

Allen, Jackson finish season at state meet

Derek Allen and Tyrone Jackson performed well but failed to make the finals at the Class AA boys track meet held Friday and Saturday, May 26 and 27, in Charleston.

Allen's best toss in the discus was a toss of 157'9", an effort 17" short of qualifying for the finals. Jackson was clocked at 40.81 seconds in the 300 meter intermediate hurdles, a time that was eight-tenths of a second off of qualifying time.

"Both Derek and Tyrone performed admirably in the meet. Sometimes guys go to the state meet and can't deal with the pressure. They both came close to their personal bests during the

season and they can be very proud of the way they did," said Coach Don Fredericks.

Coach Fredericks also announced the award winners for the 1989 track season. Allen and Jackson were named the most valuable and most improved performers, respectively. They were also named team captains, along with fellow senior Brad Baker. The other major award winner was Michael Bell, who was named most inspirational.

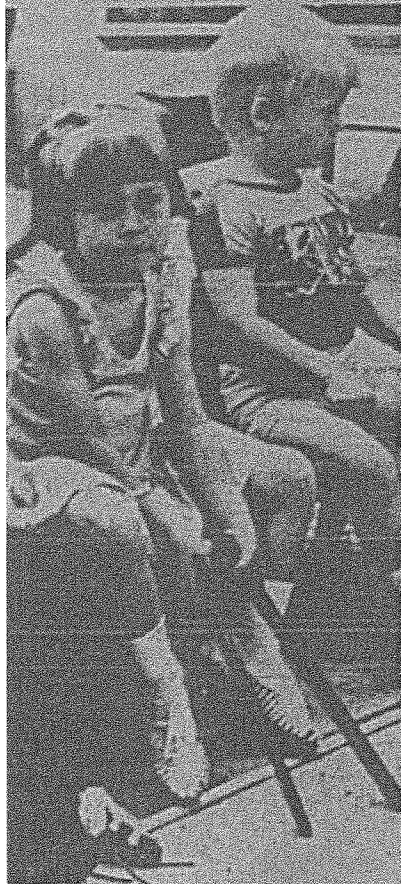
Also named were the varsity, junior varsity, sophomore and freshman award winners.
