Leaf tracksters finish seventh in Peoria meet

With this win safely tucked under their belts, the Leafs then headed for Peoria to compete in the Peoria Relays, a meet which featured some of the finest teams in the state, according to Coach Fredericks.

Peoria Central won the meet with 62.5 points followed by Peoria Richwoods with 52, East St. Louis Lincoln 48, Normal Community 42, UT 26.5, Morton 24, Geneseo 21, Peoria Woodruff 17, Bartonville Limestone 8, Chillicothe I.V.C. 3 and Pekin 2. Several other teams in the meet did not score any points.

The top performer in the meet for the Leafs was Allen. The burly senior heaved the shot put 49'3.5" for a fourth place finish and tossed the discus 159'2" for a third place finish.

His throw in the discus was only 4'5" off the school record set by Lane Boblett in 1975.

"I think that record is living on borrowed time the way Derek is throwing," said Coach Fredericks.

Besides Allen's effort in the discus, the Leafs had one other third place finish. That was turned in by the 440 meter high hurdle shuttle team of McKibbon, Jackson, Chris Bush and Blunt. They were timed in 1:07.2.

Two Leaf relay teams placed fourth They were the 6400 meter relay team of Baker, Boardman, Bell and Bassier who were timed in 19:12.59 and the frosh-soph 3200 meter relay team of Van Vooren, Rummel, Calvin Orwig and Ryan Kleinau which was timed in 8:53.56.

Fifth place finishers were Brian Klopp, who cleared 12 feet in the pole

vault and Darin Lavery, who soared 39'3.5" in the triple jump. Lavery's effort was the second longest ever for a Leaf freshman.

Three of the Leaf's top performers who would have made a difference in the final standings did not compete in the meet. They were pole vaulter Glenn Klopp, triple jumper Jay Reed and sprinter Mayes.

"Anybody that placed in this meet did a great job because it was such a high-powered meet. It was also important for us to do well because we will be seeing some of the Peoria teams again when the sectional comes around. We wanted to show them what kind of team we have," concluded Coach Fredericks.
