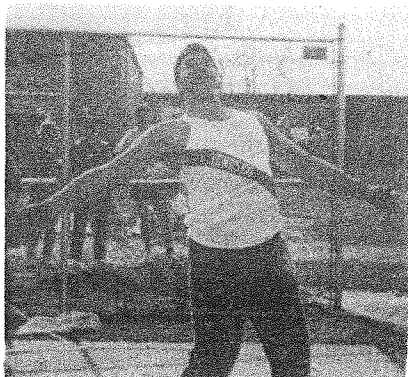


Whoooooosh!

Discus record falls as Allen uncoils against Moline

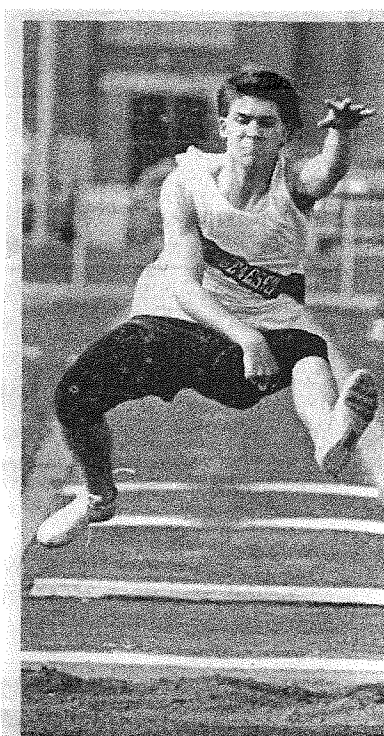

Oh, geez...!

Last week's **NewsLife** carried a photo of Geneseo's Neil Simon throwing the discus, but incorrectly identified the athlete as Derek Allen. **NewsLife** regrets the error. Allen on Tuesday night broke the school record in the discus in a meet against Moline.

Soaring senior

Jon Obrecht gave it his all but this leap in the long jump didn't get him in the top five in the event in the Geneseo senior's 76-70 win over Moline on Tuesday, April 25.

MOLINE — Derek Allen went to town Tuesday, and the folks in Moline gave him room.

Allen needed the room, too - exactly 165 feet, 7 inches' worth.

That's how far Allen sailed the discus against gravity and the Moline Maroons, and it was worth a Geneseo school record.

Allen's throw, which broke the previous record of 163'7", set in 1975 by Lane Boblett, led an effort against Moline which delighted Maple Leaf coach Don Fredericks.

Moline, a strong dual meet team, beat Geneseo 81.5 to 64.5. In sophomore action, Geneseo was a 76-70 winner.

"We asked the kids to gear up for this meet," Fredericks said. "They did, and I'm pleased with our effort."

Allen's other two measured throws Tuesday were 153'6" and 160'11".

Geneseo earned seven wins on the afternoon. Chad Blunt won the high hurdles, Dave Evans took the high jump, Mike VanDeVelde won the 400-meter dash (in a sizzling 52.2), and Ben Mayes won the 200 in 23.6. In addition, Geneseo won the 400 and 800-meter relays with Mayes anchoring.

"He (Mayes) ran down a kid from behind in the 800," Fredericks said. "He had a great meet."

Fredericks said the race of the day came in the 300-meter intermediate hurdles. "Derek Rogers of Moline, the best hurdler in the Quad Cities, against our Tyrone Jackson," Fredericks said. "And Tyrone was blowing him away. He had a sub-40-second time going. Then he tripped and fell over a hurdle, and couldn't finish."

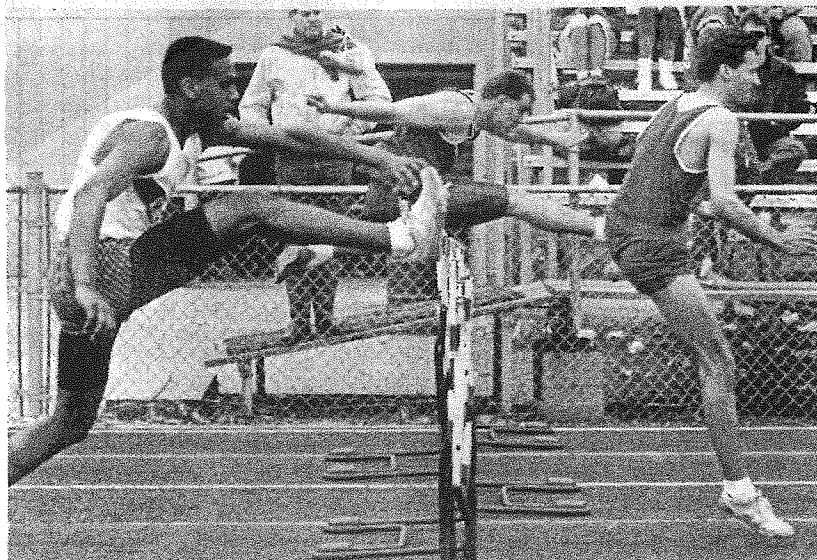
Jackson scraped himself up and ran a 51.4 split in Geneseo's 1,600 relay which had Fredericks ecstatic all over again. VanDeVelde added a 52.4 split, and although Moline won the event, Geneseo's time of 3:33.4 was a season's best.

