and 800 meter relay events. He won the 100 in 11.8 seconds and the 200 in 24.4 seconds.

Derek Allen was also a double winner for the Leafs as captured he both of the weight events. His winning efforts were 48'10.5" in the shot put and 146'7" in the discus.

Other individuals who won events for the Leafs were Pat Lawrence, who went 11'6" in the pole vault, Tyrone Jackson, who ran the 300 meter intermediate hurdles in 42.7 seconds and Brad Baker, who won the 1600 meter run in 4:37.

Three relay teams also took first place finishes. The 400 meter relay team of Chad Loucks, Ryan Verbeck, Chad Blunt and Mayes won in 45.1 seconds and the 800 meter relay team of Loucks, Verbeck, Andy Hahn and Mayes won in 1:36.9. The final relay winner was the 3200 team of Baker, Adam Boardman, Mike Bell and Barry Bassier.

Second place finishers for the Leafs were Brian Klopp in the pole vault, Dave Evans in the triple jump, Blunt in the 110 meter high hurdles and 300 meter intermediate hurdles, Brian Walsh in the 800 meter run, Chad Clark in the 400 meter dash and the 1600 meter relay team of Clark, Jackson, Jay Wachtel and Joe Rogers.

Third place finishers for the Leafs were Troy Bjork in the pole vault, Shane McKibbon in the 110 high hurdles and 300 meter intermediate hurdles, Christian Michaelson in the 800

meter run, Jay Wachtel in the 400 meter dash and Loucks in the 200 meter dash.

"We finally had some good weather and the guys showed what they could do under good conditions. We had several guys who gave outstanding efforts," said Coach Don Fredericks.

Leaflet tracksters pummel Galesburg and Alleman

Geneseo's frosh-soph track team captured first place finishes in 17 of the 18 events contested on its way to a 137-30-17 win over Galesburg and Alleman on Thursday, April 13 in Geneseo.

Steven Campbell and David Farmer led the Leaf frosh with two wins apiece. Campbell won the high jump with a leap of 5'4" and the 800 meter run with a time of 2:22.7. Farmer won the 110 meter high hurdles in 19.2 seconds and the 300 meter intermediate hurdles in 47.6 seconds.

Other individual winners for Geneseo were Kent Swanson, who heaved the shot put 39'6"; Matt Henning, who tossed the discus 98'7"; Matt Jacocks, who traveled 18'1.5" in the long jump; Darin Lavery, who soared 38'7" in the triple jump; Mark Chaney, who cleared 10' in the pole vault; Bryan Glass, who won the 3200 meter run in 10:49.9; Kevin Fuhr, who covered 100 meters in 12.3 seconds; Jeremy Holke, who captured the 400 meter dash in 57 seconds; Justin VanVooren, who won the 1600 meter run in 4:56.5; and David Burbridge, who took the 200 meter dash in 25 seconds flat.

Also victorious were the 400 meter relay team of Burbridge, Jacocks, Lavery and Fuhr, the 800 relay team of

Burbridge, Jacocks, Brett Harpel and Fuhr and the 3200 meter relay team of VanVooren, Ryan Rummel, Calvin Orwig and Ryan Kleinau.

Second place finishes came from Henning in the shot put, Ryan Alexander in the triple jump and pole vault, Holke in the high jump, Travis Stroh in the 3200 meter run, Jeremy Mier in the 110 meter high hurdles and the 300 meter intermediate hurdles, Burbridge in the 100 meter dash, Lavery in the 400 meter dash, Orwig in the 1600 meter run and Fuhr in the 200 meter run.

Third place finishes were earned by Brad Kastor in the shot put, Kleinau in the high jump, Chuck Blaszczyk in the pole vault, Bryant Crawford in the 800 meter run and Rummel in the 1600 meter run.




