

Frosh capture own Invite for second straight year

Middle distance runner Josh Pierce captured first place in two events to lead the Geneseo freshmen boys track team to the team title in the Geneseo Frosh Invitational held Monday, April 23.

The win was the second in a row for the Leafrosh in this event.

Team scores in the meet were Geneseo (121), Rock Island (101-1/2), Sterling (76-1/2), Clinton (61), UT (59), LaSalle-Peru (47), Moline (33), Alleman (21) and Bettendorf (17).

"This was the freshmen's chance to

shine and they came through like champions. There were some outstanding performances against some very good teams," noted Coach Don Fredericks.

Pierce claimed wins in the 800 (2:10.5) and 1600 (4:49) meter runs to be one of just four individual double winners in the meet.

Other Leafrosh tracksters who placed first were Andy Snook in the 3200 (10:19.19), Derek Wright in the 300 intermediate hurdles (46.81 seconds) and Ben Hahn in the 400 (54.39).

Brian Davis, Seth Graham, Aron Sikarskie and Heath DeGoei of Geneseo won the non-scoring weightman's relay.

Runner-up finishes were turned in by Hahn in 100 and 200 and Wright in the triple jump.

Finishing third were Wright in the 110 high hurdles, Graham in the discus, Snook in the 1600, Steve Pardoe in the pole vault and the 800 relay team of Eric Walker, Chad Sager, Kris Rusch and Landon Neumann.

"This was their big opportunity this season and the freshmen really came through. I see nothing but good things ahead for this group," concluded Coach Fredericks.
