

Leaflets nab second at Dixon Invitational

Geneseo's boys frosh-soph track team continued to perform well as it pounded Princeton and Rockridge 120-58-11 on Thursday, April 27, placed second in the Dixon Invitational on Saturday, April 29 and was edged 76-70 by Sterling on Tuesday, May 2 in Sterling. Kevin Fuhr, Ryan Rummel and Shane McKibbon led the Leaflets to their win over Princeton and Rockridge as each won two events.

Fuhr won the 100 meter dash in 12 seconds and the 200 meter dash in 24.19 seconds. Rummel took the 800 meter run in 2:19.8 and the 1600 meter run in 5:04.1. McKibbon claimed the 110 meter high hurdles in 16.6 seconds and the 300 meter intermediate hurdles in 42.9 seconds.

Other individual winners were Steven Campbell in the high jump with a leap of 5'6", Mark Chaney in the pole vault with a 11'6" effort, Matt Jacocks in the long jump with a 17'1" jump and Travis Stroth, who was clocked in 11:32.5 in the 3200 meter run.

All four relay teams were victorious as well. The 400 team of Dave Burbridge, Jacocks, Brad Dierickx and Fuhr was clocked in 47.5 seconds. The same four boys won the 800 in 1:40.5.

The 1600 team of Chaney, Ryan Kleinau, Jeremy Holke and McKibbon was clocked in 3:50.15 while the 3200 team of Steve Miller, Bryant Crawford, Roger Sheets and Jason Jolly won with a 10:16.4 effort.

Second place finishers were Troy Bjork in the pole vault, Ryan Alexander in the triple jump, Neil Radicic in the 3200, David Farmer in the 110 high hurdles, Burbridge in the 100 and 200, Kleinau in the 800 and Miller in the 1600.

Third place finishers were Kent Swanson in the shot put, Holke in the high jump, Farmer in the triple jump, Mike McVietty in the 3200, Jeremy Mier in the 110 high hurdles and 300 intermediate hurdles, Campbell in the 800 and Brett Harpel in the 200.

The Leaflets then traveled to Dixon to take part in a 10-team Invitational. Though they left behind three of their top performers, McKibbon, Mike VanDeVelde and Ryan Verbeck, the Leaflets still placed second in the meet.

Princeton won the meet with 89 points followed by Geneseo with 84, IIT with 70, Rock Falls and Sterling 53 each, Hononegah 30, Belvidere 24, Moline 23, Dixon 20 and LaSalle-Peru 19.

"With McKibbon, VanDeVelde and Verbeck, we would have won the meet by 30 points. The fact that we almost won it without them is very exciting," said Coach Don Fredericks.

The Leaflets placed first in five events.

The pole vault team of Bjork, Alexander, Chaney and Chuck Blaszczyk jumped a total of 43' while the 1600 team of Glass, Orwig, Miller and Stroth also took first.

The 3200 team of Justin VanVooren, Rummel, Boardman and Kleinau was clocked in 8:34 while the distance medley team of Rummel, Kleinau, VanVooren and Boardman won with a 11:07 effort.

The final first place finish came from the 1600 relay team of Fuhr, Chaney, Burbridge and Boardman that was clocked in 3:40.9.

Second place finishers were the high jump team of Evans, Campbell, Holke and Kleinau and the triple jump team of Evans, Darin Lavery, Alexander and Kleinau.

Third place finishes were by the shot put team of Brad Kastor, Swanson, Jim VanAcker and Matt Henning and the 440 high-low hurdle shuttle team of Farmer, Chris Jiles, Mier and Blaszczyk.

The final meet of the week for the Leaflets was the narrow loss to perennial power Sterling.

Fuhr and Farmer led the Leaflet effort with a pair of individual victories.

Fuhr was the 100 in 11.90 seconds and the 200 in 24.71 seconds. Farmer captured the 110 high hurdles in 18.01 seconds and the 300 intermediate hurdles in 46.82 seconds.

Other individual winners were Rummel, who won the 3200 in 10:56.7 and Kleinau, who was clocked in 2:16.51 in the 800.

The Leaflets also won three of four relay events.

The 400 team of Burbridge, Jacocks, Dierickx and Fuhr was clocked in 47.3 seconds while the same four won the 800 relay in 1:41.98. The final relay winner was the 1600 team of Kleinau, Chaney, Mier and Farmer timed in 3:55.14.

Second place finishers were Stroh in the 3200, Mier in the 110 high hurdles, Rummel in the 1600, Dierick in the long jump and Chaney in the pole vault.

Third place finishers were Radicic in the 3200, Campbell in the 800 and high jump, Holke in the 400, Mier in the 300 intermediate hurdles, Burbridge in the 200, Kleinau in the long jump and Alexander in the triple jump.

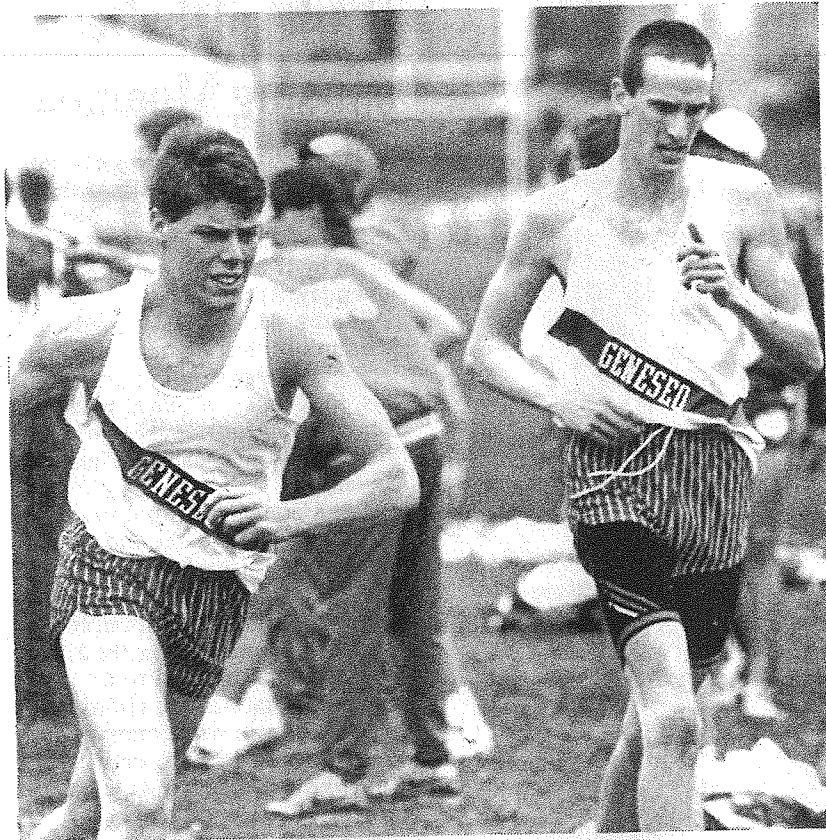
