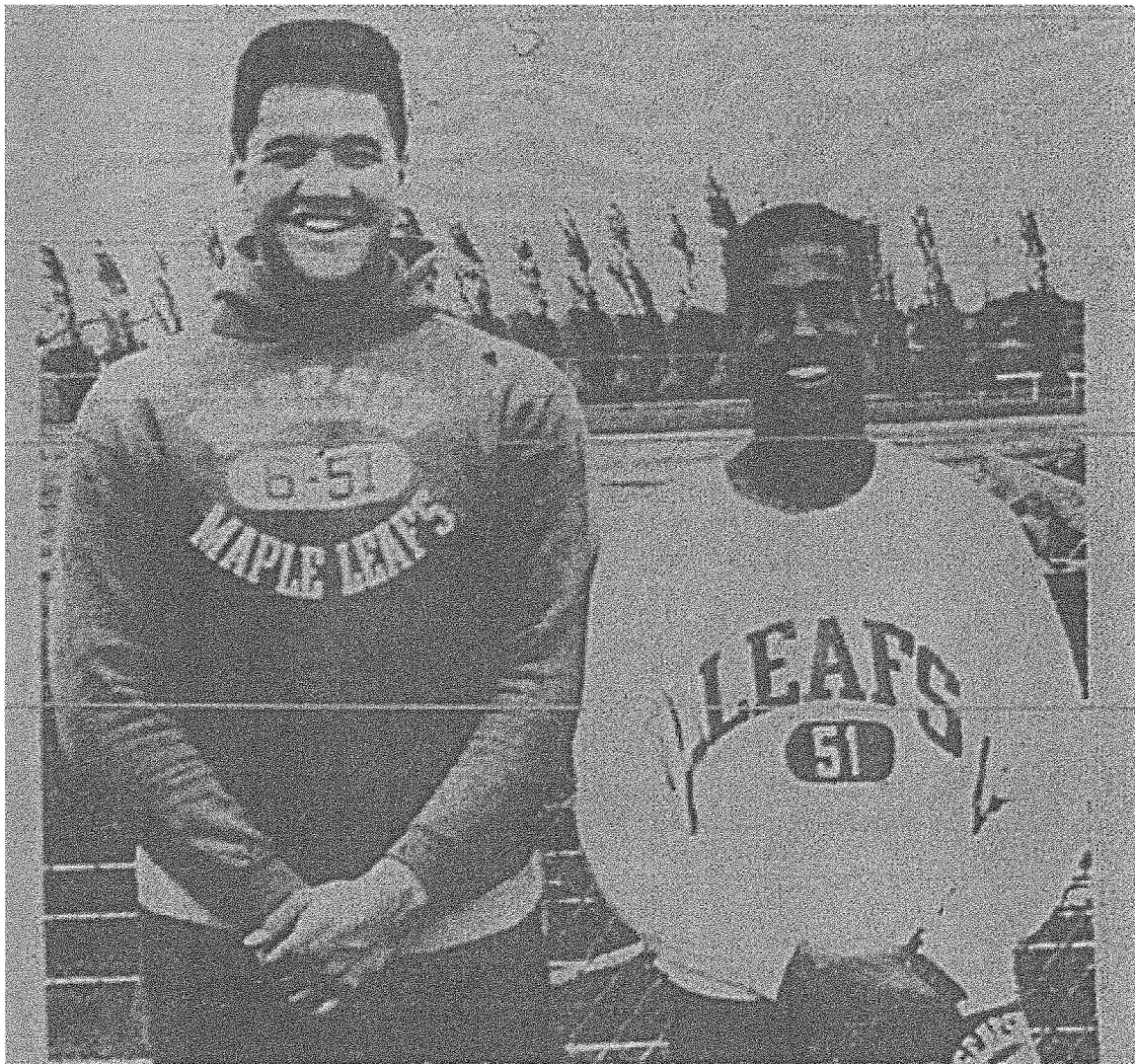

On to state

Jackson and Allen advance to state meet

Seniors Tyrone Jackson and Derek Allen were the only two Geneseo boys varsity track team members to advance out of the power-packed Sterling sectional track meet held Saturday, May 20 in Sterling.

"I feel this was the best sectional in the state. There were times turned in that might make it to the finals in the state meet that didn't make it out of this sectional. We had some outstanding performances. Some people might look at this meet and see we only had two advance to state and think we had a bad meet but that simply wasn't the case," said Coach Don Fredericks.

Jackson ran his first sub 40 second time in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles as he was clocked at 39.80 to finish second.

Allen qualified in the discus as his 160'4" effort was good enough for third place.

The Leafs also had three individuals who had outstanding efforts but came away empty.

Adam Boardman ran a blazing 1:58.31 in the 800 meter run only to come up seven-tenths of a second short of second place. Glenn Klopp soared a season best 13' in the pole vault only to be bested in a regional that sent five vaulters who went 13'6" or higher. Brad Baker was clocked in a quick 4:26.85 in the 1600 only but again fell short in a loaded field.

"Several of our athletes peaked just at the right time but they were just up against unbelievable competition," said Coach Fredericks.

Jackson and Allen both have a shot at doing well in Charleston this weekend, according to Coach Fredericks.

"It will take outstanding efforts and maybe some luck but I think Tyrone and Derek have a shot at placing," concluded Coach Fredericks.
