

Klopp, Mayes help Leafs clobber Dixon, Rochelle

Seniors Glenn Klopp and Ben Mayes scored a pair of individual victories to lead the Geneseo varsity boys track team to season-opening wins over Dixon and Rochelle Tuesday, March 13 at the Westwood sports complex, Sterling.

The Leafs scored a total of 75 points to clip the Dukes (65) and the Hubs (30).

"This was strictly a developmental meet for us and I was very pleased with what I saw. We still have a long way to go before we are a solid track team, though," noted Coach Don Fredericks.

Klopp captured the pole vault and the high jump with efforts of 12'6" and 5'10", respectively.

Mayes was tops in the 55 meter dash (6.37 seconds) and the 200 meter dash (23.82).

Juniors Justin VanVooren and Adam Boardman were also double winners for the Leafs, though one of their wins came in a relay event.

Justin VanVooren captured the 800 in a time of 2:08.9 while Boardman claimed first in the 1600 with a time of 4:40. They also paired with Jason VanVooren and Brian Walsh to win the 3200 meter relay in a time of 8:26.4.

The final first place winner for the Leafs was junior distance ace Bryan Glass, who captured the 3200 meter run in 10:15.

Second place finishers for the Leafs were Mark Chaney in the pole vault, Mike VanDeVelde in the long jump, Shane McKibbin in the 55 meter intermediate and high hurdles, Justin VanOpdorp in the 1600 and the 1600

meter relay team of Darin Lavery, Chaney, Ryan Kleinau and Boardman.

Earning third place finishes were VanDeVelde in the high jump, Lavery in the long jump and triple jump, Travis Stroh in the 3200 meter run, McKibbin in the 400 and Jason VanVooren in the 1600.

Coach Fredericks feels that athletes from other schools have an edge on his team in the early stages of the season.

"Schools that have access to indoor facilities have an advantage at this point in the year, especially in the technique events. There are several schools that use the Westwood facility to practice but when the weather starts to improve we will catch up. They won't improve as much as we will in the later part of the season," he said.

The Geneseo sophomore boys track team also got off to a solid start this season as it topped Rochelle and Dixon by scores of 85-39-36, respectively.

Freshman sprinter Ben Hahn led the way with wins in the 55, 200 and 400 meter dashes.

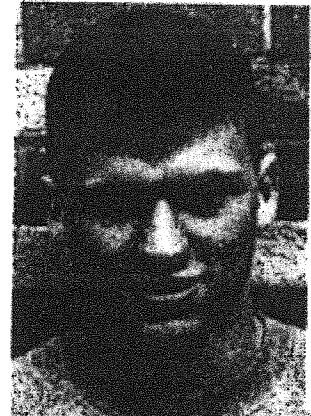
Also gaining multiple wins were David Farmer (55 meter intermediate and high hurdles), Josh Pierce (800 and a leg on the winning 1600 and 3200 meter relay teams) and Jeremy Holke (high jump and 1600 meter relay).

Also claiming wins for the Leaflets were Steve Pardoe in the pole vault, Tom Britton in the long jump, Derek Wright and Jeremy Mier (1600 relay) and Mitch Pray, Matt Lotz and Micah Miller (3200 relay).

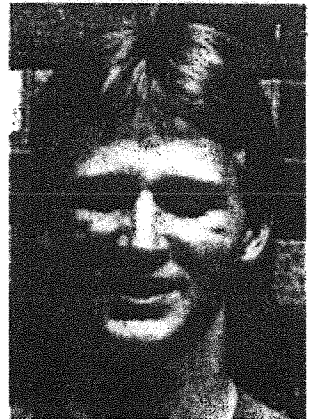
Second place finishers were Nathan Culbertson in the shot put, Andy Snook in the pole vault and 3200, Gibson and
