

Red-hot Geneseo track team runs past Moline

GENESEO — Hot? Right now, Geneseo's boys track team is glowing

Fresh off Friday night's secondplace finish in the Rock Island Invitational, the Maple Leafs didn't break stride Tuesday afternoon, and gave long-time Geneseo track observers a rare something for their memory banks: a small-meet victory over Moline.

It was a competitive affair, Geneseo scoring eight wins while recording 90 points; Moline winning nine times en route to 85 points. Officially, it was a triangular; Streator scored 10 points.

Moline outscored Geneseo 39-25 in the field events while the Leafs prevailed 65-46 on the track. The difference was provided by Geneseo's sprinters and hurdlers.

The Leafs took first- and secondplace finishes in four individual events — both hurdles races and both short sprints — and grabbed the first three spots in the pole vault. Moline went one-two in the long jump, and one-two-three in the shot put.

Moline's Tauwon Taylor was in the winner's circle four times. He came from behind with great kicks in both the 800 and 1,600-meter runs, nipping Geneseo's Adam Boardman each time. Taylor also won the long jump, and ran on a winning 1,600-meter relay team.

Geneseo sprinter Ben Mayes and hurdler Chad Blunt each were in on three wins. Mayes won the 100- and 200-meter dashes. His 100 time of 10.83 converts to a 9.93 100-yard dash, making Mayes the secondfastest Leaf, ever.

Blunt and Shane McKibbon went one-two in both hurdles races, while Blunt joined Mayes on the winning 400-meter relay team.

The Leaf of the meet, according to Coach Don Fredericks, was senior jumper Glenn Klopp, who soared 13-6 to win the pole vault, and grabbed the high jump at 5-8 on fewer misses.

Moline coach Jeff Quick pointed toward the versatility of Alberto Furman, who got a moment in the sun when he came from behind to win the 400 in a sizzling 50.16. Furman nipped a 50.37 by Geneseo's Mike VanDeVelde, and that time, too, was the second-fastest ever by a Leaf in that event.

"It was only a triangular, not a big meet, but our kids didn't let anything bother them," Fredericks said. "We're continuing toward our goal of peaking, and we're nowhere near peaking yet."

Geneseo boys bounce back to outdistance Moline in dual meet

GENESEO - Five points was the difference between first and second place in a triangular meet between Geneseo, Moline and Streator's boys track teams on Tuesday, April 24.


The Maple Leafs bounced back after trailing by 14 points after the field events to defeat Moline 90-85. Streator took third with 10 points. The win moved Geneseo 12-0 in dual meet competition for the season.

A handful of first place finishes combined with seconds and thirds in all events made the difference for Geneseo down the stretch.

Ben Mayes and Chad Blunt were triple winners for the Leafs. Mayes won the 100 (10.83) and 200 (23.27) while Blunt took first in both the 110 high hurdles (15.15) and 300 intermediates (41.72). Mayes and Blunt were also members of the winning 400 relay team along with Ryan Verbeck and Mike VanDeVelde.

Glenn Klopp was a double winner in the field events. The senior placed first in the high jump with a leap of 5'8" and soared 13'6" to win the pole vault

Geneseo also took second and thirdin the pole vault with Mark Chaney and Adam Stokes.
