Leaflets nip strong field in Moline Invitational

Geneseo's frosh-soph boys track team showed it will be a team to be reckoned with in the future as it captured the Moline Frosh-Soph Invitational on Tuesday, May 16 in Moline.

This was the first time for this meet and Coach Don Fredericks compared it to a sectional meet, only at the sophomore level.

"This was a big-time meet filled with quality teams. Everybody sent the best they had and we showed we could compete with the best around. It was just a great way for this team to end the season," said Coach Fredericks.

Sophomore hurdler Shane McKibbon nabbed the only first place finish for the Leaflets as he won the 300 meter intermediate hurdles with a time of 43 seconds flat.

"There were a lot of times, including Shane's, that would have won varsity meets," noted Coach Fredericks.

Troy Bjork, Steven Campbell and Adam Boardman nabbed second place finishes for the Leaflets.

Bjork cleared 11'6" in the pole vault, Campbell marked 5'8" in the high jump and Boardman was clocked at 52.67 in the 400 meter dash. Boardman was held out of the 800 and 1600 meter runs, two events he won at the recent North Central Illinois Conference varsity meet, to prepare for his other events.

Darin Lavery, McKibbon and Bryan Glass took third places in the meet.

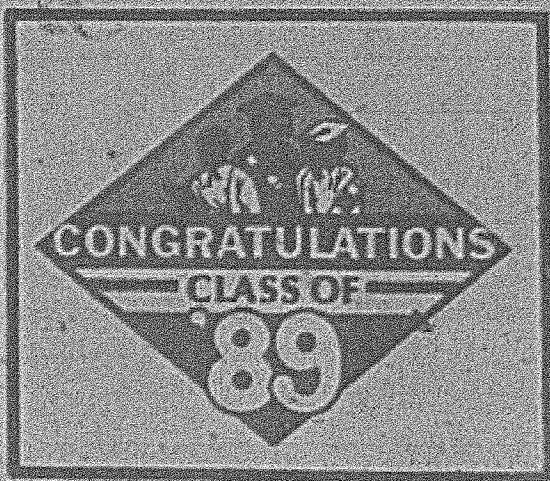
Lavery soared 38'3 1/2" in the triple jump, McKibbon was clocked at 16.18 seconds in the 110 high hurdles and Glass was timed at 10:22 in the 3200 meter run.

The Leaflets also had several fourth, fifth and sixth place finishes which garnered points towards the team total.

"It was a definite team effort and win," said Coach Fredericks.

The Leaflets scored 68 points to nab the narrow win. Rock Island was second with 66 points, East Moline third with 65 followed by Moline with 63, Ottawa 61, Alleman 44, Galesburg 34, Sherrard 27 and Rockridge 4.

"We showed that we will continue to be strong in boys track for years to come," concluded Coach Fredericks.
