Leafs boys eat Sterling's dust

STERLING — Geneseo's varsity boys track team has its work cut out for it if the Maple Leafs want to defend their NCIC championship.

Sterling smoked the varsity Leafs 96-50 in a dual meet Tuesday night, just a little over a week before the conference meet.

It was a lot closer in the frosh-soph ranks, but Sterling also prevailed, 76-70.

"I blasted the team right after the meet. But on the bus coming home I reasoned that our team has a lot of character, and there must be a reason we didn't perform any better than we did," coach Don Fredericks said.

"The weather had something to do with it," Fredericks said. "The home team can stay warm longer in conditions like we had Tuesday. That's a big advantage, and we looked like we never got warmed up."

Sterling swept all three place finishes in three events - the long jump, high jump and triple jump, and won all four relays. That's a 47-0 edge in points, and the Golden Warriors won by 46 points.

Geneseo had a one-two sweep in the 800-meter run. Adam Boardman won in 2:01.66, and Michael Bell was second in his season's best of 2:03.4.

Boardman and Brad Baker were one-two in the 1,600, Boardman clocking 4:42.10 with Baker in at 4:47.30.

Tyrone Jackson had an outstanding race, too, Fredericks said. Jackson erased his previous personal best with a winning 15.51 victory in the high hurdles.

Derek Allen picked up a discus victory in windy conditions, sailing the dish 155'4".

Each team won nine events in the frosh-soph meet, but a whopping 45-14 Sterling edge in the field events produced the Braves' victory.

Individual double winners for the Leaflets were Kevin Fuhr in the short dashes and David Farmer in the hurdles races. Ryan Kleinau won the 800 for Geneseo, Ryan Rummel won the 3,200, and the Leaflets won three relay races.

The Leafs then had a showdown with conference power Sterling. On a cold and windy day in Sterling, the Golden Warriors made short work of the Leafs as they won by 46 points. Coach Fredericks felt it was a deceiving amount of victory.

"There is no way Sterling is that much better of a team than we are. A big factor in the meet was the weather. Their athletes had the advantage of going into the school and staying warm in between events while we had to stay outside and freeze. Sterling has a good team and they just had everything going for them in this meet," he said.

The Leafs were shut out in events they have been strong in this year. Sterling won all four relay races and swept the long, high and triple jumps to rack up the points in those events.

A big reason Geneseo scored no points in the jumps was due to the absense of Jay Reed, who is no longer with the team.

"Sterling won't sweep the relays of the jumps in the conference meet," said Coach Fredericks.

The Leafs did win five events in the meet, including two by sophomore distance ace Boardman. He won the 800 in 2:01.66 and the 1600 in 4:42.1.

Other winners were Glass, Jackson and Allen. Glass took the 3200 in 10:27.99, Jackson captured the 110 high hurdles in 15.51 seconds and Allen tossed the discus 155'4".

Second place finishers were Mayes in the 100 and 200 meter dashes, Bell in the 800, VanDeVelde in the 400, Shane McKibbon in the 300 meter low hurdles, Baker in the 1600 and Allen in the discus.

Third place finishers include Orwig in the 3200, Blunt in the 110 high hurdles; Jackson in the 400 and Glenn Klopp in the pole vault.

"We've really got our work cut out for us if we want to challenge Sterling in the conference meet. They can be beat though," concluded Coach Fredericks.