The Leafs competed without jumper Jay Reed, who Fredericks said is no longer with the team.

Geneseo's sophomore team achieved its victory without its fresh-

man contingent, which was resting up after Monday's big win in the Geneseo Freshman Invitational. And, a number of Leaf sophs competed with the varsity on Tuesday.

The Leaflets won 10 events, including individual double victories by Kevin Fuhr in the short sprints and by Shane McKibbin in the hurdles races.

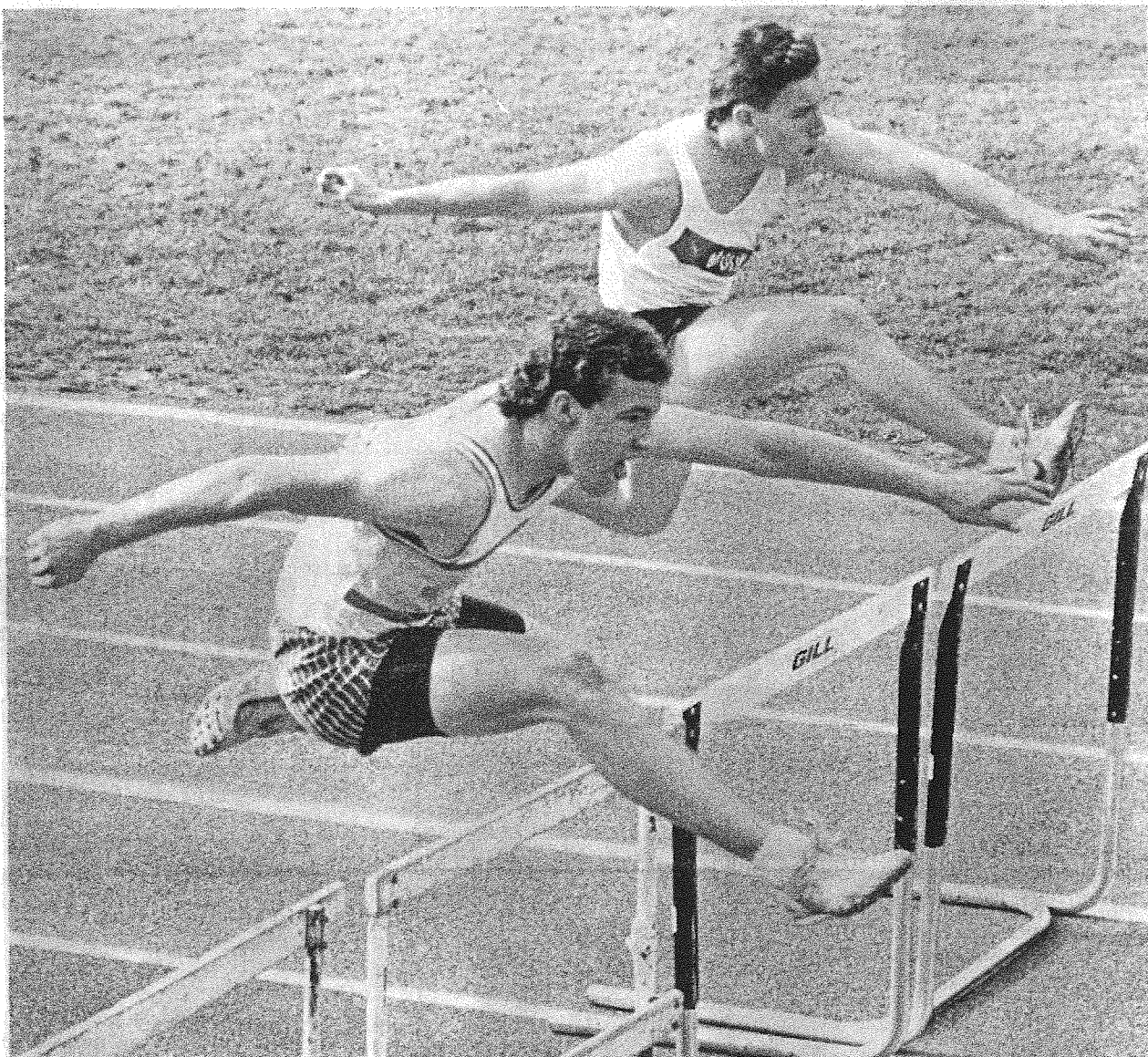
