

# Leaf tracksters trounce Freeport and Sterling

Six athletes contributed multiple wins as the Geneseo varsity track team gained wins over Freeport and Sterling Tuesday, March 20 at the Westwood sports complex in Sterling.

Team totals in the meet were Geneseo--68, Freeport--52 and Sterling--46.

Justin VanVooren and Shane McKibbon led the Leafs with three wins each. VanVooren captured the 800 meter run in a time of 2:05.6 and ran legs on the winning 1600 and 3200 meter relay teams. McKibbon won the 55 meter intermediate and high hurdles in times of 8.23 and 8.20 seconds, respectively. He also ran a leg on the 1600 relay team.

The 1600 team of VanVooren, McKibbon, Adam Boardman and Mike VanDeVelde was clocked at 3:44.13 while the 3200 team of VanVooren, Boardman, Justin VanOpdorp and Brian Walsh won with a time of 8:27.4

Ben Mayes captured both sprinting events for the Leafs. His times were 6.55 in the 55 meter dash and 23.55 in the 200 meter dash.

VanDeVelde placed first in the 400

with a time of 52.83 while VanOpdorp was the winner in the 1600 with a time of 4:39.9.

Glenn Klopp and Jason VanVooren were single event winners for the Leafs. Klopp cleared 13' in the pole vault while Jason VanVooren finished the 3200 meter run in a time of 10:10.

Second place finishers for the Leafs were Bryan Glass in the 3200 and Boardman in the 1600.

Placing third were VanDeVelde in the high jump and Jason VanVooren in the 1600.

"We are still putting the pieces together this early in the season but this was a very good meet for us. It will definitely help us get ready for the outdoor season," said Coach Don Fredericks.

The frosh-soph team cruised to easy wins as it topped Sterling and Freeport 87 1/2 - 57 1/2 - 19, respectively.

Leading the way were multiple winners Ben Hahn, David Farmer and Andy Snook.

Hahn captured the 55, 200 and 400 meter dashes in times of 6.90, 25.55 and 57.1 seconds.

Farmer won the 55 intermediate and high hurdle events (8.61 and 8.81 seconds) as well as the triple jump (38' 1/2").

Snook earned first place in the 1600 (5:03.1) and the 3200 (10:48.1).

Also earning first place finishes for the Leaflets were Nathan Culbertson in the shot put (40'8"), Tom Britton in the long jump (18'7 1/2") and the 1600 relay team of Josh Pierce, Chris Jiles, Jeremy Holke and Jeremy Mier (4:01.9).

Finishing second were Derek Wright in the long jump and triple jump, Mier in the 55 meter high and intermediate hurdles, Pierce in the 800 and Holke in the 400.

Third place finishes were earned by Farmer in the long jump, Britton in the triple jump and 55 meter dash, Randy Carton in the pole vault and Mitch Pray in the 3200.

The Leafs and Leaflets will open their outdoor season with a Tuesday, March 27 meet against Orion and UT at the Soule Bowl in East Moline.

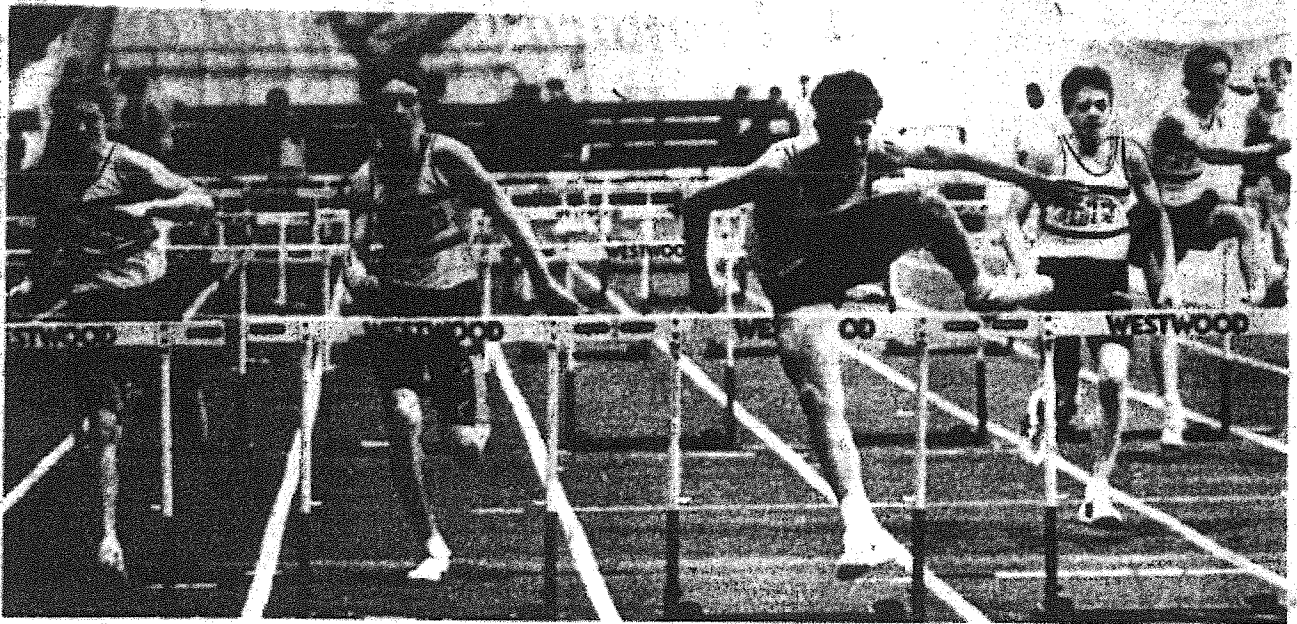
